INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and efficient use of your Samsung Galaxy M20 smartphone. Please read this manual thoroughly before using your device to ensure proper operation and to prevent damage.

The Samsung Galaxy M20 is an international model designed for use with GSM SIM cards. It features a 6.3-inch Infinity-V display, a dual rear camera system, and a 5000 mAh battery.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

- Samsung Galaxy M20 Smartphone
- USB Charger Block
- USB Charging Cable
- Quick Start Guide (may vary by region)

If any items are missing or damaged, contact your retailer.

DEVICE LAYOUT

Familiarize yourself with the physical components of your Samsung Galaxy M20.

1. Charging the Battery

1. Connect the USB charging cable to the USB charger block.
2. Plug the charger block into a power outlet.
3. Connect the other end of the USB cable to the charging port on your Galaxy M20.
4. Allow the device to charge fully before first use. The device features a non-removable 5000 mAh Lithium Polymer battery with 15W fast charging capability.

2. Inserting a SIM Card

The Samsung Galaxy M20 supports GSM SIM cards. It will not work with CDMA carriers.

1. Locate the SIM card tray on the left side of the device (refer to Figure 4).
2. Insert the SIM ejection tool (not included, typically comes with the SIM card) into the small hole on the SIM tray to eject it.
3. Place your Nano-SIM card(s) into the tray with the gold contacts facing down.
4. Carefully reinsert the tray into the device.

3. Initial Power On and Configuration

1. Press and hold the Power button (located on the right side) until the Samsung logo appears.
2. Follow the on-screen prompts to select your language, connect to Wi-Fi, set up your Google account, and configure security features like fingerprint or face unlock.

OPERATING YOUR DEVICE

Basic Navigation

- **Touchscreen:** Interact with the device by tapping, swiping, pinching, and spreading on the 6.3-inch display.
- **Power Button:** Press to turn the screen on/off. Press and hold to power off or restart the device.
- **Volume Buttons:** Adjust media volume, ringtone volume, and alarm volume.

Connectivity

- **Wi-Fi:** Connect to wireless networks for internet access. Go to *Settings > Connections > Wi-Fi*
- **Mobile Data:** Enable or disable mobile data for internet access via your SIM card. Go to *Settings > Connections > Data usage*. The device supports 2G, 3G, and 4G LTE cellular technologies.
- **Bluetooth:** Pair with other Bluetooth devices like headphones or speakers. Go to *Settings > Connections > Bluetooth*.
- **GPS:** The device includes GPS functionality for location services.

Camera Usage

The Galaxy M20 features a dual rear camera and a front camera.

1. Open the Camera application.

2. Select your desired mode (e.g., Photo, Video, Live Focus).
3. Tap the shutter button to capture an image or start/stop video recording.

Security Features

Unlock your device using biometric authentication:

- **Fingerprint Sensor:** Register your fingerprints via *Settings > Biometrics and security > Fingerprints*.
- **Face Recognition:** Set up face unlock via *Settings > Biometrics and security > Face recognition*.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning Your Device

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body of the device.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or compressed air.

Software Updates

Regularly check for and install software updates to ensure optimal performance and security. Go to *Settings > Software update*.

Battery Care

- Avoid exposing the device to extreme temperatures.
- Use only Samsung-approved chargers and cables.
- The 5000 mAh battery is non-removable. Do not attempt to replace it yourself.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Solution
Device does not power on	Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the charger and wait a few minutes before attempting to power on again.
Cannot connect to network	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Verify that a valid GSM SIM card is properly inserted. ◦ Check network settings (<i>Settings > Connections > Mobile networks</i>). ◦ Restart the device. ◦ Note: This international model is not compatible with CDMA carriers (e.g., Sprint, Verizon, US Cellular).
Battery drains quickly	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Close unused applications running in the background. ◦ Reduce screen brightness. ◦ Disable Wi-Fi, Bluetooth, or GPS when not in use. ◦ Check battery usage in <i>Settings > Device care > Battery</i> to identify power-consuming apps.
Apps are slow or unresponsive	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Close unnecessary applications. ◦ Clear app cache (<i>Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Storage > Clear cache</i>). ◦ Restart the device.
