INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the Thomson SBC255BT Stereo Bluetooth 2.1 Soundbar Speaker. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure proper operation and to maximize your listening experience. Keep this manual for future reference.

- Do not expose this appliance to rain or moisture.
- Do not block any ventilation openings.
- Ensure the power cord is not pinched or walked on.
- Unplug the appliance during lightning storms or when unused for long periods.

- This product is not water resistant. Avoid contact with liquids.

SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your soundbar system:

- 1. Placement:** Place the soundbar on a stable, flat surface, preferably below your TV. Position the wired subwoofer in a suitable location for optimal bass response.
- 2. Connect Subwoofer:** Connect the wired subwoofer to the 'SUB OUT' port on the back of the soundbar using the appropriate cable.
- 3. Connect Audio Source (Optional):**
 - **Bluetooth:** For wireless connection, proceed to the 'Operating Instructions' section.
 - **AUX In:** Connect your audio device (e.g., TV, tablet, laptop) to the 'AUX IN' (L-AUX IN-R) ports on the back of the soundbar using an RCA audio cable.
 - **USB/SD:** Insert a USB drive or SD card into the respective slots on the side control panel.
- 4. Power Connection:** Connect the power cable to the soundbar's power input and then plug it into a standard electrical outlet (230V).
- 5. Power On:** Flip the main power switch on the back of the soundbar to the 'ON' position. Then, press the 'POWER' button on the side control panel to turn on the unit.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Learn how to use the various functions of your Thomson SBC255BT Soundbar.

Control Panel Functions (Touch Control)

- **POWER:** Press to turn the soundbar on or off.
- **MODE:** Press to cycle through input modes (Bluetooth, AUX, USB, SD).
- **VOL - / VOL +:** Press to decrease or increase the volume.

- **PREVIOUS / NEXT:** Press to skip to the previous or next track (in Bluetooth, USB, or SD modes).
- **PLAY / PAUSE:** Press to play or pause audio (in Bluetooth, USB, or SD modes).

Bluetooth Pairing

1. Turn on the soundbar and select 'Bluetooth' mode using the MODE button. The soundbar will enter pairing mode, indicated by a flashing LED indicator.
2. On your smartphone, tablet, or laptop, enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
3. Select 'SBC255BT' from the list of devices.
4. Once paired, the LED indicator will stop flashing, and you will hear a confirmation tone. You can now play audio wirelessly through the soundbar.

USB/SD Card Playback

1. Insert a USB flash drive or SD card containing MP3 audio files into the corresponding slot on the soundbar's side panel.
2. Press the MODE button to select 'USB' or 'SD' mode. The soundbar will automatically begin playing the audio files.
3. Use the PREVIOUS/NEXT and PLAY/PAUSE buttons to control playback.

AUX Input Playback

1. Connect your external audio device to the 'AUX IN' ports on the soundbar.
2. Press the MODE button to select 'AUX' mode.
3. Play audio from your connected device. The soundbar will output the sound.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care ensures the longevity of your soundbar system.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the surfaces of the soundbar and subwoofer. Do not use liquid cleaners or abrasive materials.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, store the soundbar in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure that the ventilation openings are not obstructed to prevent overheating.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power cable not connected; Main power switch off; Unit not turned on.	Ensure power cable is securely connected. Flip main power switch to ON. Press the POWER button on the control panel.
No sound	Volume too low; Incorrect input mode; Audio cable not connected properly; Bluetooth not paired.	Increase volume. Press MODE to select correct input. Check audio cable connections. Re-pair Bluetooth device.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bluetooth pairing fails	Soundbar not in pairing mode; Device too far; Bluetooth disabled on source device.	Ensure soundbar is in Bluetooth pairing mode (flashing LED). Move device closer to soundbar. Enable Bluetooth on your source device.
USB/SD card not playing	Incorrect mode; Unsupported file format; Corrupted files.	Select USB/SD mode. Ensure files are MP3 format. Try another USB/SD card.
