## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your Microsoft Xbox 360 Wireless A/B/G Network Adapter. This adapter enables your Xbox 360 console to connect to a wireless network, facilitating access to Xbox Live, streaming media, and other online features without the need for wired connections.

### 3. SETUP

Follow these steps to connect and configure your Wireless Network Adapter with your Xbox 360 console:

1. **Power Off Console:** Ensure your Xbox 360 console is powered off before connecting the adapter.
2. **Connect Adapter:** Plug the USB connector of the Wireless Network Adapter into an available USB port on the back of your Xbox 360 console. The adapter is designed to attach directly to the back of the console.

3. **Adjust Antenna:** Position the adapter's antenna for optimal signal reception.

4. **Power On Console:** Turn on your Xbox 360 console.
5. **Access Network Settings:** From the Xbox 360 Dashboard, navigate to the **System Settings** menu, then select **Network Settings**.
6. **Configure Wireless Network:**
  - Select **Wireless Network**. The console will scan for available wireless networks.
  - Choose your desired wireless network from the list.
  - If prompted, enter your network's wireless password (security key). Ensure correct capitalization.
  - Confirm the settings. The console will attempt to connect to the network.
7. **Test Xbox Live Connection:** After successful network connection, you can test your Xbox Live connection from the Network Settings menu to ensure full functionality.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once the Wireless Network Adapter is successfully configured, your Xbox 360 console will automatically connect to the configured wireless network when powered on. You can then:

- Access Xbox Live for online multiplayer gaming, digital content downloads, and communication.
- Stream photos, music, and videos from compatible devices on your home network, such as a Microsoft Windows XP Media Center based PC.
- Browse the internet using the console's web browser (if available and supported).

To switch between wireless networks or modify network settings, repeat steps 5 and 6 from the Setup section.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

---

The Wireless Network Adapter requires minimal maintenance. Follow these guidelines to ensure its longevity:

- **Cleaning:** Gently wipe the adapter with a soft, dry cloth to remove dust. Avoid using liquid cleaners or abrasive materials.
- **Placement:** Ensure the adapter is not obstructed by other objects, which could interfere with wireless signal reception.
- **Handling:** Avoid bending or twisting the antenna excessively, as this may cause damage.
- **Storage:** If storing the adapter for an extended period, disconnect it from the console and store it in a cool, dry place.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues with your Wireless Network Adapter, refer to the following troubleshooting steps:

- **No Network Detected:**
  - Ensure the adapter is securely plugged into a USB port on the Xbox 360.
  - Verify that your wireless router is powered on and broadcasting a signal.
  - Move the Xbox 360 closer to the wireless router or adjust the adapter's antenna.
  - Restart both your Xbox 360 and your wireless router.
- **Unable to Connect to Network:**
  - Double-check the wireless password (security key) for accuracy, paying attention to capitalization.
  - Confirm that your wireless router is using a compatible security protocol (WPA, WPA2, WEP). **Note:** Some older adapters may have limited support for newer security protocols like WPA2 or WPA3, potentially only supporting WEP. If your router is set to a newer protocol, you may need to adjust its settings (if possible and secure) or consider a different adapter.
  - Ensure your router's MAC filtering is not enabled or that the Xbox 360's MAC address is added to the allowed list.
- **Slow Connection or Frequent Disconnections:**
  - Reduce interference by moving other wireless devices (cordless phones, microwaves) away from the Xbox 360 and router.
  - Adjust the adapter's antenna position.
  - If your router supports it, try changing the wireless channel to one with less congestion.

- Ensure your router's firmware is up to date.
- **Adapter Indicator Light:** A solid green light typically indicates a successful connection. If the light is off or blinking erratically, recheck connections and power.

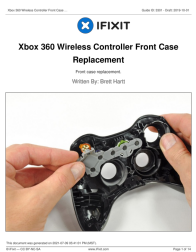
