# Esperanza EKO011W Microwave Oven User Manual

### IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Do not operate the oven if it is damaged. Contact qualified service personnel for examination and repair.
- Do not heat liquids or other foods in sealed containers as they are liable to explode.
- Do not use corrosive chemicals or vapors in this appliance.
- This appliance is intended for household use only.
- Always ensure the turntable and roller ring are correctly positioned before operation.
- Do not attempt to operate this oven with the door open as this can result in harmful exposure to microwave energy.
- Keep the appliance and its cord out of reach of children.
- Do not immerse the cord, plug, or appliance in water or other liquid.
- Only use utensils suitable for microwave ovens.

### PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Esperanza EKO011W is a 1100W countertop microwave oven designed for efficient heating, defrosting, and grilling of food items. It features a simple control panel with rotary knobs for power and time settings.

### Components:

- **Oven Door:** Features a viewing window and a latch system.
- **Control Panel:** Includes power level selector and timer knob.
- **Turntable:** Glass tray that rotates to ensure even cooking.
- **Roller Ring:** Supports the turntable.
- **Oven Cavity:** The interior space where food is placed.

## SETUP

---

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the microwave oven and all packing materials from the carton. Check for any damage. Do not remove the light brown mica sheet that is attached to the oven cavity to protect the magnetron.
2. **Placement:** Place the oven on a flat, stable surface that can support its weight and the heaviest food item likely to be cooked in the oven. Ensure there is adequate ventilation space: at least 20 cm (8 inches) of space above the oven, 10 cm (4 inches) at the rear, and 5 cm (2 inches) on both sides.
3. **Power Connection:** Plug the power cord into a standard grounded electrical outlet. Ensure the voltage matches the rating label on the oven.
4. **Turntable Assembly:** Place the roller ring in the center of the oven cavity. Then, place the glass turntable securely on top of the roller ring.
5. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, wipe the interior and exterior of the oven with a damp cloth.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

This microwave oven features two rotary knobs for controlling power level and cooking time.

### 1. Setting Power Level

The oven offers 10 power levels for various cooking needs. Rotate the top knob (labeled "POWER") to select the desired power setting.

- **High Power (Max 1100W):** For fast cooking and reheating.
- **Medium-High:** For general cooking.
- **Medium:** For slower cooking of dense foods.
- **Medium-Low:** For simmering or delicate foods.
- **Low/Defrost:** For defrosting or keeping food warm.

### 2. Setting Cooking Time

Rotate the bottom knob (labeled "TIME") to set the desired cooking duration. The timer can be set up to 30 minutes.

- Place food in a microwave-safe container on the turntable.
- Close the oven door securely.
- Select the desired power level using the top knob.
- Set the cooking time using the bottom knob. The oven will start automatically.
- The oven will stop and a bell will sound when the set time has elapsed.

### 3. Defrosting Function

The defrost function allows for thawing frozen foods. Rotate the top knob to the defrost symbol (snowflake icon) and then set the desired defrosting time using the bottom knob. For best results, turn food over periodically during defrosting.

### 4. Grill Function

This microwave oven is equipped with a grill function. To use the grill, select the grill setting on the power knob and set the desired grilling time. Ensure to use heat-resistant cookware and monitor food closely to

prevent burning.

## MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

---

Regular cleaning helps maintain the performance and longevity of your microwave oven.

- **Before Cleaning:** Always unplug the oven from the power outlet.
- **Oven Interior:** Wipe the inside of the oven with a damp cloth after each use. For stubborn stains, use a mild detergent or a microwave-safe cleaner. Do not use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads.
- **Oven Exterior:** Clean the exterior surface with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid getting water into the ventilation openings.
- **Door and Door Seals:** Clean the door, door seals, and adjacent parts carefully with a damp cloth to remove any spills or splatters.
- **Turntable and Roller Ring:** The glass turntable and roller ring can be washed in warm soapy water or in a dishwasher. Ensure they are completely dry before placing them back in the oven.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues with your microwave oven, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Oven does not start	Power cord not plugged in; Door not closed properly; Fuse blown or circuit breaker tripped.	Ensure plug is firmly in outlet; Close door securely; Check household fuse or reset circuit breaker.
Food not heating	Power level set too low; Cooking time too short; Utensils not microwave-safe.	Increase power level or cooking time; Use microwave-safe cookware.
Turntable not rotating	Turntable or roller ring not correctly positioned; Debris under turntable.	Re-position turntable and roller ring; Clean under the turntable.
Sparks or arcing inside oven	Metal objects in oven; Food residue on cavity walls.	Remove any metal objects; Clean oven interior thoroughly.
