## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides instructions for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of the Vacuum Part Pro Hose and Accessory Kit for the Hoover Power Scrub Elite PET Carpet Cleaner, Model FH50251. Please read these instructions carefully before use to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your accessories.

## 2. KIT CONTENTS

---

The accessory kit includes the following components:

- **(1) Attachment Hose:** A flexible hose designed to connect to your carpet cleaner for extended reach.
- **(1) Upholstery Tool:** An attachment for cleaning upholstery, stairs, and other hard-to-reach areas.
- **(1) Nozzle Cleaning Tool:** A small tool used to clear debris from the cleaning nozzle.

### 3. COMPATIBILITY

This accessory kit is specifically designed for use with the **Hoover Power Scrub Elite PET Carpet Cleaner, Model FH50251**. To confirm compatibility, locate the 4 to 6 digit model number on the silver sticker found on the back of your carpet cleaner.

### 4. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Prepare the Carpet Cleaner:** Ensure your Hoover Power Scrub Elite PET Carpet Cleaner (Model FH50251) is unplugged

and turned off before attaching any accessories.

2. **Connect the Attachment Hose:** Locate the accessory port on your carpet cleaner. Align the connector end of the attachment hose with the port and push firmly until it clicks securely into place.
3. **Attach the Upholstery Tool:** Select the upholstery tool. Push the open end of the upholstery tool onto the end of the attachment hose until it fits snugly.
4. **Fill Solution Tank:** Fill the clean water/solution tank on your carpet cleaner according to its specific instructions for spot cleaning or upholstery cleaning.
5. **Power On:** Plug in and turn on your carpet cleaner.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 5.1 Using the Upholstery Tool

1. **Pre-test:** Before cleaning, always test a small, inconspicuous area of the fabric for colorfastness.
2. **Apply Solution:** Hold the upholstery tool firmly against the surface to be cleaned. Press the trigger on the carpet cleaner handle (or the tool itself, if applicable) to spray cleaning solution.
3. **Scrub and Extract:** Move the tool slowly over the soiled area, applying gentle pressure. Release the trigger and pull the tool back over the wet area to extract the dirty solution.
4. **Repeat:** Continue cleaning in small sections, overlapping slightly, until the area is clean. Avoid over-wetting the fabric.
5. **Rinse (Optional):** For best results, you may rinse the area with clean water (if your carpet cleaner supports this function) and extract thoroughly.

### 5.2 Using the Nozzle Cleaning Tool

The nozzle cleaning tool is used to clear blockages from the spray nozzle of the upholstery tool or other attachments. If you notice reduced spray or uneven solution distribution, follow these steps:

1. **Disconnect Power:** Ensure the carpet cleaner is unplugged.
2. **Remove Attachment:** Detach the upholstery tool from the hose.
3. **Clear Nozzle:** Carefully insert the narrow end of the nozzle cleaning tool into the spray opening of the upholstery tool. Gently move it back and forth to dislodge any debris.
4. **Rinse:** Rinse the upholstery tool under running water to flush out any loosened debris.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

---

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and effectiveness of your accessory kit.

- **After Each Use:**

- Disconnect the attachment hose and upholstery tool from the carpet cleaner.
- Rinse the upholstery tool and the inside of the attachment hose thoroughly with clean water to remove any remaining cleaning solution or debris.
- Use the nozzle cleaning tool if necessary to clear any blockages in the upholstery tool's spray nozzle.
- Wipe down all components with a clean cloth.
- Allow all parts to air dry completely before storing.

- **Storage:** Store the hose and accessories in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No spray or reduced spray from upholstery tool.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Nozzle clogged.</li> <li>• Solution tank empty or improperly seated.</li> <li>• Hose not securely connected.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use the nozzle cleaning tool to clear debris.</li> <li>• Check solution tank level and ensure it is properly installed.</li> <li>• Verify the hose is firmly connected to the carpet cleaner and the upholstery tool.</li> </ul>
Poor suction from upholstery tool.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hose not securely connected.</li> <li>• Dirty water tank full or improperly seated.</li> <li>• Upholstery tool not making good seal with surface.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure all connections are secure.</li> <li>• Empty the dirty water tank and ensure it is properly seated.</li> <li>• Press the upholstery tool firmly against the surface to create a seal.</li> </ul>
