All7s Deluxe Canasta Game Set Instruction Manual

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for setting up and playing the All7s Deluxe Canasta Game Set. Canasta is a classic card game for 2 or more players, offering engaging and strategic gameplay. This set includes all necessary components to begin playing immediately.

WHAT'S INCLUDED

Your All7s Deluxe Canasta Game Set contains the following components:

- Two (2) Decks of Canasta Playing Cards with Point Values
- One (1) Dual Revolving Card Holder
- One (1) Large Score Pad
- One (1) Instruction Booklet

SETUP

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all items from the game box.
2. **Prepare Card Holder:** Place the dual revolving card holder in the center of your playing area. This holder is designed to keep the draw pile and discard pile organized and easily accessible for all players.

3. **Shuffle Cards:** Combine both decks of Canasta playing cards and shuffle them thoroughly. The cards feature an air-cushion finish for easy handling and shuffling.
4. **Form Draw Pile:** Place the shuffled deck face down in one section of the revolving card holder to form the draw pile.
5. **Deal Cards:** The number of cards dealt to each player depends on the number of players:
 - **2 Players:** 15 cards each
 - **3 Players:** 13 cards each
 - **4 Players (2 teams of 2):** 11 cards each
 - **5 Players:** 11 cards each
 - **6 Players (2 teams of 3):** 11 cards each
6. **Form Discard Pile:** Turn the top card of the draw pile face up and place it next to the draw pile in the other section of the revolving card holder to start the discard pile. If this card is a wild card (Joker or 2) or a red 3, turn the next card and continue until a natural card (4 through King) is turned up. The wild card or red 3 is placed sideways at the bottom of the discard pile, indicating it is "frozen".

OPERATING: HOW TO PLAY CANASTA

Canasta is played with two decks of standard playing cards (108 cards total, including 4 Jokers). The objective is to score points by melding cards of same rank and making Canastas (at least seven cards of the same rank).

Card Values

Card	Point Value
Jokers	50 points each
Aces, 2s	20 points each
K, Q, J, 10, 9, 8	10 points each

Card	Point Value
7, 6, 5, 4	5 points each
Black 3s	5 points each
Red 3s	100 points each (bonus)

Note: The cards in this set have point values printed on them for easier scoring.

Gameplay Overview

- Drawing Cards:** At the beginning of your turn, you must draw two cards from the top of the draw pile.
- Melding:** After drawing, you may make one or more melds. A meld consists of at least three cards of the same rank. Melds can include natural cards (4 through King) and wild cards (Jokers and 2s). A meld must contain at least two natural cards and never more than three wild cards.
- Taking the Discard Pile:** Instead of drawing, you may take the entire discard pile if you can use its top card to make a new meld or add to an existing meld. Special rules apply if the discard pile is "frozen" (contains a wild card or red 3 turned up during setup).
- Red 3s:** If you draw a red 3, immediately place it face up in front of you and draw a replacement card. Red 3s cannot be melded and are bonus points at the end of the round.
- Black 3s:** Black 3s can only be melded when a player is going out. They cannot be used to take the discard pile.
- Canastas:** A Canasta is a meld of at least seven cards of the same rank.
 - Natural Canasta:** All seven cards are natural cards (no wild cards). Worth 500 bonus points.
 - Mixed Canasta:** Contains at least four natural cards and one to three wild cards. Worth 300 bonus points.
- Going Out:** A player "goes out" when they play the last card in their hand, either by melding it or discarding it, provided their team has completed at least one Canasta.
- Scoring:** Points are tallied at the end of each round.
 - Points for cards in melds are added.
 - Points for red 3s are added (100 points each).
 - Bonus points for Canastas are added.
 - Bonus for going out (100 points).
 - Points for cards remaining in hand are subtracted.

MAINTENANCE

- **Card Care:** To prolong the life of your playing cards, handle them with clean, dry hands. Avoid bending or creasing the cards. Store them in their original boxes when not in use.
- **Card Holder Cleaning:** The revolving card holder can be wiped clean with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners that may scratch the surface.
- **Storage:** Store the entire game set in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures to prevent warping or damage to components.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Missing Cards:** If you find any cards missing, please check all packaging thoroughly. If still missing, contact customer support.
- **Damaged Card Holder:** In case the revolving card holder is damaged upon arrival or during normal use, please refer to the warranty information for replacement options.
- **Difficulty with Rules:** Canasta rules can be complex initially. Refer to the instruction booklet for clarifications or search for online tutorials and rule explanations. Practice helps in mastering the game.
