1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

2. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Proper installation is crucial for the functionality and longevity of your MAAX Ariosa bathtub. It is recommended that installation be performed by a qualified professional plumber or contractor.

2.1 Pre-Installation Checks

- Verify that the floor structure can support the weight of the filled bathtub and its user(s).
- Ensure all necessary plumbing connections (water supply and drain) are in place according to local building codes. The bathtub is compatible with Above-the-Floor Rough (AFR) and F2 Drain systems.
- Inspect the bathtub for any damage prior to installation.

2.2 Positioning and Leveling

The MAAX Ariosa bathtub is designed for freestanding installation. Position the tub in its desired location, ensuring adequate clearance for maintenance and cleaning. Utilize the MAAX innovative leveling legs to ensure the bathtub is perfectly level on all sides. Adjust the legs as needed to achieve stability and prevent rocking.

2.3 Plumbing Connections

Connect the drain assembly to the floor drain. Ensure all connections are watertight. The recessed deck provides ample space for installing your chosen faucet. Follow the faucet manufacturer's instructions for proper installation.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The MAAX Ariosa bathtub is designed for a luxurious soaking experience. Its deep and roomy interior, combined with ergonomically designed backrests, ensures maximum comfort.

3.1 Filling the Bathtub

Ensure the center drain stopper is closed. Turn on the faucet to fill the bathtub with water to your desired level and temperature. The generous capacity of 76 gallons allows for a deep and immersive soak.

3.2 Comfort Features

The bathtub features inclined backrests on both ends, allowing for comfortable reclining in either direction. The inset curves along the sides also serve as comfortable armrests, enhancing the overall relaxation experience.

3.3 Draining the Bathtub

To drain the bathtub, open the center drain stopper. Ensure the drain is clear of any obstructions to allow for efficient water flow.

4. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

To maintain the pristine condition of your acrylic bathtub, follow these care guidelines:

- **Regular Cleaning:** Clean the bathtub regularly with a soft cloth or sponge and a non-abrasive, mild bathroom cleaner.
- **Avoid Harsh Chemicals:** Do not use abrasive cleaners, scouring pads, steel wool, or harsh chemical solvents (e.g., acetone, paint thinner) as these can damage the acrylic surface.
- **Stain Removal:** For stubborn stains, use a diluted solution of white vinegar and water, or a specialized

acrylic cleaner. Rinse thoroughly after cleaning.

- **Prevent Scratches:** Avoid dropping sharp or heavy objects into the tub. Small scratches can often be buffed out with a fine automotive polishing compound.
- **Drain Care:** Periodically remove and clean the center drain stopper to prevent hair and debris buildup, which can lead to slow draining.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your bathtub.

- **Slow Draining:** Check the center drain for any obstructions like hair or soap scum. Clean the drain assembly if necessary. If the issue persists, consult a plumber.
- **Water Leaks:** Immediately turn off the water supply. Inspect all plumbing connections for tightness. If you cannot identify or fix the leak, contact a professional plumber.
- **Surface Discoloration/Stains:** Refer to the 'Maintenance and Care' section for appropriate cleaning methods for acrylic surfaces.
- **Bathtub Rocking/Unstable:** Re-adjust the MAAX innovative leveling legs to ensure the tub is stable and evenly supported on the floor.
