Rfiver UT5001 Universal Table Top TV Stand Instruction Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Rfiver UT5001 Universal Table Top TV Stand. Please read this manual thoroughly before installation and use to ensure safe and correct operation. Keep this manual for future reference.

The Rfiver UT5001 is designed to accommodate most 40 to 90 inch flat or curved screen TVs, with a maximum load capacity of 150 lbs (68 kg) and VESA compatibility between 200x100 mm and 800x400 mm.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Weight Capacity:** Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 150 lbs (68 kg). Overloading may result in serious injury or property damage.
- **TV Size:** Ensure your TV size is within the recommended range of 40 to 90 inches.
- **VESA Compatibility:** Verify that your TV's VESA mounting pattern is between 200x100 mm and 800x400 mm.
- **Stable Surface:** Always place the TV stand on a stable, level, and sufficiently wide surface. The TV stand base should be wider than 14.5 inches.
- **Assembly:** Follow all assembly instructions carefully. If you have any doubts, consult a qualified professional.
- **Children:** Keep children away from the assembly area. Small parts may be a choking hazard.
- **Moving the Stand:** When moving the TV stand with a TV mounted, always do so with caution and preferably with assistance to prevent tipping.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before assembly, ensure all parts are present and undamaged. Refer to the parts list in the included manual for detailed identification.

5. SETUP & ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps for proper assembly. It is recommended to have assistance when handling larger TVs.

5.1. Unboxing and Part Identification

Carefully open the package and lay out all components. Compare them with the parts list in your instruction manual to ensure everything is present.

5.2. Assembling the Brackets

Attach the vertical brackets to the back of your TV using the appropriate screws and washers provided. Ensure they are securely fastened.

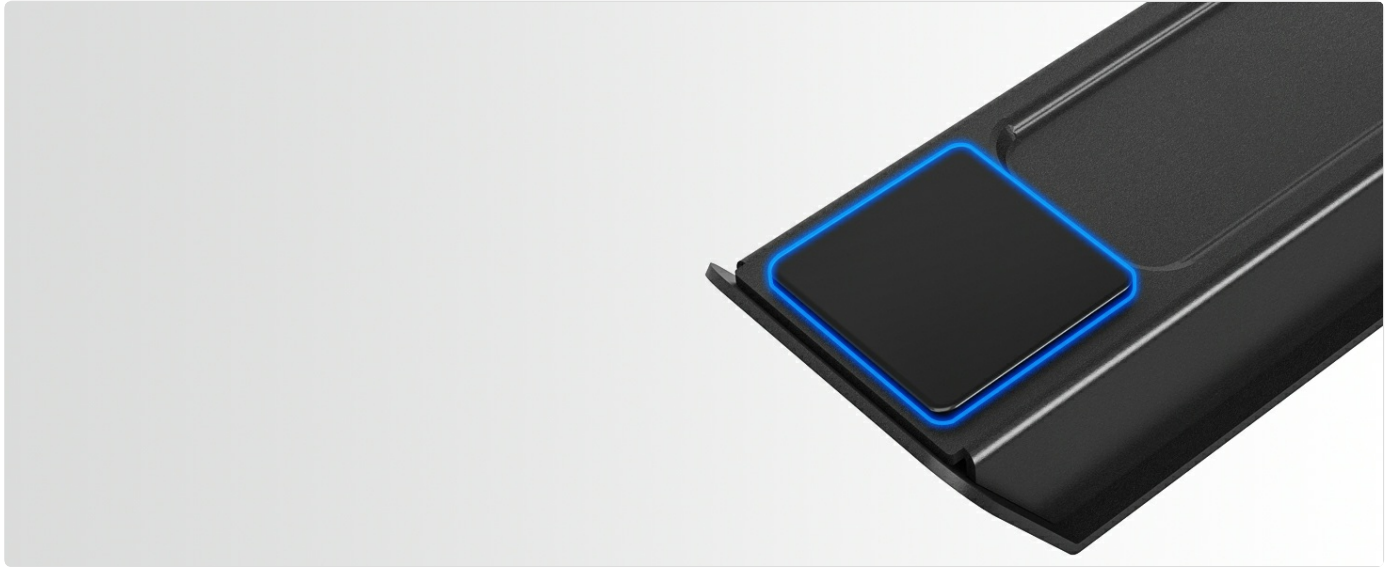


Figure 4: Assembly steps for the TV stand, including attaching brackets to the TV.

5.3. Assembling the Base and Support Column

Connect the support column to the base. Ensure all screws are tightened for stability.

5.4. Mounting the TV

Carefully lift your TV and hook the attached brackets onto the support column. Secure the TV using the provided safety locks.

5.5. Height Adjustment

The stand offers 4 levels of height adjustment. Select the desired height before final tightening of the mounting screws. The height can be adjusted from 21.5" to 30.3" from the table top.

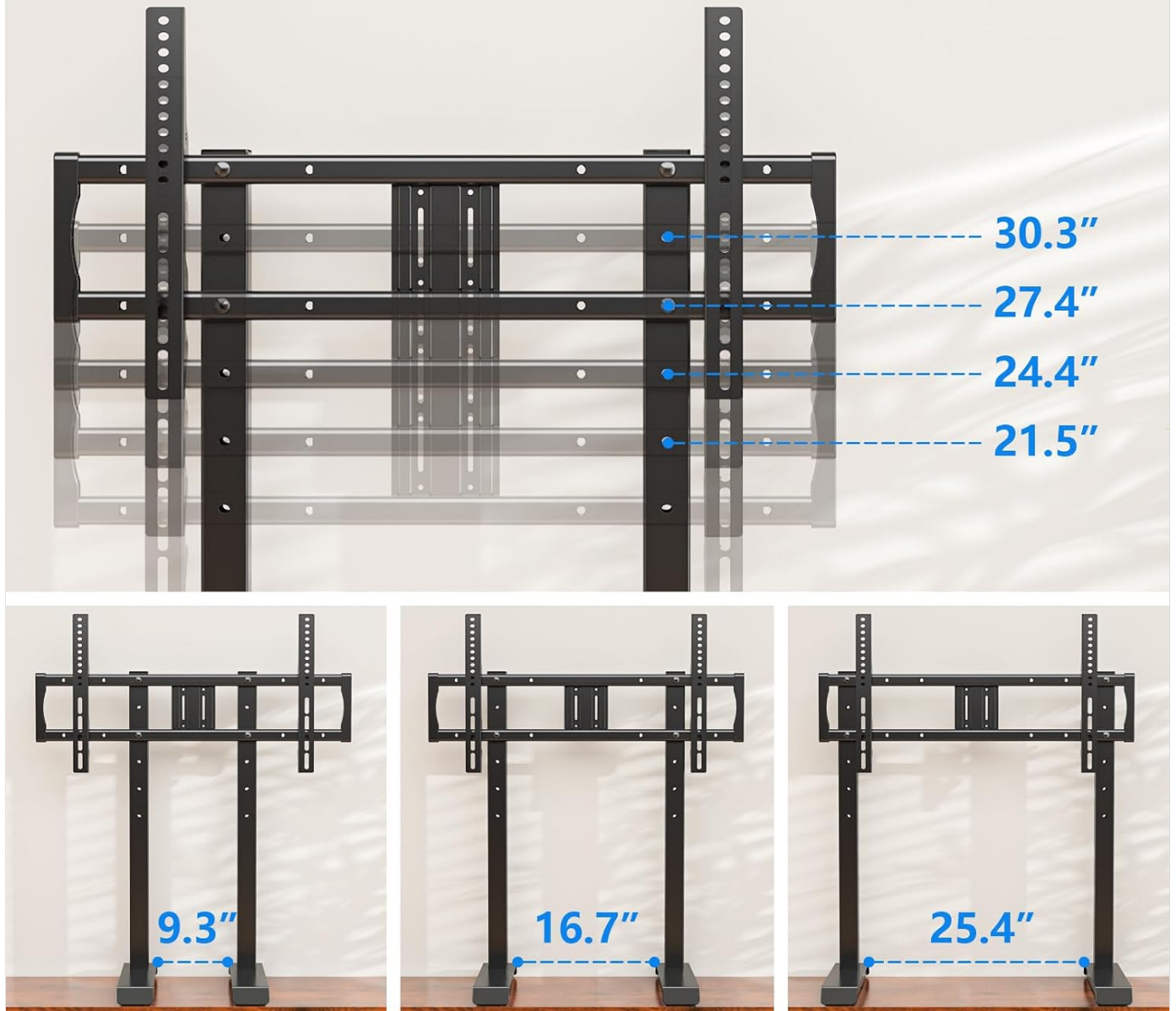


Figure 7: Available height adjustment options for optimal viewing.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1. Swivel Function

The TV stand allows for a swivel of up to ± 25 degrees (depending on the specific model and TV size). Gently rotate the TV to achieve your desired viewing angle. The swivel mechanism is designed for smooth movement.

6.2. Cable Management

Utilize the integrated cable management clips on the support column to organize and conceal TV cables, maintaining a

tidy appearance.

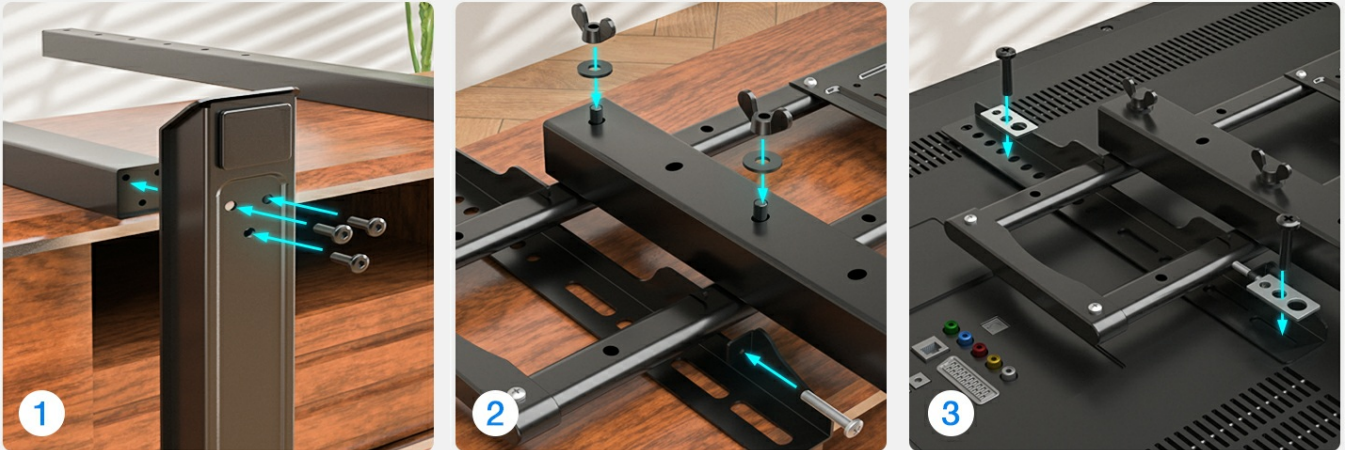


Figure 8: Example of effective cable management using the stand's features.

7. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the stand. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents that may damage the finish.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check all screws and connections to ensure they remain tight and secure. Retighten if necessary.
- **Damage:** If any part of the stand is damaged, discontinue use and contact customer support for replacement parts.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

8.1. TV is not stable

- Ensure all assembly screws are fully tightened.
- Verify that the TV's weight and VESA pattern are within the stand's specifications.
- Confirm the stand is placed on a flat, stable surface.

8.2. Difficulty adjusting height or swivel

- Check for any obstructions preventing movement.
- Ensure no cables are caught in the moving parts.
- If adjusting height, ensure the TV is slightly lifted to relieve pressure on the adjustment mechanism.
