Initial Setup

Before beginning, ensure you have a 2.4GHz Wi-Fi network available. The X1 camera does not support 5GHz Wi-Fi.

1. Connect the X1 camera to power using the provided Micro USB Charging Cable and AC Adapter.
2. Download the BOSMA app from your device's app store.
3. Create an account or log in within the app.

Connecting to Wi-Fi

2. Select your 2.4GHz Wi-Fi network and enter the password when prompted.
3. The camera will provide an audible confirmation upon successful connection.

1. In the BOSMA app, navigate to the device settings for your X1 camera.
2. Select 'Add Accessory' and follow the on-screen prompts to pair your door/window sensor and smart button.


OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Camera Controls

The BOSMA X1 features 360° panning capability, allowing you to remotely adjust the camera's view through the app. Utilize the two-way audio feature to communicate with individuals near the camera; this functions like a phone call, allowing simultaneous speaking and listening. Activate the built-in 110dB siren from the app to deter intruders.

Motion Detection & Alerts



Local Storage

The X1 camera supports local storage via a microSD card (up to 128GB, not included). Insert a formatted microSD card into the designated slot on the camera to enable continuous recording or event-triggered storage.

The X1 camera features advanced image sensors for color night vision, providing clear, vivid video even in low-light conditions. Traditional black-and-white infrared night vision is also available.



MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

TROUBLESHOOTING

Refer to the table below for common issues and their solutions:

Issue	Solution
Camera offline/cannot connect to Wi-Fi	Ensure camera is powered on and within range of a 2.4GHz Wi-Fi network. Restart the camera and your router. Verify Wi-Fi password.
False motion alerts	Adjust motion detection sensitivity in the app. Utilize PIR detection for human/pet movement. Ensure camera is not pointed at moving objects like curtains or trees.
Poor video quality	Check your Wi-Fi signal strength in the app. Ensure the camera lens is clean.
Two-way audio not working	Check microphone and speaker settings in the app. Ensure your phone's volume is up.
Door sensor/Smart button not pairing	Ensure the X1 camera is online and in pairing mode. Check battery levels of the accessories.


