SETUP

Ecolab Solid Laundry Detergent is designed for use in commercial laundry systems with compatible dispensing equipment.

Installation of Solid Capsule

1. Ensure the laundry dispensing system is turned off and locked out according to facility procedures.
2. Open the dispenser housing.
3. Carefully remove the empty solid detergent capsule, if present.
4. Insert the new Ecolab Solid Laundry Detergent capsule (Model 6102325) into the designated slot in the dispenser. Ensure it is seated correctly.
5. Close and secure the dispenser housing.
6. Verify that the system recognizes the new capsule and is ready for operation.

The solid capsule packaging promotes safe operation and reduces physical strain/effort during replacement.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This detergent is intended for use in low-temperature commercial laundry applications. The dispensing system will automatically deliver the correct amount of detergent based on the programmed wash cycle.

General Usage

1. Load laundry into the washing machine according to manufacturer's guidelines, ensuring not to overload.
2. Select the appropriate low-temperature wash cycle for the fabric type and soil level.
3. Start the wash cycle. The Ecolab dispensing system will automatically add the required amount of solid detergent.
4. Monitor the wash process. The solid laundry program includes an out-of-product alarm to advance simplified procedures and training, indicating when a capsule replacement is needed.

For optimal results, follow the specific wash program recommendations provided by your laundry equipment manufacturer and Ecolab representative.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance of the dispensing system is crucial for consistent performance.

Dispenser Cleaning

- Periodically inspect the detergent dispenser for any residue buildup.
- Clean the dispenser components as recommended by the dispenser manufacturer or your Ecolab service technician.
- Ensure all parts are dry before reassembling.

Capsule Storage

- Store unused capsules in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and incompatible materials.
- Keep capsules in their original packaging until ready for use.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with the Ecolab Low Temp Laundry Solid Detergent or its dispensing system, refer to the following common problems and solutions.

Common Issues

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Poor cleaning results	Incorrect dosage; dispenser malfunction; wrong wash cycle	Check dispenser settings; ensure capsule is correctly installed; verify wash cycle selection
"Out of product" alarm	Capsule is empty or not detected	Replace the solid detergent capsule; ensure it is properly seated
Detergent not dissolving	Water temperature too low; dispenser blockage	Verify water temperature; inspect dispenser for blockages
