1. Introduction

3. SETUP

Follow these steps to connect your USB cable to your Logitech Harmony Touch remote control:

- 1. **Identify Connectors:** Locate the USB Type-A connector (the larger, rectangular end) and the Micro-USB connector (the smaller, trapezoidal end) on your cable.
- 2. **Connect to Power Source/Computer:** Insert the USB Type-A connector into a compatible USB port on a power adapter (e.g., wall charger, computer USB port, power bank).
- 3. **Connect to Remote Control:** Carefully insert the Micro-USB connector into the corresponding port on your Logitech Harmony Touch remote control. Ensure the connector is oriented correctly to avoid damage.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once connected, the cable facilitates two primary functions for your Logitech Harmony Touch remote:

4.1. Charging the Remote Control

- Connect the cable as described in the Setup section.
- Ensure the power source is active.
- The remote control should indicate that it is charging. Refer to your Logitech Harmony Touch remote's manual for specific charging indicators.

4.2. Data Transfer/Synchronization (if applicable)

- If your Logitech Harmony Touch remote supports data transfer or synchronization via USB, connect the USB Type-A end to a computer.
- Follow the instructions provided by Logitech's software for your remote control to perform updates or synchronize settings.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper care will extend the life of your USB cable:

- Cleaning: Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the cable and connectors. Avoid using liquid cleaners or abrasive materials.
- **Storage:** Store the cable in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. The tangle-free design allows for easy coiling.
- **Handling:** Always grasp the connector housing when plugging or unplugging the cable. Avoid pulling directly on the cable itself to prevent internal damage.
- Avoid Bending: While designed to be tangle-free, avoid sharp bends or kinks, especially near the
 connectors, to maintain cable integrity.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your USB cable, consider the following:

- Remote Not Charging:
 - Ensure both ends of the cable are securely connected.
 - Try a different USB port or power adapter.

- Verify the power source is active and functioning correctly.
- Check if the remote control itself is functioning properly with its original charging accessories.

• Cable Not Recognized by Computer:

- Ensure the cable is fully inserted into both the computer and the remote.
- Try a different USB port on your computer.
- Restart your computer and the remote control.
- Ensure necessary drivers or software for your Logitech Harmony Touch remote are installed on your computer.
- **Physical Damage:** Inspect the cable for any visible signs of damage, such as frayed wires or bent connectors. If damaged, discontinue use and replace the cable.
