1. INTRODUCTION

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

4.1 Front and Top Panel Controls

- **POWER:** Press to turn the unit on or off.
- **SOURCE:** Press to cycle through input modes (Bluetooth, Optical, AUX, RCA).
- **VOL+:** Increase volume.
- **VOL-:** Decrease volume.
- **PAIR:** Press and hold to initiate Bluetooth pairing.
- **LINE IN:** 3.5mm AUX input port.

4.2 Rear Panel Connections

- **OPTICAL IN:** For connecting to devices via optical cable.
- **DC 18V:** Power input port.

- **L/R RCA:** For connecting to devices via RCA cables.

5. SETUP

5.1 Placement

The soundbar can be placed on a flat surface in front of your TV or wall-mounted.

- **Tabletop Placement:** Position the soundbar on a stable, flat surface directly below your television.
- **Wall Mounting:** Use the provided screws and plugs to securely mount the soundbar to a wall. Ensure the wall can support the weight of the soundbar.

5.2 Connecting to Power

1. Connect the power adapter to the DC 18V input port on the rear of the soundbar.
2. Plug the power adapter into a wall outlet.

5.3 Audio Connections

Choose one of the following methods to connect your audio source:

5.3.1 Bluetooth Connection

1. Press the **POWER** button on the soundbar or remote to turn it on.
2. Press the **SOURCE** button repeatedly until 'BT' (Bluetooth) mode is selected. The indicator light will flash.
3. On your device (e.g., smartphone, tablet), enable Bluetooth and search for 'MAJORITY Snowdon'.
4. Select 'MAJORITY Snowdon' to pair. Once connected, the indicator light will stop flashing.

5.3.2 Optical Connection

1. Connect one end of an optical cable to the OPTICAL OUT port on your TV or audio device.
2. Connect the other end to the **OPTICAL IN** port on the soundbar.
3. Press the **SOURCE** button on the soundbar or remote until 'OPT' (Optical) mode is selected.

5.3.3 AUX Connection

1. Connect one end of the 3.5mm audio cable to the headphone jack or AUX OUT port on your device.
2. Connect the other end to the **LINE IN** port on the soundbar.
3. Press the **SOURCE** button on the soundbar or remote until 'AUX' mode is selected.

5.3.4 RCA Connection

1. Connect the red and white plugs of the RCA cable to the corresponding audio output ports on your TV or audio device.
2. Connect the other end of the RCA cable to the **L/R RCA** input ports on the soundbar.
3. Press the **SOURCE** button on the soundbar or remote until 'RCA' mode is selected.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Power On/Off

Press the **POWER** button on the soundbar or remote control to turn the unit on or off.

6.2 Source Selection

Press the **SOURCE** button on the soundbar or remote control to switch between input modes: Bluetooth, Optical, AUX, and RCA.

6.3 Volume Control

Use the **VOL+** and **VOL-** buttons on the soundbar or the volume buttons on the remote control to adjust the audio level.

6.4 Remote Control Functions

The included remote control provides convenient access to all soundbar functions:

- **Power:** Turn the soundbar on or off.
- **Source:** Select input mode.
- **Volume Up/Down:** Adjust volume level.
- **Mute:** Mute or unmute the sound.
- **Play/Pause:** Control media playback in Bluetooth mode.
- **Previous/Next Track:** Skip tracks in Bluetooth mode.
- **EQ Modes:** Select preset equalizer settings (e.g., Music, Movie, News).

7. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your soundbar:

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the soundbar. Do not use liquid cleaners or abrasive materials.
- **Storage:** If storing the soundbar for an extended period, disconnect it from power and store it in a cool, dry place.
- **Avoid Obstructions:** Ensure no objects block the speaker grilles or ventilation openings.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your soundbar, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power cable not connected; Power outlet not active	Check power cable connection; Try a different power outlet
No sound	Incorrect input source selected; Volume too low; Audio cable not connected properly	Select correct input source; Increase volume; Reconnect audio cables securely

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bluetooth pairing fails	Soundbar not in pairing mode; Device too far; Interference	Ensure soundbar is in BT pairing mode; Move device closer; Turn off other Bluetooth devices
Distorted sound	Volume too high; Poor audio source quality; Loose cable connection	Reduce volume; Try a different audio source; Check cable connections
