1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Continental Electric CE-DF309 is a 2.0 Liter air fryer designed for healthier cooking by circulating hot air to fry, grill, bake, and roast food with minimal to no oil. It features adjustable temperature control and a 30-minute timer, making it suitable for preparing small snacks or meals for individuals.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all instructions carefully before using the appliance to prevent personal injury or damage to the product.

- Always ensure the appliance is placed on a stable, heat-resistant surface.
- Do not immerse the cord, plug, or appliance in water or other liquids.
- Keep the appliance and its cord out of reach of children.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts.
- Do not use attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer.

3. COMPONENTS

- Control Panel (Temperature Dial, Timer Dial)
- Removable Air Fryer Basket
- Crisping Tray (inside the basket)
- Handle

4. SETUP AND FIRST USE

4.1 Unpacking

1. Remove all packaging materials, stickers, and labels from the appliance.
2. Remove any accessories from inside the air fryer basket.

4.2 Cleaning Before First Use

1. Wash the air fryer basket and crisping tray in hot, soapy water. Rinse and dry thoroughly.
2. Wipe the inside and outside of the main unit with a damp cloth.
3. Ensure all parts are completely dry before use.

4.3 Placement

1. Place the air fryer on a stable, level, and heat-resistant surface.
2. Ensure there is at least 6 inches of space around the back and sides of the appliance for proper air circulation.
3. Do not place the air fryer directly against a wall or under cabinets.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Control Panel

The air fryer is equipped with two mechanical dials for easy control:

- **Temperature Dial:** Adjusts the cooking temperature from 180°F to 400°F.
- **Timer Dial:** Sets the cooking time up to 30 minutes. The appliance will automatically shut off when the timer reaches zero.

5.2 Basic Operation

1. Plug the air fryer into a grounded electrical outlet.
2. Pull out the air fryer basket using the handle.
3. Place the crisping tray inside the basket.
4. Place your food onto the crisping tray in the basket. Do not overfill the basket to allow for proper air circulation.
5. Slide the basket back into the air fryer until it clicks into place.
6. Turn the temperature dial to your desired cooking temperature.
7. Turn the timer dial to your desired cooking time. The air fryer will begin heating.
8. During cooking, you may pull out the basket to shake or flip food for even cooking. The appliance will pause and resume when the basket is reinserted.
9. Once the timer reaches zero, the air fryer will automatically shut off. Carefully remove the basket and transfer food to a serving dish.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your air fryer.

6.1 Cleaning the Basket and Crisping Tray

1. Unplug the air fryer and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
2. Remove the air fryer basket and crisping tray.
3. Wash the basket and tray in hot, soapy water. Use a non-abrasive sponge. **Note:** These parts are not dishwasher safe.
4. For stubborn food residue, soak the basket and tray in warm, soapy water for about 10 minutes before cleaning.
5. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely before reassembling or storing.

6.2 Cleaning the Exterior

1. Wipe the exterior of the air fryer with a damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads.
2. Never immerse the main unit in water or any other liquid.

6.3 Storage

Store the cleaned and dried air fryer in a cool, dry place.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your air fryer, please refer to the following common problems and solutions:

- **Appliance not turning on:**
 - Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working electrical outlet.
 - Verify that the air fryer basket is fully inserted into the main unit. The appliance will not operate if the basket is not correctly closed.
 - Check if the timer dial has been set. The air fryer will only operate when a cooking time is selected.
- **Food not cooked evenly:**
 - Do not overcrowd the air fryer basket. Cook food in smaller batches if necessary.
 - Shake the basket or flip food items halfway through the cooking process to ensure even browning and crisping.
- **White smoke coming from the appliance:**
 - White smoke can be caused by cooking fatty foods. This is normal and does not indicate a malfunction.
 - Excess oil or grease residue from previous use can also cause smoke. Ensure the basket and crisping tray are thoroughly cleaned after each use.
- **Food not crispy:**
 - Ensure the food is not overcrowded in the basket.
 - Increase cooking time or temperature slightly.
 - Lightly spray or brush food with a small amount of oil for extra crispness.
