Intex 28053 Pool Frame Seat Instruction Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and efficient use of your Intex 28053 Pool Frame Seat. Please read thoroughly before installation and use. Proper installation and maintenance will ensure optimal performance and longevity of the product.

2. SAFETY WARNINGS

- Always supervise children in and around the pool area.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of **100 kg (220 lbs)**.
- Ensure the seat is securely attached to the pool frame before use.
- Avoid standing on the seat. It is designed for sitting only.
- Inspect the seat regularly for any signs of wear or damage. Discontinue use if damaged.

3. PRODUCT FEATURES

The Intex 28053 Pool Frame Seat is designed for comfort and convenience in your frame pool. Key features include:

- Easy connection to various Intex frame pools: Metal Frame, Prism Frame, and Ultra XTR Frame.
- Tool-free installation on the side of the pool.
- Foldable design for convenient storage and to prevent interference when not in use.
- Wide and comfortable seating area.
- Maximum weight capacity: 100 kg.

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Intex 28053 Pool Frame Seat is designed for quick and easy installation without the need for additional tools.

1. Identify a suitable location on the side of your Intex frame pool where you wish to install the seat. Ensure the area is clear of obstructions.
2. Position the seat's attachment mechanism over the top rail of the pool frame.
3. Align the seat and secure it by tightening the integrated screws or clamps by hand. No tools are required for this step. Ensure the seat is firmly attached and does not wobble.
4. Once secured, gently test the seat's stability before full use.

To fold the seat against the pool wall when not in use, simply lift the seat portion and push it upwards until it locks into its folded position. This helps to keep the pool area clear.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

To use the Intex 28053 Pool Frame Seat:

1. Ensure the seat is in the down position and securely attached to the pool frame.
2. Carefully sit on the seat, distributing your weight evenly.
3. Enjoy a comfortable and relaxing experience in your pool.

When finished, you may fold the seat up against the pool wall to maximize swimming space.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will extend the life of your pool seat.

- **Cleaning:** Clean the seat periodically with mild soap and water. Rinse thoroughly with fresh water to remove any soap residue or pool chemicals.
- **Inspection:** Regularly check all attachment points and the seat structure for any cracks, damage, or signs of wear.
- **Storage:** When the pool is not in use for an extended period, or during off-season, remove the seat from the pool. Clean it thoroughly, allow it to dry completely, and store it in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Intex 28053 Pool Frame Seat, consider the following:

- **Seat feels unstable:** Ensure all attachment screws/clamps are tightened securely. Re-check the installation steps.
- **Difficulty folding/unfolding:** Check for any debris or obstructions in the hinge mechanism. Clean if

necessary.




