

SETUP GUIDE

1. Driver Installation

Before connecting the tablet, it is recommended to install the latest driver. This ensures optimal performance and access to all features, including pressure sensitivity and customizable hotkeys.

- 1. Visit the official Parblo website (www.parblo.com) and navigate to the 'Support' or 'Downloads' section.
- 2. Locate the driver for the Parblo A640 model compatible with your operating system (Windows or macOS).
- 3. Download the driver installer.
- 4. Close all drawing software and antivirus programs before running the installer.
- 5. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the installation.
- 6. Restart your computer if prompted.

2. Connecting the Tablet

Once the driver is installed, connect the tablet to your computer.

- 1. Connect the USB-C end of the provided cable to the port on the Parblo A640 tablet.
- 2. Connect the USB-A end of the cable to an available USB port on your computer.
- 3. The tablet should be automatically recognized by the system and the driver software.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using the Battery-Free Pen

The Parblo A640 comes with a battery-free stylus, eliminating the need for charging. It features 8192 levels of pressure sensitivity for precise control.




Image: A visual representation highlighting the 8192 pressure levels of the Parblo A640 stylus, indicating its capability for detailed and accurate input.

The pen includes two customizable buttons:

- Upper Button: Default function is "Quick Switch" (e.g., toggle between pen and eraser).
- Lower Button: Default function is "Right-Click".

Customizable Function Keys

The Parblo A640 tablet features four customizable function keys located on the top left and right of the active area. These keys can be programmed to perform various shortcuts or commands, enhancing your workflow.



To customize these keys:

- 1. Open the Parblo driver software from your computer's system tray or applications folder.
- 2. Navigate to the 'Function Keys' or 'Hotkeys' tab.
- 3. Select each key and assign your desired function (e.g., Undo, Zoom In, Brush Size, etc.).
- 4. Click 'Apply' or 'OK' to save your settings.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your Parblo A640 tablet.

- Cleaning: Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the tablet surface and pen. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents that could damage the finish. For stubborn smudges, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by immediate drying.
- **Nib Replacement:** The pen nib will wear down over time. When it becomes too short or sharp, use the nib removal tool (located at the end of the pen) to gently pull out the old nib and insert a new one. Ensure the new nib is fully seated.
- Storage: Store the tablet and pen in a clean, dry place away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and excessive dust.
- Cable Care: Avoid bending or crimping the USB cable excessively, especially near the connectors, to prevent internal wire damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Parblo A640 tablet, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Solution
Tablet not responding / No cursor movement.	Ensure the USB cable is securely connected to both the tablet and the computer. Try a different USB port on your computer. Reinstall the tablet driver. Restart your computer.
Pen pressure not working.	Verify that the tablet driver is correctly installed and running. Check the pen pressure settings in the tablet driver software. Ensure your drawing software supports pen pressure and that it is enabled in the software's settings. Try replacing the pen nib.
Hotkeys not functioning.	Open the tablet driver software and ensure the hotkeys are correctly configured. Make sure no other software is conflicting with the hotkey assignments. Restart the tablet driver or your computer.
Lag or delay in drawing.	Ensure your computer meets the minimum system requirements for your drawing software. Close unnecessary background applications to free up system resources. Update your graphics card drivers. Check for driver updates for the tablet.




Image: A size comparison of the Parblo A640 tablet with an iPhone X, illustrating its compact and slim design, along with its active drawing area dimensions.
