Setup

Unpacking

1. Carefully remove the scan handle from its packaging.
2. Inspect the handle for any signs of damage. If damaged, do not proceed with installation and contact customer support.
3. Ensure all components are present as listed on the packaging.

Installation

1. Ensure your Honeywell CT40 Computer is powered off before attaching the handle.
2. Align the CT40 Computer with the mounting grooves on the top of the scan handle.
3. Gently slide the CT40 Computer into the handle until it clicks securely into place. Ensure the connection is firm and there is no wobble.
4. Verify that the CT40 Computer's ports and buttons remain accessible and unobstructed by the handle.

Operating Instructions

Attaching the Scan Handle

The scan handle is designed for easy attachment and detachment. Follow the installation steps above to attach the CT40 Computer. To detach, locate the release mechanism (if present, typically a small lever or button) and gently slide the CT40 Computer out of the handle.

Using the Scan Handle

- Once the CT40 Computer is securely attached, hold the handle comfortably in your hand.
- Point the scanning window of the CT40 Computer towards the barcode or data matrix you wish to scan.
- Press the trigger button located on the handle to activate the scanner.
- Ensure the scan beam fully covers the barcode for optimal reading performance.
- A successful scan is typically indicated by an audible beep or a visual confirmation on the CT40 Computer's screen.

Maintenance

Cleaning

- Regularly clean the exterior of the scan handle with a soft, damp cloth.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or solvents, as these can damage the material.
- Ensure no liquid enters the internal components or the connection points.
- For the scanning window on the CT40 Computer, refer to the CT40 user manual for specific cleaning instructions.

Storage

- Store the scan handle in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- When not in use, it is recommended to store the CT40 Computer and scan handle in a protective case or on a charging dock.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
CT40 Computer does not fit securely.	Incorrect alignment or debris in connection.	Ensure proper alignment; check for and remove any debris from the connection points on both the handle and the CT40 Computer.
Scan trigger unresponsive.	CT40 Computer not fully seated or powered off.	Verify the CT40 Computer is securely attached and powered on. Refer to the CT40 user manual for scanner activation.
Handle feels loose after attachment.	Improper installation or worn locking mechanism.	Re-attach the CT40 Computer, ensuring it clicks firmly into place. If the issue persists, the locking mechanism may be worn; contact customer support.
