1. Setup

This section guides you through the initial setup of your Vangoa VGD610 Portable Electric Piano.

1.1 Unboxing and Initial Inspection

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Verify that the following items are included:

- 1 x 61-Key Electric Keyboard
- 1 x Keyboard Sustain Pedal
- 1 x 61-Key Electric Keyboard Bag
- 1 x USB Power Cable

Inspect all items for any signs of damage. If any components are missing or damaged, please contact Vangoa customer support.

1.2 Powering the Keyboard

The VGD610 can be powered in two ways:

- **Via USB Power Cable:** Connect the provided USB power cable to the micro USB port on the keyboard and to a standard USB power adapter (not included) or a computer's USB port.
- **Via Built-in Battery:** The keyboard features a built-in 1750mAh rechargeable lithium battery, offering up to 8 hours of playing time on a full charge (2-3 hours charging time).

1.3 Connecting Accessories

The VGD610 offers various connectivity options:

- **Sustain Pedal:** Connect the included sustain pedal to the 'Sustain Pedal' jack on the rear panel for expressive playing.
- **Headphones:** For private practice, connect 3.5mm headphones to the 'Phone Output' jack.
- **External Audio:** Connect external speakers or an amplifier to the 'Phone Output' jack for louder sound.
- **Audio Input:** Use the 'Audio Input' jack to connect an external audio source (e.g., MP3 player, phone)

and play along.

- **Bluetooth MIDI:** Pair your device (phone, PC, tablet) via Bluetooth to use the keyboard with learning apps or DAW software.

2. Operating Instructions

Familiarize yourself with the control panel and various functions of your VGD610 electric piano.

2.1 Control Panel Overview

The control panel features an LED display and various buttons for selecting voices, rhythms, demo songs, and other functions.

2.2 Voice and Rhythm Selection

- **Voices (Tones):** The keyboard has 128 standard GM timbres. Use the 'Voice' button and number keys to select different instrument sounds.
- **Rhythms:** Choose from 128 rhythms using the 'Style' button and number keys to add accompaniment to your playing.

2.3 Demo Songs and Learning Functions

- **Demo Songs:** Access 20 built-in demo songs using the 'Song' button.
- **Dual Function:** Layer two voices simultaneously for a richer sound.
- **Split Function:** Divide the keyboard into two sections, each with a different voice, allowing two players or different instrument sounds on each hand.

2.4 Recording and Playback

Use the 'Record' and 'Play' buttons to capture and review your performances.

2.5 Touch Sensitivity

The 61 full-size keys are touch-sensitive, meaning the volume and tone of the notes change based on how hard you press the keys, providing a more expressive playing experience.

3. Maintenance

Proper care will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Vangoa VGD610.

3.1 General Care

- Keep the keyboard clean by wiping it with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Store the keyboard in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and humidity.
- When transporting, use the provided carrying case to protect the instrument from dust and physical damage.

3.2 Battery Care

To maximize battery life and performance:

- Fully charge the battery before first use.
- Avoid completely draining the battery frequently.
- If storing for an extended period, charge the battery to approximately 50% every few months.

4. Troubleshooting

If you encounter any issues with your VGD610, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound from speakers/headphones	Volume too low; headphones not fully inserted; external speakers off/unconnected.	Increase master volume; ensure headphones are fully inserted; check external speaker power and connections.
Keyboard does not power on	Battery drained; power cable loose/faulty; power adapter not working.	Charge the battery; ensure power cable is securely connected; try a different power source or adapter.
Keys not responding or inconsistent volume	Touch sensitivity setting off/low; dirty keys.	Check touch sensitivity settings on the control panel; clean keys with a soft, dry cloth.
Bluetooth connection issues	Device not in pairing mode; interference; distance too far.	Ensure keyboard and device are in pairing mode; reduce distance; minimize interference from other devices.
