1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Artemide Tolomeo Table Lamp Micro. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient use of your new lamp. The Tolomeo Micro is designed with a fully adjustable, articulated anodized aluminum arm and body, featuring die-cast aluminum joints and tension control knobs for precise positioning. Its monochromatic matte finish complements various interior styles.

Please read this manual thoroughly before installation and operation, and retain it for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Observe the following safety precautions to prevent injury or damage to the lamp:

- Ensure the power supply voltage matches the lamp's requirements (120V).
- Always disconnect the lamp from the power outlet before cleaning, changing the bulb, or performing any maintenance.
- Do not exceed the maximum wattage specified for the bulb (100W max). Use only E26 (medium base) A19 compatible incandescent, compact fluorescent, or LED lamps.
- Avoid touching the bulb directly after use, as it may be hot.
- Do not operate the lamp with a damaged cord or plug. If damaged, contact qualified service personnel.
- Keep the lamp away from water or other liquids. Do not use in damp or wet locations.
- Ensure the lamp base is placed on a stable, level surface to prevent tipping.
- This lamp is designed for indoor use only.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present in the package:

- Artemide Tolomeo Table Lamp Micro (Articulated Arm, Head, Base)
- Power Cable

- *Bulb not included.*

4. SETUP

4.1 Unpacking and Placement

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Place the lamp base on a flat, stable surface. Ensure there is sufficient space for the articulated arm to extend and adjust without obstruction.

4.2 Bulb Installation

1. Ensure the lamp is unplugged from the power outlet.
2. Gently unscrew the lamp head to access the bulb socket.
3. Insert an E26 (medium base) A19 compatible bulb, ensuring it does not exceed 100W.
4. Screw the lamp head back into place securely.

4.3 Power Connection

Plug the power cable into a standard 120V electrical outlet. Ensure the cable is not pinched or routed in a way that could cause a tripping hazard.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Turning On/Off

The Artemide Tolomeo Table Lamp Micro features a touch switch for convenient operation. Locate the touch-sensitive area on the lamp (typically on the base or head, refer to product specifics if available). A single touch will turn the lamp on or off.

5.2 Adjusting the Lamp

The lamp's articulated arm and head offer extensive adjustability:

- **Arm Adjustment:** Gently move the articulated aluminum arm to position the light source as desired. The tension control knobs at the joints allow for smooth movement and stable positioning.
- **Shade Rotation:** The lamp head can rotate 360 degrees, allowing you to direct light precisely where needed.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning

Always unplug the lamp before cleaning.

- Wipe the aluminum surfaces with a soft, dry cloth.
- For stubborn marks, use a slightly damp cloth with a mild, non-abrasive cleaner. Dry immediately.
- Do not use harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or solvents, as these can damage the finish.

6.2 Bulb Replacement

Refer to section 4.2 for detailed bulb installation instructions. Ensure the lamp is unplugged and the bulb has cooled down before attempting to replace it.

6.3 Tension Adjustment

If the articulated arm feels too loose or too stiff, the tension control knobs at the joints can be adjusted. Turn them clockwise to increase tension or counter-clockwise to decrease tension, finding a comfortable balance for movement and stability.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your lamp, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Lamp does not turn on.	No power to the outlet. Bulb is loose or burnt out. Power cable is not properly connected.	Check the wall outlet with another device or test the circuit breaker. Unplug the lamp, check/replace the bulb (E26, 100W max). Ensure the power cable is securely plugged into both the lamp and the outlet.
Light flickers.	Loose bulb. Incompatible bulb type. Faulty electrical connection.	Unplug the lamp and tighten the bulb. Ensure you are using an E26 (medium base) A19 compatible bulb. If flickering persists, contact customer support.
Arm does not hold position.	Tension control knobs are too loose.	Adjust the tension control knobs clockwise to increase tension.
