1. INTRODUCTION

3. SETUP GUIDE

3.1 Charging the Headphones

Before first use, fully charge your PowerLocus P2 headphones. A full charge takes approximately 15 hours.

1. Connect the small end of the USB-C charging cable to the charging port on the headphones.
2. Connect the large end of the USB-C charging cable to a USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, wall adapter).
3. The LED indicator will show charging status (refer to LED indicator section for details). Once fully charged, the indicator will change or turn off.

3.2 Bluetooth Pairing

The PowerLocus P2 headphones are designed for quick and easy Bluetooth connection.

1. Ensure the headphones are turned off.
2. Slide the On/Off button to the 'On' position. The headphones will enter pairing mode, indicated by a flashing LED light (e.g., blue/red alternating).
3. On your device (smartphone, tablet, PC), enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
4. Select "PowerLocus P2" from the list of found devices.
5. Once connected, the LED indicator will typically show a solid blue light or flash slowly.

3.3 Wired Connection

For non-Bluetooth devices or when the battery is depleted, you can use the included 3.5mm audio cable.

1. Connect one end of the 3.5mm audio cable to the audio input jack on the headphones.
2. Connect the other end of the 3.5mm audio cable to the audio output jack of your device.
3. The headphones will automatically switch to wired mode.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Controls Overview

The headphones feature intuitive controls located on the earcup.

- **Power On/Off:** Slide switch.
- **Volume Up/Next Track:** Short press for volume up, long press for next track.
- **Volume Down/Previous Track:** Short press for volume down, long press for previous track.
- **Multi-function Button (MFB):** Play/Pause, Answer/End Call, Reject Call, Redial.

4.2 Bluetooth Mode Operation

- **Playing Music:** Use the MFB to play or pause audio. Use volume buttons for track navigation and volume adjustment.
- **Making/Receiving Calls:** The built-in microphone allows for hands-free communication. Press MFB to answer/end calls, long press to reject.

4.3 Micro SD/TF Card Mode

Insert a Micro SD/TF card (up to 32GB) into the designated slot to play music directly from the card.



4.4 FM Radio Mode

The headphones support FM radio functionality.

1. Switch to FM mode (refer to specific button function if available, usually a mode button or long press of MFB).
2. Press the MFB to auto-scan and save available FM stations.
3. Use the volume buttons to navigate between saved stations.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

5.1 Cleaning

Regular cleaning helps maintain the headphones' appearance and hygiene.

- Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the exterior of the headphones.
- For earcups, gently wipe with a slightly damp cloth and allow to air dry completely before use.
- Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.

5.2 Storage

Proper storage extends the life of your headphones.

- Fold the headphones to their compact size.
- Always store them in the provided protective case when not in use or when traveling.
- Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

- Avoid fully discharging the battery frequently.
- Charge the headphones regularly, even if not used for extended periods, to maintain battery health.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your PowerLocus P2 headphones, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Headphones do not power on.	Low battery.	Charge the headphones fully.
Cannot pair via Bluetooth.	Headphones not in pairing mode; device Bluetooth off; interference.	Ensure headphones are in pairing mode (flashing LED). Turn off and on device's Bluetooth. Move closer to device.
No sound in Bluetooth mode.	Volume too low; not connected; incorrect audio output.	Increase headphone and device volume. Re-pair headphones. Check device's audio output settings.
Sound distortion.	Too far from device; interference.	Move closer to the connected device. Avoid obstacles between headphones and device.
Microphone not working.	Incorrect input device selected on computer/phone.	Check audio input settings on your device and select PowerLocus P2.
