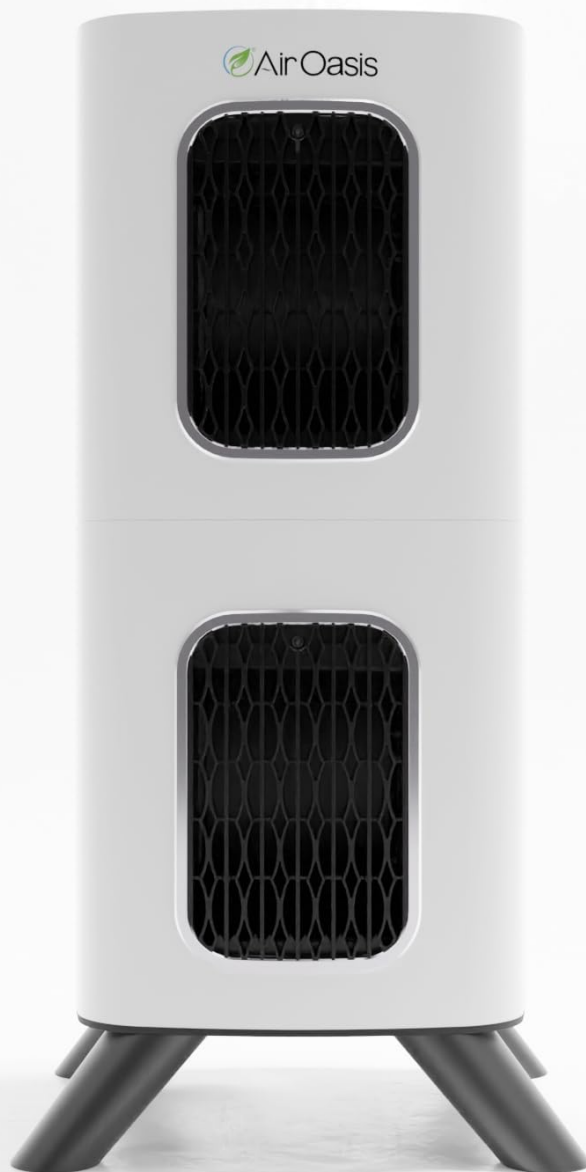

Air Oasis iAdaptAir 2.0 Air Purifier Instruction Manual

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Air Oasis iAdaptAir 2.0 is an advanced air purification system designed to significantly improve indoor air quality. This model (AOIA-M) is engineered to cover up to 2,650 square feet in one hour, or 530 square feet with 5 air exchanges per hour, making it suitable for medium to large spaces. It utilizes a comprehensive 5-stage filtration process to reduce a wide range of airborne contaminants.

Key Features:

- **5-Stage Filtration System:** Incorporates Medical-Grade HEPA (H13), Carbon Filtration, Silver Ion Screen, Bi-Polar Ionization, and UV Light for comprehensive air purification.
- **High Clean Air Delivery Rate (CADR):** Efficiently cleans air in large areas, covering up to 2,650 sq. ft. in one hour.
- **Allergen and Contaminant Reduction:** Reduces up to 99% of viruses, mold, dust, smoke, pet dander, pollen, and odors.
- **Quiet Operation:** Engineered for low noise levels, operating at approximately 25 dB.
- **Smart Control:** Features a touch-sensitive control panel and Wi-Fi compatibility for remote monitoring and control via a mobile application. The Wi-Fi chip is removable for EMF-sensitive users.
- **Air Quality Sensor:** Automatically adjusts fan speed based on real-time indoor air quality readings.
- **Long-Life Filters:** Designed for extended use, with filters lasting up to 2 years under typical operating conditions.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the air purifier from its packaging. Retain all packaging materials for future storage or transport.
2. **Placement:** Place the unit on a flat, stable surface. Ensure there is adequate space around the air intake and outlet grilles for optimal airflow. Avoid placing the unit directly against walls or furniture.
3. **Filter Installation/Verification:**

The filters are located at the top of the unit. Open the top cover by pressing the designated "Press here and Pop-up" button. Verify that the filters are correctly seated and remove any protective packaging from them before first use. Close the top cover securely.

4. **Power Connection:** Connect the power cord to the air purifier and then plug it into a standard electrical outlet (120V AC).
5. **Initial Power On:** Press the power button on the control panel to turn on the unit. The unit will perform an initial air quality assessment.

Control Panel Overview:

- **Power Button:** Press to turn the unit On or Off.
- **Fan Speed Button:** Press to cycle through different fan speed levels (Low, Medium, High, Max).
- **Auto Mode:** When activated, the unit automatically adjusts fan speed based on detected air quality. The "AUTO" indicator will blink when active.
- **UV Light Control:** The UV light can be toggled On/Off via the control panel or app. The UV indicator will illuminate when active.
- **Ionizer Control:** The ionizer function can be toggled On/Off. The Ionizer indicator will illuminate when active.
- **Sleep Mode:** Activates a quiet operation mode with dimmed lights for undisturbed rest.
- **Timer Button:** Set a fixed shutdown time, which can be cycled between 1-12 hours or Off.
- **Filter Life Indicator:** Displays the remaining life of the filter as a percentage.

- **Air Quality Display (PM2.5):** Shows the concentration of particulate matter (PM2.5) in $\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$.

Air Quality Indicator:

Green (0-75 $\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$): Good air quality.

Orange (76-150 $\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$): Fair air quality.

Wi-Fi Connectivity and App Control:

The iAdaptAir 2.0 is Wi-Fi enabled, allowing for remote control and monitoring via the Air Oasis Home App. The Wi-Fi chip is removable for users concerned about EMF exposure.

To connect:

1. Download the Air Oasis Home App from your device's app store.

2. Follow the in-app instructions to pair your device.
3. Once connected, you can control fan speed, UV/Ionizer functions, set custom schedules, view remaining filter life, and monitor indoor air quality from your smartphone.

MAINTENANCE

Filter Replacement:

The iAdaptAir 2.0 uses a long-life 3-in-1 filter designed to last up to 2 years, depending on usage and air quality. The unit's control panel and mobile app will indicate the remaining filter life.

1. **Power Off:** Turn off and unplug the air purifier before performing any maintenance.
2. **Open Top Cover:** Press the "Press here and Pop-up" button on the top panel to open the filter compartment.
3. **Remove Old Filters:** Gently pull out the used filter cartridges.
4. **Install New Filters:** Insert new Air Oasis iAdaptAir 2.0 replacement filters, ensuring they are correctly oriented and seated.
5. **Close Cover:** Close the top cover securely.
6. **Reset Filter Life:** After replacing the filters, reset the filter life indicator on the control panel or through the mobile app as per the instructions in the user guide.

For replacement filters, refer to the QR code on the unit's top panel or visit the Air Oasis website.

TROUBLESHOOTING

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|---------------------------|--|--|
| Unit does not turn on. | No power, loose connection. | Ensure power cord is securely plugged into the unit and a working outlet. Check circuit breaker. |
| Airflow is weak or noisy. | Clogged filters, obstructed air intake/outlet. | Check and replace filters if necessary. Ensure no objects are blocking air grilles. |

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|---|--|--|
| Air quality reading is consistently "Poor" (Red). | High particulate levels, sensor obstruction. | Allow unit to run on Auto mode for an extended period. Ensure sensor is clean and not obstructed. Identify and remove sources of pollution. |
| Wi-Fi connection issues. | Incorrect Wi-Fi password, router issues, Wi-Fi chip removed. | Verify Wi-Fi password. Restart router and air purifier. Ensure Wi-Fi chip is installed if app control is desired. Consult app's troubleshooting guide. |
| Filter life percentage not resetting after replacement. | Filter reset procedure not followed. | Follow the specific filter reset instructions in the full user manual or app. |


