INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient setup, operation, and maintenance of your Intex Prism Frame Premium Above Ground Swimming Pool. Please read this manual thoroughly before installation and keep it for future reference.

SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: Failure to follow these instructions can result in serious injury or death.

- Adult supervision is required at all times when children are in or near the pool.
- Do not dive or jump into the pool. The water depth is not sufficient for diving.
- Ensure the pool is set up on a firm, level surface free of sharp objects.
- Keep all electrical cords, pumps, and filters away from the pool area to prevent electrical hazards.
- Do not allow horseplay or roughhousing in or around the pool.
- Always secure the pool ladder when not in use to prevent unsupervised access by children.
- Regularly check the pool for damage, leaks, or signs of wear. Do not use if damaged.
- Maintain proper water chemistry to ensure a safe and healthy swimming environment.

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps for proper pool assembly:

1. Site Preparation

Select a flat, level area free of sharp objects, debris, and excessive slopes. The ground must be firm enough to support the weight of the filled pool.

Spread the included ground cloth on the prepared site. Then, carefully unroll and spread the pool liner over the ground cloth, ensuring it is centered and free of wrinkles.

2. Frame Assembly

Assemble the powder-coated steel frame according to the diagrams in the included DVD manual. Ensure all connections are secure and the frame is rigid. No tools are typically required for frame assembly.

3. Filter Pump Installation

Connect the 1500 GPH cartridge filter pump to the pool's inlet and outlet fittings using the provided hoses and clamps. Ensure all connections are tight to prevent leaks. Position the pump on a stable surface at least 6 feet (1.8 meters) away from the pool.

4. Ladder Assembly

Assemble the removable pool ladder according to its specific instructions. Place the ladder securely against the pool wall, ensuring it is stable before use.

5. Filling the Pool

Begin filling the pool with water. As the water level rises, smooth out any remaining wrinkles in the liner from the center outwards.

Fill the pool to the recommended fill line, typically indicated on the liner or in the DVD manual. The pool has a capacity of 8,638 gallons (90% full) and can be filled in approximately 60 minutes.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Filter Pump Operation

The 1500 GPH cartridge filter pump is crucial for maintaining clean water. Operate the pump daily for a duration recommended by your water testing results, typically 4-6 hours. Refer to the pump's specific manual for detailed operating instructions and timer settings.

Hydro Aeration Technology

Your filter pump is equipped with Hydro Aeration Technology, which improves water circulation and filtration, enhances water clarity, and increases negative ions at the water surface. This technology operates automatically when the filter pump is running.

MAINTENANCE

Water Chemistry

Regularly test your pool water for pH, chlorine, and alkalinity levels. Adjust chemicals as needed to maintain balanced water chemistry, which is essential for swimmer safety and pool longevity. Consult a pool supply professional for specific chemical recommendations.

Filter Cartridge Cleaning and Replacement

Turn off the filter pump before cleaning or replacing the cartridge. Remove the filter cartridge from the pump housing and rinse it thoroughly with a garden hose. Replace the cartridge every two weeks or sooner if the water flow is reduced or the cartridge appears dirty.

Pool Cleaning

Skim debris from the water surface daily. Use a pool vacuum to clean the pool floor as needed. Brush the pool walls to prevent algae growth.

Pool Cover Usage

Use the included pool cover when the pool is not in use to prevent debris from entering the water and to reduce evaporation. Ensure the cover is securely fastened.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cloudy Water	Insufficient filtration; improper chemical balance; high bather load.	Run filter pump longer; test and adjust water chemistry; shock treat the pool.
Pump Not Running	Power outage; tripped GFCI; clogged impeller; faulty motor.	Check power supply; reset GFCI; clean impeller; contact customer support.
Water Leaking from Connections	Loose clamps; worn O-rings; damaged hoses.	Tighten clamps; inspect and replace O-rings; replace damaged hoses.
