Parkside Polishing Set PWP 90 B2 Instruction Manual

INTRODUCTION

This instruction manual provides essential information for the safe and effective use of your Parkside Polishing Set PWP 90 B2. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use and keep it for future reference. This set is designed for use with the Parkside PWP 90 B2 polisher (LIDL IAN 104097, 273271) for vehicle care, specifically for applying polishes and waxes.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

The Parkside Polishing Set PWP 90 B2 includes the following components:

- **1x Polishing Plate:** The base attachment for the polisher.
- **1x Sponge Cap:** Designed for applying polishes.
- **1x Synthetic Fur Cap:** Designed for waxing and buffing.

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to correctly attach the polishing accessories to your Parkside PWP 90 B2 polisher:

1. **Ensure Polisher is Off:** Before attaching any accessories, ensure your Parkside PWP 90 B2 polisher is switched off and unplugged from the power source to prevent accidental startup.
2. **Attach Polishing Plate:** Securely fasten the polishing plate to the polisher's spindle. Refer to your polisher's manual for specific attachment instructions if needed.
3. **Select and Attach Cap:**
 - For polishing, use the **Sponge Cap**. Carefully stretch the sponge cap over the polishing plate, ensuring it fits snugly and is centered.
 - For waxing or buffing, use the **Synthetic Fur Cap**. Stretch the synthetic fur cap over the

polishing plate, ensuring a secure and even fit.

4. **Verify Attachment:** Gently tug on the attached cap to ensure it is firmly secured to the polishing plate and will not detach during operation.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This section outlines the general procedure for using the polishing set. Always refer to your polisher's specific operating instructions and the polish/wax product's guidelines.

General Polishing Procedure:

1. **Prepare Surface:** Ensure the surface to be polished is clean, dry, and free of dirt or debris.
2. **Apply Polish:** Apply a small amount of polishing compound directly onto the sponge cap or the surface area to be polished. Do not over-apply.
3. **Start Polisher:** Place the polisher with the sponge cap flat on the surface before turning it on. Start at a low speed and gradually increase as needed.
4. **Polish Area:** Move the polisher in a consistent, overlapping pattern (e.g., cross-hatch) over the surface. Apply light, even pressure. Avoid pressing too hard, as this can generate excessive heat.
5. **Monitor Progress:** Continuously check the surface for desired results.
6. **Turn Off Polisher:** Before lifting the polisher from the surface, turn it off.
7. **Wipe Residue:** Use a clean microfiber cloth to wipe off any polish residue.

General Waxing/Buffering Procedure:

1. **Prepare Surface:** Ensure the surface is clean and dry, ideally after polishing.
2. **Apply Wax:** Apply a thin, even layer of wax to the synthetic fur cap or directly to the surface.
3. **Start Polisher:** Place the polisher with the synthetic fur cap flat on the surface before turning it on. Use a low to medium speed.
4. **Wax/Buf Area:** Move the polisher in a consistent, overlapping pattern. The synthetic fur cap is excellent for spreading wax evenly and buffing to a high shine.
5. **Turn Off Polisher:** Before lifting the polisher from the surface, turn it off.
6. **Final Buff (Optional):** For an even higher shine, a final hand buff with a clean, dry microfiber cloth may be performed.

Important Safety Note:

- Always wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE), such as safety glasses.
- Do not use the polisher near flammable liquids or gases.
- Avoid applying excessive pressure, which can damage the surface or the polisher.
- Regularly check the caps for wear and tear. Replace them if they become damaged or ineffective.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper maintenance extends the life of your polishing set and ensures optimal performance.

1. Cleaning Caps:

- After each use, remove the sponge and synthetic fur caps from the polishing plate.
- Wash the caps thoroughly with warm water and a mild detergent. Gently squeeze out excess product and dirt.
- Rinse thoroughly until all soap residue is gone.
- Allow the caps to air dry completely before storing or reusing. Do not tumble dry or expose to direct heat.

2. **Cleaning Polishing Plate:** Wipe the polishing plate with a damp cloth to remove any residue. Ensure it is dry before storage.

3. **Storage:** Store the polishing set components in a clean, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

4. **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the caps for signs of wear, tears, or hardening. Replace them if they are no longer effective or show damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your polishing set.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Poor polishing/waxing results (streaks, uneven finish)	Too much or too little product applied. Cap is dirty or worn out. Uneven pressure or inconsistent movement. Surface not properly cleaned.	Adjust product quantity. Clean or replace the cap. Maintain even pressure and consistent movement. Ensure surface is thoroughly cleaned before starting.
Cap detaches during operation	Cap not securely attached. Cap is stretched or worn out. Excessive speed or pressure.	Ensure cap is snugly fitted and centered on the polishing plate. Replace the cap if it's loose or damaged. Use appropriate speed and pressure for the task.
Excessive heat generation	Too much pressure applied. Working on one spot for too long.	Reduce pressure. Keep the polisher moving constantly.
