1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Snow Peak Sorotento & Tarp SDI-101 is a versatile and lightweight outdoor shelter designed for camping, hiking, and various outdoor adventures. It features a modern, minimalist design and a waterproof construction to provide reliable protection in diverse conditions. This product is engineered for ease of setup and portability, making it an ideal choice for solo adventurers or small groups.

- **Waterproof Tarp:** Constructed from durable tarp material for water resistance and protection.
- **Modern Style:** Features a sleek and minimalist design with clean lines.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Fire Safety:** Keep all flame and heat sources away from the tent and tarp fabric. The fabric is not fireproof.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure adequate ventilation to prevent condensation and carbon monoxide buildup if using heating or cooking appliances inside or near the shelter.
- **Weather Conditions:** Do not use the tent or tarp in extreme weather conditions such as severe winds, heavy snow, or lightning storms. Seek appropriate shelter during such events.
- **Anchoring:** Always properly anchor the tent and tarp using all provided guy lines and stakes to prevent collapse or damage from wind.
- **Site Selection:** Choose a flat, clear area free from sharp objects, overhead hazards, and potential water runoff.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present before proceeding with setup:

- Rainfly (Tarp)
- Inner Tent
- Tent Poles (Aluminum)
- Stakes (Duralumin, 12 count)
- Guy Lines (9 count)
- Storage Bag

4. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps for proper assembly of your Snow Peak Sorotento & Tarp:

1. **Site Selection:** Choose a level area, clear of debris and potential water accumulation.
2. **Unpack Components:** Lay out the rainfly (tarp) and inner tent. Identify all poles, stakes, and guy lines.
3. **Position the Tarp:** Spread the tarp on the ground in your desired orientation.
4. **Connect Tent to Tarp:** Connect the inner tent to the tarp using the provided attachment points.
5. **Insert Poles:** Insert the aluminum poles into the designated sleeves or grommets on the tent and tarp. Extend them to their full length.
6. **Secure with Stakes:** Secure the tent and tarp to the ground using the 12 duralumin stakes. Ensure all corners and guy line points are firmly anchored.
7. **Adjust Guy Lines:** Adjust the 9 guy lines to create tension and stability. Ensure the tent and tarp are taut and wrinkle-free.
8. **Final Checks:** Verify all zippers are closed and the structure is stable.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

To maximize your experience with the Sorotento & Tarp, consider the following operational guidelines:

- **Ventilation:** Utilize the tent's door and window for airflow. In humid conditions, proper ventilation helps reduce internal condensation.
- **Adjusting Tarp Height:** The tarp can be adjusted to various heights and configurations using additional poles (not included) or natural anchors to adapt to sun, wind, or rain.
- **Securing in Wind:** In windy conditions, ensure all guy lines are taut and stakes are firmly in the ground. Consider adding extra stakes or using heavier objects to secure the base.
- **Internal Lighting:** The tent features internal loops for hanging lightweight lanterns or lights.

6. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will extend the lifespan of your Sorotento & Tarp:

- **Cleaning:** Hand wash the tent and tarp with mild soap and water. Do not use harsh detergents or bleach. Rinse thoroughly.
- **Drying:** Always ensure the tent and tarp are completely dry before packing away to prevent mildew and fabric degradation. Air dry in a shaded area.
- **Storage:** Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Avoid compressing the fabric for long periods.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect poles for damage, fabric for tears or wear, and zippers for smooth operation. Repair any damage promptly.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter:

- **Condensation Inside Tent:** Increase ventilation by opening doors or windows. Ensure the tent is not pitched in a low-lying, damp area.
- **Tarp/Tent Instability:** Re-check all stakes and guy lines. Ensure they are taut and securely anchored. Adjust pole positions if necessary.
- **Water Leakage:** Inspect the fabric for small holes or tears. Apply seam sealer to seams if leakage persists. Ensure the rainfly is properly tensioned and not touching the inner tent.

- **Difficulty with Pole Assembly:** Ensure poles are fully extended and connected. Avoid forcing connections.
