SETUP AND PLACEMENT

Follow these steps to properly place your neck speaker and accessories into the protective case:

1. **Open the Case:** Unzip the case completely to reveal the interior compartments.
2. **Position the Speaker:** Carefully place your wearable neck speaker into the main contoured compartment. Ensure it sits snugly within the molded shape to prevent movement during transit.
3. **Store Cables:** Utilize the designated mesh pocket or recessed area within the case to store charging cables or other small accessories. This prevents them from scratching the speaker or becoming tangled.

4. **Verify Fit:** Before closing, ensure that no parts of the speaker or accessories are protruding or being compressed excessively. The case is designed for a snug fit to maximize protection.

OPERATING THE CASE

The case is designed for simple and secure operation:

- **Closing the Zipper:** Once your speaker and accessories are placed inside, carefully close the stainless steel zipper. Ensure the zipper teeth align properly to prevent damage and maintain the case's protective seal.
- **Carrying:** The compact design allows for easy carrying by hand or placement inside larger bags. Some models may include an integrated carabiner for attaching to backpacks or luggage.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and effectiveness of your protective case, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Exterior Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior surface with a damp cloth and mild soap if necessary. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, as these can damage the EVA material.
- **Interior Cleaning:** Gently vacuum or use a lint roller to remove dust and debris from the soft interior lining. For spills, lightly dab with a damp cloth and allow to air dry completely before closing the case.
- **Zipper Care:** Periodically check the zipper for any obstructions. If the zipper becomes stiff, a small amount of zipper lubricant can be applied.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the case in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight to prevent material degradation.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your protective case, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Speaker Does Not Fit:** Ensure your neck speaker model is listed as compatible. While the case is designed for a range of speakers, some larger or uniquely shaped models may not fit perfectly. Do not force the speaker into the case, as this can cause damage to both the speaker and the case.
- **Zipper Sticking:** Check for any fabric or debris caught in the zipper teeth. Gently clear any obstructions. If the

zipper is still stiff, apply a small amount of graphite or a specialized zipper lubricant.

- **Case Odor:** New cases may have a slight manufacturing odor. Air out the case in a well-ventilated area for a few days to dissipate any smells.
