Monopoly Pizza Board Game Instruction Manual

1. INTRODUCTION AND OVERVIEW

The Monopoly Pizza board game offers a unique twist on the classic game, centered around a pizza theme. Designed for players aged 8 and up, this edition replaces traditional property acquisition with buying pizza slices. The game board features vibrant images of pizza toppings, and the packaging resembles a pizza takeout box. Players aim to collect as many pizza slices as possible by purchasing pizza spaces and acquiring slice tokens. The game incorporates Chance and Community Chest cards, which can lead to various outcomes, from becoming a pizza connoisseur to entering a pizza-making contest.

2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Verify that all components listed below are present in your game box:

- Gameboard
- 6 Tokens (pizza-themed)
- 16 Pizza Cards
- 16 Chance Cards
- 16 Community Chest Cards
- 64 Cardboard Pizza Slice Tokens
- Money Pack
- 2 Dice
- Game Guide

3. SETUP

Follow these steps to prepare your Monopoly Pizza game for play:

1. Unbox the game and remove all pieces.
2. Set up the game board in the center of the playing area.
3. Each player chooses a pizza-themed token to represent them on the board.
4. Shuffle the Pizza cards, Chance cards, and Community Chest cards separately and place them face down on their designated spaces on the board.
5. Distribute the starting money to each player as specified in the game guide.
6. Place the pizza slice tokens in a general supply area accessible to all players.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS (HOW TO PLAY)

The game proceeds in turns, with players rolling dice and moving their tokens around the board. The objective is to collect the most pizza slices.

4.1. Player Turn Sequence

1. **Roll Dice:** Roll both dice to determine the number of spaces to move.
2. **Move Token:** Move your token clockwise around the board the number of spaces indicated by the dice.
3. **Action on Space:** Perform the action associated with the space your token landed on. This may include:
 - **Buying Pizza Spaces:** If you land on an unowned pizza space, you may purchase it.
 - **Paying Rent:** If you land on an opponent's owned pizza space, you must pay them rent.
 - **Drawing Cards:** Land on a Chance or Community Chest space and draw the top card from the respective pile, following its instructions.
 - **Collecting Slice Tokens:** Certain actions or card instructions may award you pizza slice tokens.

4. **End Turn:** Your turn ends, and play passes to the player on your left.

4.2. Pizza-Themed Tokens

Move around the game board using one of the unique pizza-themed tokens:

- Cheese Grater
- Pizza Chef
- Cheese Shaker
- Delivery Bike
- Slicer
- Pizza on a Paddle

5. WINNING THE GAME

The game concludes when all the pizza spaces on the board have been purchased. The player who has collected the most pizza slices (and the tastiest pizza, as determined by the game guide) at the end of the game is declared the winner.




Image: Diagram illustrating the product dimensions of the Monopoly Pizza game box.
