# Motorola Moto G35 5G User Manual

## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

## 2. INITIAL SETUP

3. Place your Nano-SIM cards (up to two) and/or a microSD card into the designated slots on the tray. Ensure the gold contacts are facing down.
4. Carefully push the tray back into the phone until it clicks into place.

Apps crashing or freezing	Close and reopen the app. Clear the app's cache (Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Storage & cache > Clear cache). Restart the phone.
Slow performance	Close unused apps. Clear cache and data of frequently used apps. Free up storage space. Restart the phone.
Cannot connect to Wi-Fi	Ensure Wi-Fi is enabled. Restart your router. Forget the network and reconnect.
