1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Keter Sequoia Medium Raised Planter. This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your planter. Please read these instructions carefully before use and retain them for future reference.

This raised planter is designed for outdoor use on terraces, balconies, and garden spaces, providing an elevated planting solution for various plants and vegetables. Its weather-resistant construction ensures durability.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always assemble the product on a flat, stable surface.
- Ensure all parts are securely connected before filling the planter.
- Do not overload the planter with excessive soil or weight beyond its capacity.
- Keep small parts away from children during assembly to prevent choking hazards.
- Avoid standing or climbing on the planter.
- Wear appropriate protective gear, such as gloves, during assembly and planting.

4. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly typically requires two people. Some connections may require firm pressure to ensure a secure fit.

1. **Prepare the Area:** Clear a flat, clean, and stable workspace for assembly.
2. **Assemble Side Panels:** Connect the side panels according to the diagrams provided in the included printed manual. Ensure the wood-look texture faces outwards.
3. **Install Base Panels:** Carefully insert the base panels into the grooves or designated slots within the assembled side structure. Ensure they are fully seated.
4. **Attach Top Frame:** Secure the top frame sections to the upper edges of the assembled side panels. Apply even pressure until they click into place.
5. **Insert Water Level Indicator:** Assemble the water level indicator components and insert it into the designated opening in one of the base panels. Ensure it moves freely.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Filling the Planter

- Place a layer of drainage material (e.g., gravel or broken pottery) at the bottom if desired, though the integrated reservoir manages water.
- Fill the planter with high-quality potting mix suitable for your chosen plants. Leave approximately 2-3 cm (1 inch) from the top edge.

5.2 Planting

- Plant your desired flowers, herbs, or vegetables according to their specific requirements for spacing and depth.
- Gently firm the soil around the plants.

5.3 Watering and Drainage

- Water thoroughly after planting. The integrated water reservoir will collect excess water, providing moisture to the plant roots as needed.
- Monitor the water level indicator to determine when re-watering is necessary.
- The planter is designed with an internal reservoir system. If additional drainage is required for specific plant types, modifications to the base may be considered, but this is not part of the standard design and may affect the product's integrity or warranty.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning

- Clean the planter periodically with a mild soap solution and a soft cloth or brush.
- Rinse thoroughly with water. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals, which can damage the material.

6.2 Weather Resistance

- The Keter Sequoia planter is constructed from durable, weather-resistant plastic designed to withstand various outdoor conditions.
- While resistant to UV rays and general weather, extreme conditions may still impact its longevity.

6.3 Winter Care

- In regions with harsh winters, consider emptying the planter and storing it in a sheltered area to prolong its lifespan.
- Ensure any standing water in the reservoir is drained to prevent freezing and potential damage.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

7.1 Water Drainage Issues

- The planter features an integrated water reservoir system. If plants appear waterlogged, ensure the water level indicator is functioning correctly and not stuck.
- For plants requiring very sharp drainage, consider adding a thicker layer of coarse material at the bottom or selecting plants that tolerate moist conditions.

7.2 Assembly Difficulty

- If parts are difficult to connect, ensure they are correctly aligned. Applying firm, even pressure is often necessary for secure interlocking.
- Refer to the detailed diagrams in the printed manual for visual guidance.
