1. INTRODUCTION

Mortal Kombat 11 for Nintendo Switch is a fighting game developed by NetherRealm Studios and published by Warner Bros. Interactive Entertainment. This manual provides essential information for setting up, playing, and maintaining your game to ensure an optimal experience. It covers basic controls, game modes, and troubleshooting tips.

2. SETUP

2.1 Installing the Game Card

1. Ensure your Nintendo Switch console is powered off or in sleep mode.

2. Locate the game card slot on your Nintendo Switch console. This is typically on the top right side.
3. Insert the Mortal Kombat 11 game card into the slot with the label facing the same direction as the console's screen. Push gently until it clicks into place.
4. Power on your Nintendo Switch. The game icon should appear on the HOME Menu.

3.1 Basic Controls (Nintendo Switch Pro Controller / Joy-Cons)

Note: Specific character moves and special attacks are detailed within the game's move list, accessible during gameplay.

3.2 Key Gameplay Features

- **Custom Character Variations:** Personalize your fighters with unique gear, abilities, and cosmetic options. These variations impact gameplay and strategy.
- **Fatal Blows:** A powerful attack available once per match when your health is low. It deals significant damage and can turn the tide of a fight.
- **Krushing Blows:** Cinematic, enhanced versions of certain attacks that trigger under specific conditions, dealing extra damage and showing a brutal animation.
- **Fatalities & Brutalities:** Signature finishing moves executed at the end of a match. Fatalities are elaborate, while Brutalities are quicker, often requiring specific conditions to be met during the final hit.

3.3 Game Modes

Story Mode:

Explore Shang Tsung's island in a third-person adventure mode to unlock new gear, fatalities, and concept art.

Online Modes:

Compete against other players globally in ranked or casual matches, or participate in King of the Hill lobbies.

Training:

Practice your moves, combos, and strategies against a customizable AI opponent.

4. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the best performance and longevity of your game and console, consider the following:

- **Software Updates:** Regularly check for and install game updates. These often include bug fixes, performance improvements, and new content. Ensure your Nintendo Switch system software is also up to date.
- **Game Card Care:** Handle the game card by its edges. Avoid touching the metal connectors. Store the game card in its case when not in use to protect it from dust and damage.
- **Console Storage:** Monitor your Nintendo Switch's storage space. If you have many digital games or updates, consider archiving software or using a microSD card to free up space.
- **Cleaning:** Keep your Nintendo Switch console and accessories clean. Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe down surfaces. Avoid harsh chemicals.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues while playing Mortal Kombat 11, try the following solutions:

Game Not Loading / Freezing:

- Ensure the game card is properly inserted. Remove and reinsert it.
- Restart your Nintendo Switch console.
- Check for any pending game updates and install them.
- Clean the game card's metal connectors with a soft, dry cloth.

Performance Issues (Lag, Frame Drops):

- Ensure your Nintendo Switch system software and game are fully updated.
- Close any other applications running in the background on your console.
- If playing docked, ensure proper ventilation for the console.
- Consider restarting the console to clear temporary memory.

Online Connectivity Problems:

- Verify your Nintendo Switch is connected to a stable internet connection.
- Test your internet connection from the Nintendo Switch system settings.
- Restart your router and modem.
- Check the Nintendo Switch Online service status page for any reported outages.

Controller Input Not Responding:

- Ensure your Joy-Cons or Pro Controller are properly paired and charged.
- Try re-pairing your controllers through the HOME Menu's Controllers section.
- Check for any controller firmware updates.
