1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The IKEA Sinnerlig Pendant Lamp, Model 703.150.30, is a lighting fixture designed to provide both directed and general illumination. Its shade is crafted from bamboo, offering a soft, glowing light that enhances the ambiance of a room. The design is characterized by its unique, handmade bamboo weave, making each shade distinct. This pendant lamp is suitable for indoor use, particularly in dining rooms and living areas.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Electrical Safety:** Always disconnect power at the main circuit breaker before installation, maintenance, or changing the light bulb.
- **Qualified Electrician:** Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician in accordance with local electrical codes.
- **Light Bulb:** Use only the specified type and wattage of light bulb (E26 base, max 60 watts). An opal light bulb is recommended for even, diffused light distribution. Light bulb is sold separately.
- **Indoor Use Only:** This product is designed for indoor use and is not water resistant.
- **Secure Mounting:** Ensure the pendant lamp is securely mounted to the ceiling to prevent falling.
- **Cleaning:** Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents. Wipe clean with a dry cloth.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present before beginning installation:

- 1 x Sinnerlig Pendant Lamp Shade (Bamboo)
- 1 x Ceiling Cup (Steel, Epoxy powder coating)
- 1 x Hook Bracket (Polyamide)
- Mounting Hardware (Screws, wall plugs, etc.)
- Instruction Leaflet

Note: Light bulb is sold separately.

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Follow these steps for proper installation of your IKEA Sinnerlig Pendant Lamp. It is recommended to have a second person assist during installation.

1. **Prepare for Installation:** Turn off the power to the circuit at the main fuse box or circuit breaker. Clear the work area.
2. **Attach Hook Bracket:** Secure the hook bracket to the ceiling junction box using appropriate screws and wall plugs (if necessary). Ensure it is firmly attached.
3. **Adjust Cord Length:** Determine the desired hanging length of the lamp. Adjust the electrical cord accordingly. Excess cord can be stored within the ceiling cup.
4. **Electrical Connection:** Connect the lamp's electrical wires to the household wiring according to local electrical codes. Typically, this involves connecting live to live, neutral to neutral, and ground to ground. Ensure all connections are secure.
5. **Secure Ceiling Cup:** Push the ceiling cup up against the ceiling, covering the electrical connections and the hook bracket. Secure it in place.
6. **Install Light Bulb:** Screw an E26 base light bulb (max 60W, sold separately) into the lamp holder. An opal light bulb is recommended for optimal light diffusion.
7. **Restore Power:** Turn the power back on at the main circuit breaker.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The IKEA Sinnerlig Pendant Lamp is operated via a standard wall switch connected to its electrical circuit. Ensure the light bulb is correctly installed and the power supply is active.

- **Turning On/Off:** Use the wall switch connected to the lamp's circuit to turn the light on or off.
- **Dimmable Feature:** If connected to a compatible dimmer switch and using a dimmable light bulb, the brightness can be adjusted.
- **Light Color:** The light color is determined by the installed E26 light bulb. For a warm white light, use a corresponding bulb.

6. MAINTENANCE

To maintain the appearance and functionality of your pendant lamp:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the lamp shade and ceiling cup with a dry, soft cloth. Do not use water, cleaning agents, or abrasive materials, as these can damage the bamboo and finish.
- **Light Bulb Replacement:** Always turn off the power at the main circuit breaker before replacing the light bulb. Allow the bulb to cool before handling. Replace with an E26 base, max 60W bulb.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check the electrical connections and mounting hardware for any signs of wear or loosening.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|--------------------------|--|---|
| Lamp does not light up. | No power supply; loose connection; faulty light bulb. | Check circuit breaker. Ensure all electrical connections are secure. Replace light bulb. |
| Light is too dim/bright. | Incorrect wattage bulb; non-dimmable bulb with dimmer. | Replace with appropriate wattage bulb. Ensure dimmable bulb is used with a dimmer switch. |
| Lamp flickers. | Loose bulb; incompatible dimmer; faulty wiring. | Tighten bulb. Ensure dimmer is compatible with LED/CFL bulbs if used. Consult an electrician for wiring issues. |
