## INTRODUCTION

This device offers a versatile audio experience with its CD player, AM/FM radio, Bluetooth connectivity, USB playback, and auxiliary input. This manual provides detailed instructions for setup, operation, and maintenance to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your boombox.

## KEY FEATURES

- **Sleek and User-Friendly Design:** Features easy-to-use buttons and an LED display for effortless operation. Its compact and modern design is suitable for various environments.
- **Clear Stereo Sound:** Equipped with dual premium 3-inch front-firing speakers, delivering crisp, well-balanced stereo sound (2W x 2 RMS).
- **Versatile CD Player:** The top-loading CD player supports CD, CD-R/RW, MP3 CDs, and audiobook CDs, with shuffle (RAND) and repeat (REP) functions.
- **AM and FM Radio:** Built-in AM and FM tuner with a classic manual tuning knob for enjoying radio stations.
- **Bluetooth Streaming:** Easily pair with Bluetooth-enabled devices for wireless music and podcast streaming with a stable connection.
- **USB Playback:** Supports MP3 or WMA files from USB flash drives up to 128 GB (FAT32 format only; exFAT/NTFS not supported).
- **Convenient Features:** Includes a 3.5mm auxiliary (AUX) input for wired connections and a headphone

jack for private listening. The Function (FUNC) button allows easy switching between CD, USB, AUX, FM, AM, and Bluetooth modes.

## CONTROLS AND CONNECTIONS

Familiarize yourself with the boombox's controls and connection ports for proper operation.

- **Power ON/OFF:** Turns the unit on or off.
- **Volume Control Knob:** Adjusts the audio output level.
- **LED Screen:** Displays current mode, track number, or radio frequency.
- **Play/Pause:** Starts or pauses playback in CD, USB, or Bluetooth modes.
- **Function (FUNC) Button:** Cycles through available modes: CD, USB, AUX, FM, AM, Bluetooth.
- **B-Skip / F-Skip:** Skips backward or forward through tracks on CD/USB, or tunes radio frequencies.
- **REP/RAND/STOP/PROG:** Controls repeat, random playback, stops playback, or programs CD/USB tracks.
- **FM Antenna:** Extend for optimal FM radio reception.
- **Headphone Jack (3.5mm):** For private listening with headphones.
- **USB Port:** Connect a USB flash drive for MP3/WMA playback.
- **AUX In Jack (3.5mm):** Connect external audio devices using an auxiliary cable.

## SETUP

### Powering the Boombox

The boombox can be powered by AC power or batteries.

#### AC Power Operation:

1. Ensure the boombox is switched off.
2. Connect the supplied AC power cord to the AC IN jack on the back of the unit.
3. Plug the other end of the AC power cord into a standard wall outlet (AC 120V ~ 60Hz).

#### Battery Operation:

1. Ensure the boombox is switched off and disconnected from AC power.
2. Open the battery compartment cover on the bottom of the unit.
3. Insert 6 x 'C' size batteries (not included), ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
4. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### CD Player Operation

1. Press the **Power** button to turn on the boombox.
2. Press the **FUNC** button repeatedly until 'CD' mode is selected.
3. Open the CD compartment cover by gently lifting it.
4. Place a CD (CD, CD-R/RW, MP3 CD, or audiobook CD) onto the center spindle with the label side facing up.
5. Close the CD compartment cover. The boombox will read the disc, and the track number will appear on the LED display.
6. Press the **Play/Pause** button to start playback.
7. Use the **B-Skip** and **F-Skip** buttons to navigate between tracks.
8. Press the **REP/RAND/STOP/PROG** button to cycle through repeat modes (repeat one, repeat all) or random playback. Press and hold to stop playback.

### AM/FM Radio Operation

1. Press the **Power** button to turn on the boombox.
2. Press the **FUNC** button repeatedly until 'FM' or 'AM' mode is selected.
3. For FM reception, extend the FM antenna for best signal. For AM reception, rotate the unit for best signal.
4. Use the **Tuning Knob** to manually tune to your desired radio station.

### Bluetooth Streaming

1. Press the **Power** button to turn on the boombox.
2. Press the **FUNC** button repeatedly until 'BT' (Bluetooth) mode is selected. The LED display will show 'BT' and flash, indicating it's in pairing mode.
3. On your Bluetooth-enabled device (smartphone, tablet, etc.), enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
4. Select 'SINGING WOOD' from the list of devices. Once paired, the 'BT' indicator on the boombox will stop flashing and remain solid.

5. You can now stream audio from your device to the boombox. Use your device's controls for track navigation and volume, or the boombox's volume knob.

## AC / BATTERY POWER SUPPLY

Required AC power cord or 6C cell batteries (Not included)

### USB Playback

1. Press the **Power** button to turn on the boombox.
2. Insert a USB flash drive (FAT32 format, up to 128 GB) into the USB port.
3. Press the **FUNC** button repeatedly until 'USB' mode is selected. The boombox will automatically detect and begin playing MP3/WMA files from the USB drive.
4. Use the **Play/Pause**, **B-Skip**, **F-Skip**, and **REP/RAND/STOP/PROG** buttons to control playback.

### Auxiliary Input (AUX)

1. Press the **Power** button to turn on the boombox.
2. Connect one end of a 3.5mm audio cable (not included) to the AUX In jack on the boombox.
3. Connect the other end of the audio cable to the headphone jack or audio output of your external device (e.g., MP3 player, smartphone).
4. Press the **FUNC** button repeatedly until 'AUX' mode is selected.
5. Start playback on your external device. Adjust volume using both the external device and the boombox's volume knob.

### Headphone Jack

1. Plug your 3.5mm headphones into the Headphone Jack on the front of the boombox.
2. Audio will automatically switch from the speakers to your headphones.
3. Adjust the volume using the boombox's volume knob.

## MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the boombox. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **CD Lens Care:** If the CD player experiences reading errors, use a commercially available CD lens cleaner to clean the lens.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, remove batteries and store the unit in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Antenna:** Handle the FM antenna carefully to avoid damage. Retract it when not in use.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	AC cord not connected; Batteries depleted or incorrectly inserted.	Ensure AC cord is securely plugged in; Replace batteries or check polarity.
CD not playing / skipping	CD is dirty, scratched, or inserted incorrectly; CD lens is dirty.	Clean or replace CD; Insert CD with label side up; Use a CD lens cleaner.
Poor radio reception	FM antenna not extended; Unit position for AM.	Extend FM antenna fully; Rotate the unit for better AM signal.
Bluetooth not pairing	Boombox not in BT mode; Device Bluetooth off; Device too far.	Select BT mode; Enable Bluetooth on your device; Move device closer to boombox.
USB not playing	USB not inserted correctly; Unsupported file format; USB drive not FAT32.	Reinsert USB drive; Ensure files are MP3/WMA; Format USB drive to FAT32.
