1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The HIFROM HWF65CS is a replacement wick humidifier filter designed to maintain optimal performance and air quality in compatible humidifiers. This filter is engineered to capture impurities from water, ensuring a clean and effective mist output.

1.1 Compatibility

This filter is compatible with the following humidifier models, replacing part numbers HWF65CS, BWF65, and SF206PDQ-UM:

- **Bonaire Humidifier Models:** BCM-1845, BCM-1845C, BCM-1850, BCM-1855

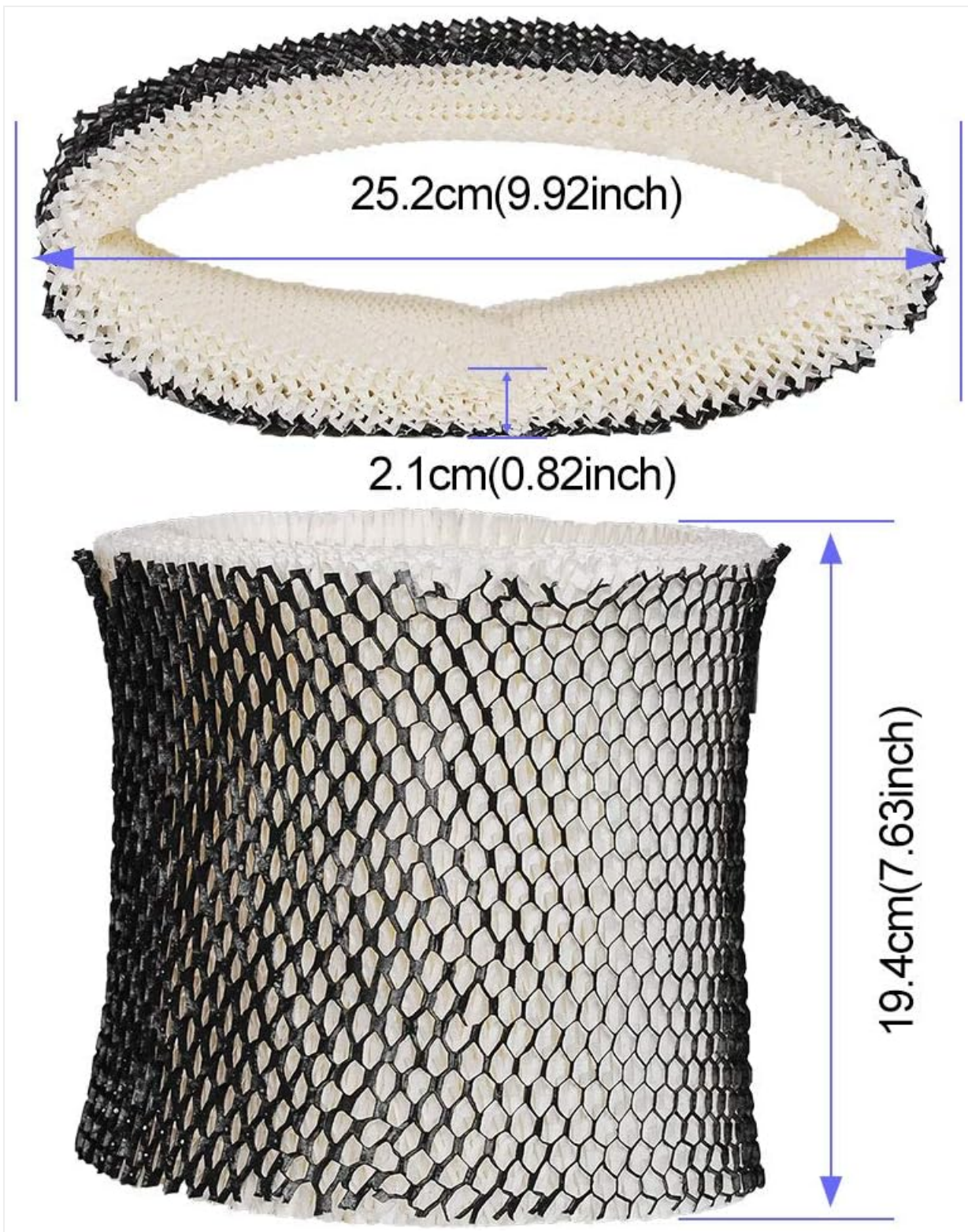

2. INSTALLATION

Follow these steps to properly install the HIFROM HWF65CS humidifier filter into your compatible humidifier.

1. **Step 1: Power Off and Unplug.** Before beginning, ensure your humidifier is turned off and unplugged from the power outlet to prevent electrical hazards.
2. **Step 2: Remove Humidifier Cover.** Carefully remove the top cover or housing of your humidifier to access the filter compartment. Refer to your humidifier's specific manual for exact instructions on accessing the filter.
3. **Step 3: Remove Old Filter.** Locate the old humidifier filter. Grasp it firmly and lift it out of its compartment. Dispose

of the old filter responsibly.

4. **Step 4: Insert New Filter.** Place the new HIFROM HWF65CS filter into the filter compartment. Ensure it sits securely and correctly within the designated slot. The honeycomb pad design should face upwards or as indicated by your humidifier's design.
5. **Step 5: Reassemble Humidifier.** Replace the humidifier cover or housing, ensuring all parts are securely fastened.
6. **Step 6: Refill Water Tank and Power On.** Refill the water tank with clean water and plug the humidifier back into the power outlet. Turn on the humidifier.

3. OPERATION

The HIFROM HWF65CS filter functions as a wick, drawing water from the humidifier's reservoir and exposing it to the air for evaporation. This process adds moisture to the air, improving indoor air quality.

3.1 How the Filter Works

- **Wicking Action:** The filter's material absorbs water from the humidifier tank.
- **Evaporation:** As air passes through the moistened filter, water evaporates, releasing invisible moisture into the room.
- **Impurity Capture:** The filter is designed to trap mineral deposits and other impurities present in the water, preventing them from being released into the air. This helps maintain a clean and healthy mist.

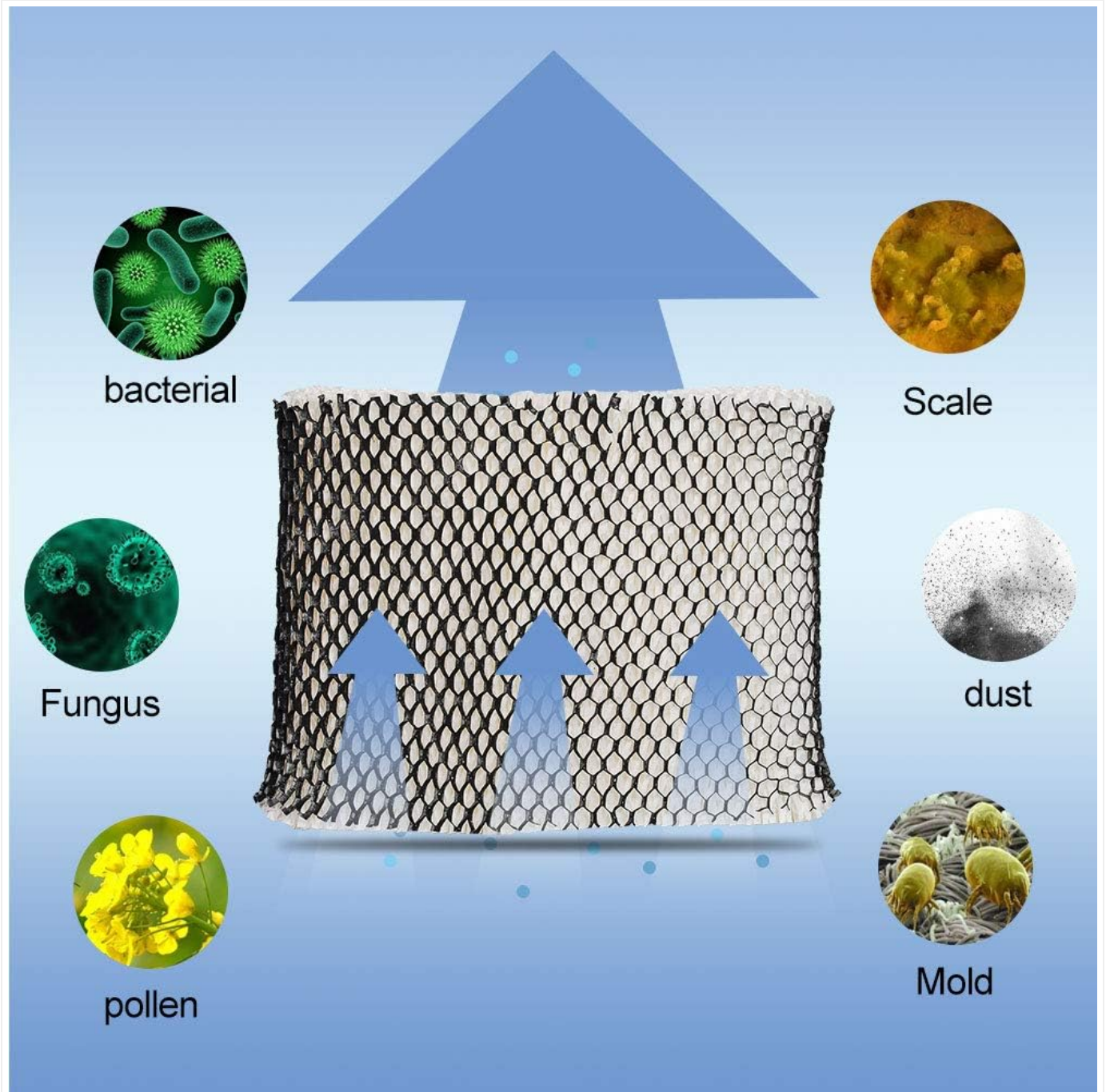

4. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance of your humidifier filter is crucial for optimal performance and air quality.

4.1 Filter Replacement

It is recommended to replace the humidifier filter every 3 months, or more frequently depending on your humidifier's

usage and local water quality. Signs that a filter needs replacement include:

- Reduced moisture output from the humidifier.
- Visible mineral buildup or discoloration on the filter.
- A noticeable decrease in the filter's wicking ability (parts of the filter remaining dry).

Replacing the filter regularly ensures efficient humidification and prevents the release of impurities into your home's air.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues with your humidifier after installing a new filter, consider the following:

- **Low Moisture Output:**
 - Ensure the filter is fully saturated with water. Sometimes new filters need time to absorb water completely.
 - Check if the filter is installed correctly and sitting properly in its compartment.
 - Verify that the humidifier's water tank is adequately filled.
 - If the filter is old, it may be clogged with mineral deposits, reducing its wicking ability. Replace the filter.
- **Unpleasant Odor:**
 - An odor can indicate bacterial growth in the water tank or on the filter. Clean the humidifier thoroughly and replace the filter.
 - Use distilled or demineralized water to reduce mineral buildup and potential odors.
- **Filter Not Wicking Properly:**
 - Ensure the filter is fully submerged in water at the base.
 - Mineral buildup can impede wicking. Replace the filter if it shows significant mineral deposits.
