SETUP

To begin watching Atoll K, follow these simple steps:

4. **Region Compatibility:** Please note that the Blu-ray disc is Region B and the DVD is Region 2. Ensure your player is compatible with these regions or is region-free.
5. **Power On:** Turn on your player and television/monitor. The disc should auto-play or present a menu.

Main Feature: Atoll K

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper care of your discs will ensure their longevity and optimal playback performance:

- **Handling:** Always hold discs by their edges or the center hole. Avoid touching the playback surface.
- **Cleaning:** If a disc becomes dirty, gently wipe it with a soft, lint-free cloth from the center outwards. Do not use

abrasive materials or harsh chemicals.

- **Storage:** Store discs in their original cases, away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity.
- **Avoid Scratches:** Be careful not to scratch the disc surface, as this can lead to playback errors.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues during playback, consider the following common solutions:

Problem	Solution
Disc not playing or loading.	Ensure the disc is inserted correctly. Check for smudges or scratches and clean if necessary. Verify your player is compatible with Blu-ray (for Blu-ray disc) or DVD (for DVD disc). Confirm region compatibility (Blu-ray: Region B, DVD: Region 2).
Video or audio skipping/freezing.	Clean the disc thoroughly. Check for deep scratches. Try playing the disc in another compatible player to rule out player issues.
No audio.	Check your player's audio settings and your TV/receiver volume. Ensure audio cables are securely connected.
Menu navigation issues.	Ensure your remote control batteries are working. Some players may require a firmware update for optimal disc compatibility.
