## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

The Prolux Core 13" Pad Set offers versatility for various hard-floor cleaning tasks. Always refer to your Prolux Core floor buffer's main instruction manual for general operation guidelines.

### Pad Usage Guide:

- **Stripping Pads:** Use these pads for removing old wax, sealants, or heavy buildup from hard floors. Apply appropriate stripping solution as per product instructions.
- **Polishing Pads:** Designed for buffing and polishing floors to a high shine after cleaning or waxing. Use with suitable polishing compounds or dry buffing.
- **Waxing Pads:** Apply new coats of wax or floor finish evenly onto surfaces. Ensure the floor is clean and dry before applying wax.

Always test the chosen pad and solution on an inconspicuous area of the floor first to ensure desired results and prevent damage.

## 5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

---

Proper maintenance of your pads will extend their lifespan and ensure optimal performance.

- **Cleaning Pads:** After each use, remove the pad from the buffer. Rinse the pad thoroughly with water to

remove any residue, dirt, or cleaning solutions. For heavily soiled pads, a mild detergent can be used.

- **Drying Pads:** Allow pads to air dry completely before storing them. Do not store wet pads, as this can lead to mildew or damage.
- **Storage:** Store pads in a clean, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect pads for wear and tear. Replace pads that are excessively worn, torn, or no longer effective to maintain cleaning efficiency and protect your floors.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

- **Pads not attaching securely:** Ensure the pad holder is clean and free of debris. Verify that you are using the correct 13-inch pads for your Prolux Core model (2021 and older).
- **Poor cleaning/polishing results:**
  - Check if the correct type of pad is being used for the task (stripping, polishing, waxing).
  - Ensure the pads are clean and not overly saturated or clogged with old product.
  - Inspect pads for excessive wear; replace if necessary.

- Confirm that the appropriate cleaning or finishing solution is being used according to its instructions.
- **Pads wearing out quickly:** This may indicate improper use, abrasive floor surfaces, or insufficient cleaning after use. Ensure pads are cleaned and dried properly after each use.
