## SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The Stander Wonder Rollator Plus comes pre-assembled, requiring no complex setup. Follow these steps for initial preparation:

1. Unbox the rollator.
2. Adjust the handle height to fit your wrist.

3. Unlock the brakes to move.
4. Lock the brakes when ready to rest.
5. Fold the rollator by pulling the handle upwards and back.
6. Unfold the rollator by pressing down on the seat.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### Walking with the Rollator

To walk, ensure the brakes are disengaged. Push the rollator forward, maintaining a comfortable distance. Keep your body upright and centered between the handles for stability.

### Engaging and Disengaging Brakes

The rollator features rear locking brakes for secure stopping. To engage the brakes, push the brake levers down until they click into the locked position. To disengage, pull the levers upwards. Always engage brakes when sitting or when the rollator is stationary.

### Using the Perch Seat

The 18.5 by 6-inch non-slip travel seat provides a convenient resting spot. Before sitting, ensure the rollator is on a flat, stable surface and both brakes are fully engaged. Sit facing the front of the rollator. The compact seat and back strap offer a place to sit for a quick rest while traveling or at the store.

### Folding and Unfolding

To fold the rollator, pull the strap located on the seat upwards and back. This will collapse the frame into a compact size. To unfold, simply push down on the seat until the frame locks into its open position.





## MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your rollator.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the frame and seat with a damp cloth and mild detergent. Avoid abrasive cleaners.
- **Wheel Inspection:** Periodically check the wheels for debris or wear. Clean as needed to ensure smooth rolling.
- **Brake Check:** Test the brakes regularly to ensure they engage and disengage properly. If brakes feel loose or ineffective, consult the manufacturer or a qualified technician.
- **Fasteners:** Ensure all screws, bolts, and fasteners are tight. Do not overtighten.
- **Storage:** Store the rollator in a dry place away from extreme temperatures.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Refer to the table below for common issues and their solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Rollator does not roll smoothly	Debris in wheels or loose wheels	Clean wheels, check for obstructions, ensure wheels are securely attached.
Brakes are not engaging/disengaging	Brake cable too loose/tight or worn brake pads	Adjust brake cable tension (consult user manual for specific instructions) or contact support for replacement parts.
Rollator feels unstable	Handles not properly adjusted or uneven surface	Ensure handles are at the correct height and locked. Use on flat, stable surfaces.
Difficulty folding/unfolding	Mechanism obstructed or not fully engaged	Check for obstructions around the folding mechanism. Ensure the seat is fully pushed down when unfolding, or the strap is fully pulled when folding.
