# Nespresso Descaling Kit Instruction Manual

## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

Regular descaling is essential for maintaining the performance and longevity of your Nespresso coffee machine. Over time, mineral deposits (limescale) can build up in the machine's internal components, affecting water flow, temperature, and ultimately, the taste of your coffee. The Nespresso Descaling Kit is specifically formulated to effectively remove these deposits, ensuring your machine operates efficiently and continues to deliver high-quality coffee.

## 2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

---

The Nespresso Descaling Kit includes two units of descaling solution, each designed for a single descaling cycle. The solution is a liquid formulation containing L-(+)-lactic acid, which is effective in dissolving limescale without harming your machine's internal parts.

### 3. SAFETY INFORMATION

---

**DANGER:** This product contains L-(+)-lactic acid. Causes severe skin burns and eye damage. Corrosive to the respiratory tract. Keep out of reach of children. Always wash hands thoroughly after handling.

- **IF SWALLOWED:** Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting.
- **IF IN EYES:** Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing.
- Immediately call a **POISON CENTER** or doctor/physician if exposure occurs.
- Dispose of contents/container to an authorized waste collection point.
- Contains <5% phosphates.

### 4. DESCALING PROCESS

---

The descaling procedure may vary slightly depending on your specific Nespresso machine model. Always refer to your machine's user manual for detailed, model-specific instructions on how to enter and exit descaling mode. The general steps are as follows:

1. **Preparation:** Ensure there is no capsule in the machine. Empty the capsule container and drip tray.
2. **Empty Water Tank:** Remove and empty the water tank.
3. **Prepare Solution:** Pour one sachet (100 ml) of Nespresso descaling solution into the empty water tank.
4. **Fill Water Tank:** Fill the water tank with fresh water up to the descaling indicator line, or as specified in your machine's manual.
5. **Position Container:** Place a large container (minimum 1 liter capacity) under the coffee outlet to collect the descaling solution.
6. **Activate Descaling Mode:** Follow your machine's specific instructions to enter descaling mode. This usually involves pressing and holding certain buttons for a few seconds.
7. **Run Descaling Cycle:** Start the descaling cycle as per your machine's instructions. The machine will dispense the descaling solution through the system.

8. **Rinse Cycle (First):** Once the descaling solution has been dispensed, empty and thoroughly rinse the water tank. Refill the tank with fresh water.
9. **Rinse Cycle (Second):** Place the large container back under the coffee outlet and run a rinsing cycle with fresh water. Repeat this step if your machine manual recommends a second rinse.
10. **Exit Descaling Mode:** Follow your machine's specific instructions to exit descaling mode.
11. **Final Steps:** Empty and clean the drip tray and capsule container. Your machine is now descaled and ready for use.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

---

For optimal performance and coffee taste, it is recommended to descale your Nespresso machine every 3 months, or when the descaling indicator light illuminates on your machine. The frequency may vary based on water hardness in your area and how often you use your machine.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues during or after the descaling process, or if your machine continues to show a descaling alert, consider the following:

- **Consult Your Machine Manual:** Each Nespresso machine model has specific descaling instructions. Ensure you have followed them precisely.
- **Repeat Descaling:** In areas with very hard water or if the machine has not been descaled for a long time, a second descaling cycle might be necessary.
- **Contact Nespresso Support:** If problems persist, contact Nespresso customer service for further assistance.
