INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the proper use, care, and maintenance of your AK Interactive Abteilung 502 Marta Kolinsky Brush 2. This brush is an ultra-high quality tool designed for precision painting in model and hobby building, offering excellent paint retention and a fine point for detailed work.

SETUP

- Unpacking:** Carefully remove the brush from its protective packaging. Inspect the bristles for any damage during transit.
- Initial Conditioning:** Before first use, gently moisten the bristles with clean water (for water-based paints) or an appropriate brush cleaner (for solvent-based paints). This helps to remove any sizing or protective agents applied during manufacturing.
- Reshaping:** Using your fingers, gently reshape the moistened bristles to a fine, sharp point. This prepares the brush for optimal performance.

OPERATING

- Paint Loading:** Dip the brush into your chosen paint, ensuring only the tip and the belly of the bristles are loaded. Avoid submerging the ferrule (the metal part) in paint, as this can lead to paint drying inside and damaging the brush.
- Application:** Apply paint to your model or surface with smooth, controlled strokes. For fine details, utilize the very tip of the brush. For broader coverage, use more of the brush's belly.
- Cleaning During Use:** During extended painting sessions, periodically rinse the brush in clean water or the appropriate thinner to prevent paint from drying on the bristles. This maintains the brush's flexibility and point.

MAINTENANCE

- Thorough Cleaning:** After each painting session, clean the brush thoroughly. For water-based paints, rinse with water until all paint residue is completely removed. For enamel, oil, or acrylic lacquer paints, use the recommended thinner or brush cleaner until the bristles are clean.
- Reshaping:** After cleaning, gently reshape the bristles to their original fine point using your fingers or a brush shaper. This is crucial for maintaining the brush's integrity and performance over time.
- Drying:** Allow the brush to dry completely. Ideally, hang the brush downwards or lay it flat to prevent water or cleaner from seeping into the ferrule and potentially dissolving the glue that holds the bristles.
- Storage:** Store brushes horizontally or vertically with the bristles pointing upwards. Keep them away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, or any conditions that could damage the bristles or handle.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- Bristles Splaying:** If the bristles splay out, it often indicates improper cleaning or drying. Ensure thorough cleaning to remove all paint from the base of the bristles and reshape them while wet. Avoid letting paint dry in the ferrule.
- Brush Losing Its Point:** Consistent reshaping after cleaning is vital. If the brush repeatedly loses its point, it might be due to wear from heavy use or improper handling techniques. Consider using a brush restorer if the damage is minor.
- Paint Drying Too Quickly on Brush:** This can be due to paint consistency being too thick or insufficient cleaning during painting. Adjust paint thinning and clean the brush more frequently during your work.
