INTRODUCTION

The CoolFire Solar Atomic Analog Watch Model 1531 is a precision timepiece designed for reliability and accuracy. This watch features solar power for continuous operation and atomic time synchronization for automatic time adjustment, ensuring consistent and accurate timekeeping. Its robust construction and water resistance make it suitable for various environments and daily wear.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the components of your CoolFire Solar Atomic Analog Watch.

- **Dial:** Displays analog time (hours, minutes, seconds).
- **Crown:** Used for manual time adjustments and setting functions.
- **Pushers:** Buttons on the side of the case for accessing various watch functions.
- **LCD Display:** A small digital window, typically at the 3 o'clock position, showing date and other information.
- **Solar Panel:** Integrated into the watch face, converts light into energy.
- **Case Back:** Contains model information and water resistance rating.

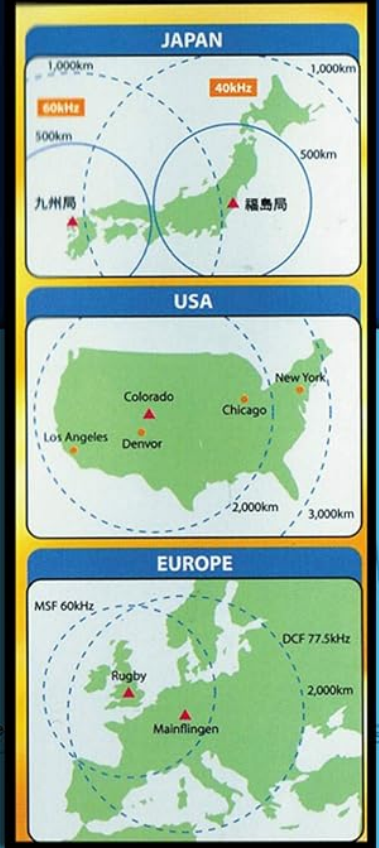


Image: Front view of the CoolFire Solar Atomic Analog Watch Model 1531, showcasing the dial, hands, and pushers.

SETUP

1. Initial Charge

Before initial use, ensure your watch is fully charged. The watch utilizes a solar panel integrated into the dial to convert light into electrical energy, which is stored in a rechargeable battery. Place the watch in direct sunlight or under a strong artificial light source for several hours. Avoid covering the watch face during charging.

A charging lamp and USB cable are included for supplemental charging if direct light exposure is insufficient or unavailable. Connect the USB cable to the charging lamp, then place the watch on the lamp to charge.

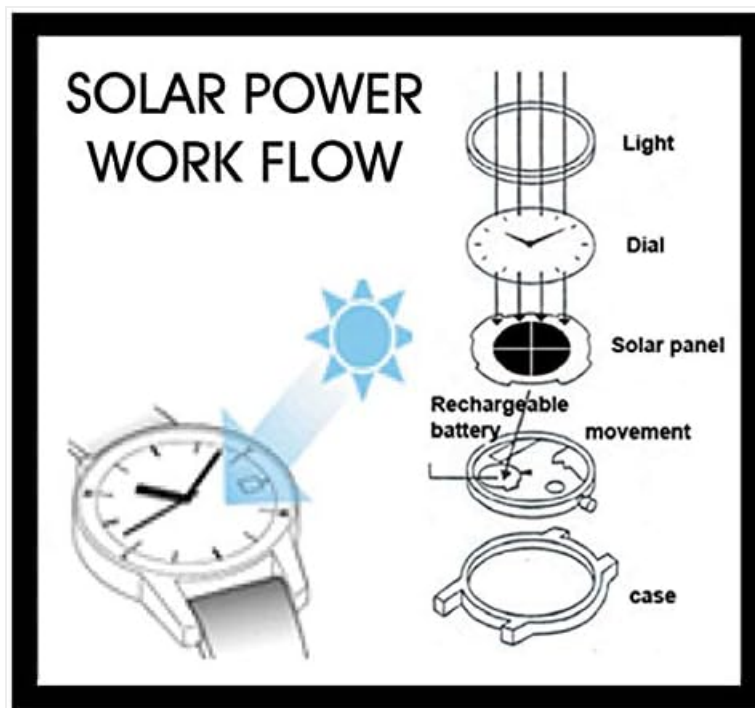


Image: A circular charging lamp with a USB connection, designed to provide light for the watch's solar panel.

2. Time Zone Setting and Atomic Synchronization

The watch automatically synchronizes with atomic time signals to maintain precise time. To ensure the correct time display for your location, you must set your local time zone. Refer to the original instruction manual for specific button presses and crown

operations to adjust the time zone setting.

The watch receives signals from various global transmitters. For optimal reception, place the watch near a window, ideally facing the direction of the nearest signal transmitter, especially overnight when synchronization typically occurs.

- **Japan:** Transmitters at 40kHz and 60kHz, covering a range of up to 1,000km.
- **USA:** Transmitter in Colorado at 60kHz, covering a range of up to 3,000km, reaching cities like Los Angeles, Denver, Chicago, and New York.
- **Europe:** Transmitters at Rugby (MSF 60kHz) and Mainflingen (DCF 77.5kHz), covering a range of up to 2,000km.

3. Manual Time Setting (If Atomic Signal Unavailable)

In locations where the atomic time signal is weak or cannot be received, the watch can be set manually. This process typically involves pulling out the crown and using the pushers to adjust the hour, minute, and second hands, as well as the date on the LCD display. Refer to the detailed instructions in your original manual for the precise steps, as the small LCD display can be challenging to read.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Time Display

The watch displays time using traditional analog hour, minute, and second hands. The small LCD display typically shows the date (day of the week and day of the month).

Atomic Time Synchronization

The watch is designed to automatically receive the atomic time signal, usually between 1:00 AM and 5:00 AM, to ensure precise timekeeping. During this period, the watch will attempt to connect to the nearest signal transmitter. For best results, ensure the watch is placed in an open area, away from electronic interference, and near a window.

Power Saving Mode

To conserve battery life, the watch may enter a power-saving mode when left in complete darkness for an extended period. In this mode, the hands will stop moving, but the internal timekeeping mechanism continues to operate. Exposing the watch to light will reactivate the display and hands.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

Wipe the watch case and crystal with a soft, dry cloth. For the watch band, use a slightly damp cloth if necessary, then dry thoroughly. Avoid using harsh chemicals, solvents, or abrasive materials, as these can damage the watch's finish or seals.

Water Resistance

The CoolFire Model 1531 watch is water-resistant up to 5 ATM (50 meters). This means it is suitable for everyday use, including splashes, rain, and brief immersion in water. However, it is not recommended for swimming, diving, or prolonged water activities. Always ensure the crown is pushed in completely before any contact with water. Do not operate the pushers or crown while the

watch is wet or submerged to prevent water ingress.

Charging

Regular exposure to light is crucial for maintaining the watch's charge. If the watch stops or its functions become erratic, expose it to strong light (natural or artificial) for several hours to fully recharge the internal battery. Avoid prolonged storage in darkness.

TROUBLESHOOTING

• **Watch not keeping accurate time:**

Ensure the watch is fully charged by exposing it to strong light. Verify that the correct time zone is set. For atomic synchronization issues, try placing the watch near a window overnight, facing the direction of the nearest signal transmitter. Obstructions or electronic interference can hinder signal reception.

• **Hands not moving:**

The watch may be in power-saving mode due to insufficient light exposure. Expose the watch to light for several hours. If the issue persists after adequate charging, consult support.

• **LCD display unreadable or difficult to see:**

The small LCD display can be challenging to read under certain conditions. Ensure adequate lighting. If your specific model allows for contrast adjustment, refer to the original manual for instructions on how to modify this setting.

• **Watch loses time or stops frequently:**

This often indicates insufficient charge. Ensure the watch receives regular and sufficient light exposure. If the problem continues despite proper charging, the rechargeable battery may need servicing.
