Introduction

This instruction manual provides detailed guidance for the assembly, setup, and maintenance of your Bandai RG-04 MS-06F Mass Production Model Zaku model kit. Please read all instructions carefully before beginning assembly to ensure a smooth and enjoyable building experience. This kit is designed for model enthusiasts aged 12 years and above.

Safety Information

Please observe the following safety precautions during assembly and handling:

- **Small Parts:** This kit contains small parts that may pose a choking hazard. Keep out of reach of children under 3 years of age.
- **Sharp Edges:** Some parts may have sharp edges or points. Handle with care to prevent injury.
- **Tools:** Use appropriate modeling tools (e.g., nippers, hobby knife) carefully. Always cut away from your body.
- **Ventilation:** If using paints, glues, or markers, ensure adequate ventilation.
- **Disposal:** Dispose of waste materials responsibly.

Parts List

- Multiple plastic runners (frames) with molded parts
- Polycaps (for joints)
- Decal sheet (stickers or water-slide decals)

Assembly Instructions

Follow the numbered steps in the included instruction booklet. The general assembly process involves:

1. **Preparation:** Carefully cut parts from the runners using nippers. Use a hobby knife or sandpaper to clean any nubs or excess plastic.
2. **Sub-Assembly:** Assemble smaller sections first, such as limbs, head, and torso, as indicated in the manual.
3. **Main Assembly:** Connect the sub-assemblies to form the complete model.
4. **Decals:** Apply decals according to the placement guide in the instruction booklet. Use tweezers for precise application.
5. **Final Touches:** Ensure all parts are securely attached.

Refer to the specific diagrams and part numbers in your kit's manual for accurate assembly.

Setup

Before starting assembly, ensure your workspace is clean, well-lit, and organized. Have all necessary tools, such as nippers, a hobby knife, and tweezers, readily available. Lay out the runners in an organized manner to easily identify parts as you proceed through the assembly steps.

Operating (Posing and Display)

Once assembled, your model kit is ready for posing and display. The RG (Real Grade) line features advanced inner frames for a wide range of articulation.

- **Posing:** Gently manipulate the joints to achieve desired poses. Avoid excessive force to prevent breakage.
- **Stability:** Ensure the model is balanced in its pose to prevent it from falling. Consider using an action base (sold separately) for dynamic poses.
- **Handling:** Always handle the model by its main body or sturdy parts to avoid damaging delicate components.

Maintenance

Proper maintenance will preserve the appearance and longevity of your model kit:

- **Cleaning:** Dust the model regularly with a soft brush or a can of compressed air. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Storage:** Store the model in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight to prevent discoloration or material degradation.
- **Repairs:** If parts become loose or detached, use plastic cement (for plastic parts) or super glue (for non-plastic parts, if applicable) sparingly to reattach them.

Troubleshooting

Encountering issues during assembly or display is uncommon but can occur. Here are some common problems and their solutions:

- **Parts Not Fitting:** Ensure you are using the correct parts for the step. Check for excess plastic (nubs) that may be preventing a flush fit and trim as necessary.
- **Loose Joints:** If a joint is too loose, a thin layer of clear nail polish or a specialized joint-tightening solution can be applied to the ball or peg to increase friction.
- **Decals Not Adhering:** Ensure the surface is clean and dry. For water-slide decals, use decal setting solution to help them conform to the surface and adhere better.
- **Missing Parts:** Double-check the runners and packaging. If a part is genuinely missing, contact Bandai customer support.
