1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your MCombo Model 0870 Wooden Garden Storage Cabinet. Please read all instructions carefully before beginning assembly and retain this manual for future reference.

1.1 Safety Information

- Always assemble the cabinet on a flat, stable surface.
- Ensure all components are securely fastened before use.
- Keep small parts and packaging materials away from children.
- Use appropriate safety gear, such as gloves, during assembly.
- Two people are recommended for assembly to ensure safety and ease of installation.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The MCombo Model 0870 is a durable wooden garden storage cabinet designed for outdoor use. It features a robust fir wood construction and a weather-resistant asphalt roof, providing protection against rain and UV rays. The cabinet offers generous storage space with adjustable shelves to accommodate various garden tools and accessories.

2.1 Key Features

- **Spacious Storage:** Equipped with two adjustable shelves, providing flexible storage for various items. Each shelf supports up to 40 kg.
- **Durable Construction:** Made from high-quality FSC certified fir wood, designed for long-term outdoor use.
- **Weather Protection:** Features a green asphalt roof for rain protection and overall weather resistance, including UV rays.
- **Secure Closure:** Double doors with magnetic catches and a metal latch ensure secure closure.
- **Stability:** Includes fixing pegs for additional stability.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before assembly, verify that all parts are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, please contact customer support.

3.1 Components

- Pre-cut fir wood panels for walls, doors, roof, and shelves.
- Green asphalt roofing material.
- Metal hardware: handles, latch, hinges, magnetic catches, corner reinforcement brackets.
- Assorted screws and fasteners (typically numbered in separate bags).
- Fixing pegs for ground anchoring.

3.2 Tools Required (Not Included)

- Phillips head screwdriver or power drill with appropriate bit.
- Hammer (optional, for fixing pegs).
- Measuring tape.
- Level.

4. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the numbered diagrams provided with your product for precise step-by-step assembly. The following is a general guide.

1. **Prepare the Area:** Choose a level, stable location for the cabinet. Clear any debris.
2. **Unpack Components:** Carefully unpack all parts and lay them out. Refer to the parts list in your product packaging to identify each component. The parts and screws are typically numbered for easy identification.
3. **Assemble the Base:** Connect the base panels according to the diagrams, ensuring all joints are flush and secure.
4. **Attach Side Panels:** Securely attach the side panels to the base. This step often requires two people to hold panels in place while fasteners are applied.
5. **Install Back Panels:** Fasten the back panels to the assembled sides and base.
6. **Install Shelves:** Insert the adjustable shelves into the desired positions. Ensure they are level and properly supported. The shelves can be removed or repositioned later.
7. **Attach Doors:** Mount the doors to the front frame using the provided hinges. Ensure the doors swing freely and align correctly.
8. **Install Door Hardware:** Attach the handles, magnetic catches, and the main latch mechanism to the doors and frame.

9. **Assemble and Attach Roof:** Construct the roof section, including the asphalt material, and then securely attach it to the top of the cabinet. Ensure the roof overhangs properly to shed water.
10. **Secure with Fixing Pegs:** For added stability, especially in windy conditions, use the provided fixing pegs to anchor the cabinet to the ground.

5. OPERATION

Using your MCombo Garden Storage Cabinet is straightforward.

- **Opening/Closing Doors:** Use the handles to open and close the double doors. The magnetic catches will help keep the doors closed, and the metal latch provides additional security.
- **Adjusting Shelves:** The interior shelves are removable and adjustable. To reposition a shelf, carefully lift it out of its current supports and place it onto new supports at the desired height. Ensure the shelf is stable before placing items on it.
- **Loading Capacity:** Each shelf is designed to hold up to 40 kg. Do not exceed this weight limit to prevent damage to the shelves or cabinet structure.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper maintenance will extend the lifespan and appearance of your garden cabinet.

- **Cleaning:** Clean the cabinet regularly with a damp cloth to remove dirt and dust. Avoid harsh chemicals that may damage the wood finish.
- **Wood Treatment:** The fir wood is treated for outdoor use, but applying an additional coat of wood stain or varnish annually is recommended to enhance protection against weathering and maintain its appearance.
- **Roof Inspection:** Periodically inspect the asphalt roof for any damage or wear. Ensure it remains intact to provide optimal rain protection.
- **Hardware Check:** Regularly check all screws, hinges, and latches to ensure they are tight and functioning correctly. Tighten any loose fasteners.
- **Winter Care:** While designed for year-round outdoor use, consider covering the cabinet during harsh winter conditions for additional protection.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Doors do not close properly:** Check if the cabinet is on a level surface. Adjust the hinges if necessary, or ensure no obstructions are preventing closure.
- **Cabinet feels unstable:** Ensure all assembly screws are tightened. Verify that the cabinet is on a firm, level surface. Use the provided fixing pegs to anchor it to the ground.
- **Water leakage:** Inspect the asphalt roof for any damage or gaps. Ensure all roof panels are securely attached and sealed.
