1. INTRODUCTION

3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to set up your Marvo CM370 Gaming Combo:

3.1. Connecting the Keyboard

1. Locate an available USB 2.0 port on your computer.
2. Plug the USB connector of the keyboard into the USB port.
3. The keyboard's RGB backlight will illuminate upon successful connection. Your operating system should automatically install the necessary drivers.

3.2. Connecting the Mouse

1. Locate another available USB 2.0 port on your computer.
2. Plug the USB connector of the mouse into the USB port.
3. The mouse's 7-color backlight will activate. Drivers will typically install automatically.

3.3. Connecting the Headset

1. Identify the two 3.5mm jack connectors on the headset cable: one for audio (typically green) and one for the microphone (typically pink).
2. Plug the audio jack into your computer's audio output port (usually green).
3. Plug the microphone jack into your computer's microphone input port (usually pink).
4. Adjust your computer's sound settings to ensure the headset is selected as the default playback and recording device.

3.4. Mousepad Placement

Place the gaming mousepad on a flat, stable surface. Its anti-skid rubber base will ensure it remains firmly in place during use.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1. Keyboard Usage

The Marvo CM370 keyboard features 104 keys with a membrane switch type, designed for responsive input. The mixed-color (Rainbow) backlight provides visual appeal and aids visibility in low-light conditions.

- **Standard Typing:** Use as a conventional keyboard for all typing tasks.
- **Multimedia Keys:** Utilize the function keys (F1-F12) in combination with the 'Fn' key for multimedia controls (e.g., volume, play/pause). Refer to the keycap legends for specific functions.
- **Backlight Control:** The keyboard's backlight is static rainbow. There are no user-adjustable modes for the backlight.

4.2. Mouse Usage

The optical gaming mouse offers precise tracking and customizable DPI settings.

- **DPI Adjustment:** Use the dedicated DPI button (located behind the scroll wheel) to cycle through DPI settings: 800, 1600, 2400, and 3200 DPI. Each setting provides a different cursor speed to suit various gaming and productivity needs.
- **Buttons:** The mouse features 4 buttons: left-click, right-click, scroll wheel (click), and DPI button.
- **Backlight:** The mouse features a dynamic 7-color backlight that cycles automatically.

4.3. Headset Usage

The stereo headset provides clear audio and an omnidirectional microphone for communication.

- **Audio Playback:** Ensure the green 3.5mm jack is connected to your computer's audio output. Adjust volume using

your computer's system controls.

- **Microphone:** Ensure the pink 3.5mm jack is connected to your computer's microphone input. Position the omnidirectional microphone appropriately for clear voice capture. Adjust microphone levels through your computer's sound settings.

4.4. Mousepad Usage

The mousepad is designed for optimal mouse tracking and comfort.

- **Surface:** The surface is ideally suited for high sensitivity mouse settings, providing smooth and precise movement.
- **Durability:** The anti-sweating design helps prevent edge warping, ensuring longevity.
- **Stability:** The anti-skid rubber base keeps the mousepad securely in place during intense gaming sessions.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe down the keyboard, mouse, and headset. For stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth with mild soap can be used, ensuring no liquid enters the devices.
- **Dust Removal:** Use compressed air to clear dust and debris from between keyboard keys and mouse crevices.
- **Cable Management:** Avoid sharp bends or kinks in the cables to prevent internal wire damage.
- **Storage:** Store the devices in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures when not in use.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Marvo CM370 Gaming Combo, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Device Not Recognized / Not Working:**
 - Ensure the USB connectors are fully inserted into the computer's USB ports.
 - Try plugging the devices into different USB ports on your computer.
 - Restart your computer.
 - Check your computer's Device Manager (Windows) to see if the devices are listed and if there are any driver issues.

- **Keyboard Backlight Not On:**

- Verify the keyboard is properly connected to a powered USB port.
- The keyboard backlight is static rainbow and should illuminate upon connection. If not, try reconnecting or restarting the computer.

- **Mouse Cursor Not Moving / Erratic Movement:**

- Ensure the mouse's optical sensor on the bottom is clean and free of debris.
- Use the mouse on a clean, flat surface, preferably the included mousepad.
- Try adjusting the DPI setting using the DPI button on the mouse.

- **Headset No Sound / Microphone Not Working:**

- Confirm both 3.5mm audio and microphone jacks are correctly plugged into the corresponding ports on your computer.
- Check your computer's sound settings to ensure the headset is selected as the default playback and recording device.
- Adjust volume levels in your operating system and any applications you are using.
- Ensure the microphone is not muted in your system settings or communication software.
