# Beldray Multi-Cyclonic Pet Vacuum Cleaner

## 1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Beldray Multi-Cyclonic Pet Vacuum Cleaner. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your appliance. Please read it thoroughly before first use and keep it for future reference.

This vacuum cleaner is designed to effortlessly remove dirt, dust, and pet hair from both carpets and hard floors, utilizing powerful multi-cyclonic suction technology. Its compact and lightweight design, along with a 2.5-liter dust compartment, ensures convenient cleaning and storage.

### Important Safety Information

- Always ensure the voltage indicated on the product corresponds with your mains supply.
- Do not immerse the appliance in water or any other liquid.
- Unplug the vacuum cleaner from the mains socket before cleaning or performing any maintenance.
- Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of the body away from openings and moving parts.
- Do not vacuum up flammable or combustible materials, hot ashes, or sharp objects.
- This appliance is for domestic use only.

## 2. PRODUCT COMPONENTS

The Beldray Multi-Cyclonic Pet Vacuum Cleaner comes with several components designed for effective cleaning:

- Main Vacuum Unit (with 2.5L dust compartment)
- Flexible Hose
- Telescopic Handle
- Floor Brush (for carpets and hard floors)
- 2-in-1 Crevice Tool
- Pet Hair Attachment

### 3. SETUP

Follow these steps to assemble your vacuum cleaner before first use:

1. **Attach the Flexible Hose:** Insert the end of the flexible hose into the suction inlet on the main vacuum unit until it clicks securely into place.
2. **Assemble the Telescopic Handle:** Connect the telescopic handle to the other end of the flexible hose. Extend the telescopic handle to your desired length by pressing the release button and pulling the sections apart.
3. **Connect the Floor Brush:** Attach the floor brush to the end of the telescopic handle. Ensure it is firmly connected.
4. **Power Connection:** Unwind the power cord and plug it into a suitable mains socket.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### General Operation

1. Ensure the vacuum cleaner is correctly assembled and plugged into a power outlet.
2. Press the power button located on the main unit to switch on the vacuum cleaner.
3. Guide the floor brush over the surface you wish to clean.
4. To switch off, press the power button again. Unplug the appliance after use.

## Using the Floor Brush

The floor brush is versatile for different floor types:

- **For Carpets:** Ensure the brush setting is engaged (bristles retracted) for optimal suction on carpets.
- **For Hard Floors:** Engage the brush setting (bristles extended) to protect hard surfaces and effectively pick up debris.

## Using Attachments

To use attachments, remove the floor brush from the telescopic handle and attach the desired tool directly to the handle or hose.

- **Pet Hair Attachment:** Ideal for removing stubborn pet hair from upholstery, stairs, and car interiors.
- **2-in-1 Crevice Tool:** Use the narrow end for tight spaces, corners, and edges. The brush attachment can be slid over for dusting delicate surfaces.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your vacuum cleaner.

### Emptying the Dust Compartment

The vacuum cleaner features a 2.5-liter dust compartment. Empty it regularly, especially when it reaches the 'MAX' fill line, to maintain strong suction.

1. Ensure the vacuum cleaner is switched off and unplugged.
2. Press the release button to detach the dust compartment from the main unit.
3. Position the dust compartment over a waste bin and open the bottom flap to empty the contents.
4. Close the flap securely and reattach the dust compartment to the main unit.

### Cleaning the Filters

The multi-cyclonic filtration system includes washable filters. Clean them periodically to prevent loss of suction.

1. With the dust compartment removed, locate the filters.



2. Carefully remove the filters. Tap them gently over a bin to remove loose dust.
3. Rinse the filters under cold running water until the water runs clear. Do not use detergents.
4. Allow the filters to air dry completely for at least 24 hours before reinserting them. Do not use a hairdryer or other heating devices.
5. Reassemble the filters and dust compartment once fully dry.

### Cleaning Attachments and Hose

Periodically check the hose and attachments for blockages. Clear any obstructions to maintain airflow.

- Disconnect attachments and the hose from the main unit.
- Visually inspect for any debris or blockages. Use a long, blunt object to carefully dislodge any obstructions.
- Wipe attachments with a damp cloth if necessary. Ensure they are dry before reattaching.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your vacuum cleaner, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vacuum cleaner does not turn on.	Not plugged in; no power at outlet; power button not pressed.	Check power cord connection; test outlet with another appliance; press power button firmly.
Loss of suction.	Dust compartment full; filters clogged; hose/attachments blocked.	Empty dust compartment; clean or replace filters; check and clear blockages in hose/attachments.
Unusual noise during operation.	Blockage in hose/attachments; foreign object in brush head.	Switch off and unplug. Inspect hose, attachments, and brush head for obstructions and remove them.
Dust escaping from vacuum.	Dust compartment not properly sealed; filters not correctly installed or damaged.	Ensure dust compartment is securely attached; check and correctly install filters; replace damaged filters.
