# Noritz RC-7606S Bathroom Remote Control User Manual (Non-Auto-Stop Type)

For Dedicated Water Heaters

## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides detailed instructions for the safe and efficient use of your Noritz RC-7606S Bathroom Remote Control. This remote is designed for use with dedicated water heaters and does not feature an auto-stop function for bath filling. Please read this manual thoroughly before installation and operation to ensure proper functionality and safety.

## 4. PACKAGE CONTENTS

---

The following items are included with your Noritz RC-7606S Bathroom Remote Control:

- Round head wood screws  $\phi 4.1 \times 25 \times 2$
- All plugs  $\#6 \times 25 \times 2$

## 5. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

---

**Note: Installation of this remote control requires specialized knowledge and tools. It must be performed by a certified professional.**

### 5.1 Pre-Installation Checks

1. Ensure the main power to the water heater is turned off at the circuit breaker.
2. Verify that the water heater model is listed as compatible in the "Product Overview" section.
3. Confirm all necessary wiring and mounting hardware are available.

### 5.2 Mounting the Remote Control

The remote control unit should be mounted in a suitable location within the bathroom, away from direct water spray. Use the provided screws and plugs for secure installation. Refer to the detailed installation manual provided with the water heater for specific wiring diagrams and connection points.

### 5.3 Electrical Connections

Connect the remote control wiring to the designated terminals on the water heater control board. Ensure correct polarity and secure connections to prevent electrical hazards. Consult the water heater's installation manual for precise wiring instructions.

### 5.4 Post-Installation

After installation, restore power to the water heater and test the remote control's functionality. Check for proper display, button responsiveness, and communication with the water heater.

## 6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 6.1 Power On/Off

Press the **Power** button to turn the water heater on or off via the remote control. The display will illuminate when the unit is active.

### 6.2 Temperature Adjustment

Use the **Up** and **Down** arrow buttons to adjust the desired water temperature. The current temperature setting will be shown on the display.

### 6.3 Function Indicators

The display may show various indicators for operational status, error codes, or specific functions. Refer to the water heater's main manual for a complete list of display icons and their meanings.

### 6.4 Non-Auto-Stop Feature

This model is a non-auto-stop type. It provides control over the water heater's basic functions but does not automatically stop water flow when filling a bath to a preset level. Users must manually monitor and stop the water flow.

## 7. MAINTENANCE

---

### 7.1 Cleaning

Wipe the remote control surface with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or chemical sprays, as these can damage the display and casing.

### 7.2 Inspection

Periodically check the remote control and its wiring for any signs of damage or loose connections. If any issues are found, contact a qualified service technician.

## 8. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

### 8.1 No Display/No Power

- Check if the main power to the water heater is on.
- Ensure the remote control's wiring connections are secure.
- If the issue persists, contact a qualified technician.

### 8.2 Incorrect Temperature

- Verify the temperature setting on the remote control.
- Allow time for the water heater to reach the desired temperature.
- If the problem continues, consult the water heater's main manual or a service professional.

### 8.3 Buttons Unresponsive

- Ensure the remote control surface is clean and free from obstructions.
- Try turning the water heater off and on again at the main power source.
- If buttons remain unresponsive, professional service may be required.
