LAGRANGE 539001 Electric Citrus Juicer User Manual

Model: 539001

INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the LAGRANGE 539001 Electric Citrus Juicer. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and care of your appliance. Please read these instructions carefully before first use and keep them for future reference.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:

- Read all instructions before use.
- Do not immerse the motor base in water or other liquids.
- Ensure the voltage indicated on the appliance corresponds to your local mains voltage before connecting.
- Unplug from the outlet when not in use, before assembling or disassembling parts, and before cleaning.
- Avoid contact with moving parts.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- The use of attachments not recommended or sold by the manufacturer may cause fire, electric shock, or injury.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let the cord hang over the edge of a table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.

PRODUCT COMPONENTS

Familiarize yourself with the parts of your LAGRANGE 539001 Electric Citrus Juicer:

1. Motor Base with Power Cord
2. Juice Reservoir (0.5L capacity) with Graduated Window
3. Spout
4. Filter
5. Small Reamer (for limes, lemons)
6. Large Reamer (for oranges, grapefruits)
7. Protective Cover
8. Cord Storage (under the base)

SETUP

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
2. **Clean:** Before first use, wash all removable parts (juice reservoir, filter, reamers, protective cover) in warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry. Wipe the motor base with a damp cloth.
3. **Assemble:** Place the juice reservoir onto the motor base. Insert the filter into the reservoir. Select the appropriate reamer size for your fruit and place it onto the filter.
4. **Position:** Place the assembled juicer on a clean, dry, and stable surface.
5. **Connect:** Unwind the power cord from the integrated storage under the base and plug it into a suitable electrical outlet.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Prepare Fruit:** Cut citrus fruits (oranges, lemons, limes, grapefruits) in half.
2. **Select Reamer:** Choose the small reamer for smaller fruits like lemons and limes, and the large reamer for larger fruits like oranges and grapefruits. Place it securely on the filter.
3. **Juice Extraction:** Place a fruit half onto the reamer and press down gently. The motor will automatically

start. The juicer features dual rotation, which helps extract maximum juice.

4. **Monitor Juice Level:** Observe the graduated window on the juice reservoir to see the amount of juice collected. The maximum capacity is 0.5 liters.
5. **Serve:** Once juicing is complete, you can either pour the juice directly from the spout or remove the entire juice reservoir (carafe) for serving.
6. **Finish:** Release pressure from the reamer to stop the motor. Unplug the appliance from the power outlet after use.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your juicer.

1. **Unplug:** Always unplug the juicer from the power outlet before cleaning.
2. **Disassemble:** Remove the reamer, filter, and juice reservoir from the motor base.
3. **Wash Removable Parts:** Wash the reamer, filter, juice reservoir, and protective cover in warm, soapy water. A brush may be used to clean the filter mesh thoroughly. Rinse all parts under running water.
4. **Clean Motor Base:** Wipe the exterior of the motor base with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the motor base in water or any other liquid.
5. **Dry:** Ensure all parts are completely dry before reassembling or storing.
6. **Reassemble:** Reassemble the juicer by placing the filter into the reservoir, then the chosen reamer on top.

STORAGE

For convenient storage:

- Ensure the juicer is clean and dry.
- Place the protective cover over the reamer to keep it dust-free.
- Wrap the power cord around the integrated cord storage facility located under the motor base.
- Store the appliance in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and heat sources.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your juicer, please refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Juicer does not turn on.	Not plugged in correctly. No power from outlet.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working electrical outlet. Check the circuit breaker.
Low juice yield.	Insufficient pressure applied. Fruit not fresh. Incorrect reamer size.	Apply firm, consistent pressure. Use fresh, ripe citrus fruits. Ensure the correct reamer size is used for the fruit.
Motor stops during juicing.	Overheating due to continuous use. Too much pressure.	Allow the appliance to cool down for a few minutes. Reduce pressure on the reamer.
