#### **PRODUCT OVERVIEW**

The KW-Trio Multi-Functional Paper Rotary Trimmer is a versatile tool designed for precise cutting of various paper sizes, photos, business cards, and craft materials. It features multiple cutting styles and a built-in corner rounder for enhanced functionality, making it ideal for office, school, and craft use.

#### **Key Features**

- 5-in-1 multi-functional paper trimmer with 4 optional cutting styles (straight, skip, wave, score) and a corner rounder.
- 33cm (13.8 inches) cutting length, suitable for A4, A5, and A6 paper.
- 1mm cutting depth, capable of cutting 3-5 sheets of 80gsm paper at one time.
- Clear scale ruler on the base plate for precise and effective cutting.
- Solid metal cutting base plate matched with a non-slip pad for sturdy performance and long durability.



#### **S**ETUP

The KW-Trio Paper Rotary Trimmer comes pre-assembled and ready for immediate use. Minimal setup is required.

#### **Unpacking**

- Carefully remove the trimmer from its packaging.
- Inspect the trimmer for any signs of damage that may have occurred during transit.
- Ensure all components, including the cutting head and corner rounder, are securely in place.

#### **Placement**

• Place the trimmer on a stable, flat, and non-slip surface to ensure safe and accurate operation.

#### **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

#### **Selecting a Cutting Style**

The trimmer offers five distinct cutting styles: Straight, Skip, Wave, Score, and Round Corner. The main cutting head handles Straight, Skip, Wave, and Score lines, while a separate integrated tool is used for corner rounding.




Image: Demonstrates the various cutting styles available, including straight, skip, wave, and score lines, along with examples of different round corner cuts.

#### Using the Main Cutting Head (Straight, Skip, Wave, Score)

- 1. Identify the desired blade type on the cutting head. The cutting head typically contains multiple blades for different styles, which can be rotated or selected.
- 2. Lift the clear cutting guide bar.
- 3. Place the paper or material flat against the base plate, aligning it with the desired measurement marks or grid lines.
- 4. Lower the clear cutting guide bar firmly to secure the paper in place.
- 5. Press down firmly on the cutting head and slide it along the guide rail to make the cut. Ensure even pressure is applied for a clean and precise cut.

6. Lift the cutting head and guide bar to remove the cut material.

#### **Using the Corner Rounder**

- 1. Locate the separate corner rounder tool, typically integrated into the left side of the trimmer.
- 2. Insert the corner of the paper fully into the slot of the corner rounder.
- 3. Press down firmly on the top of the corner rounder to punch the rounded corner.
- 4. Remove the paper.




Image: A close-up view of the corner rounder tool, demonstrating its function on paper corners and showing various rounding options.

#### MAINTENANCE

#### **Blade Replacement**

Over time, the cutting blades may become dull and require replacement to maintain cutting precision and quality. The trimmer is designed for easy blade replacement.

# How to Replace the Blade

### Choose

Open the holder and find proper blade





# Change

Anti-clockwise rotate to take out the present blade and clockwise rotate to install the new one

## Clean

Put and store the replaced blade in order

- 1. **Choose:** Open the blade holder compartment, typically located on the right side of the trimmer, to access the spare blades. Select the proper blade for replacement.
- 2. **Change:** Carefully remove the cutting head from the guide rail. Rotate the existing blade anti-clockwise to detach it. Install the new blade by rotating it clockwise until it clicks into place.
- 3. **Clean:** After replacement, ensure the old blade is safely stored or disposed of. Clean any paper dust or debris from the blade compartment before closing.




Image: A view of the blade storage compartment, showing multiple spare blades neatly organized within the trimmer's base.

#### **Cleaning**

Regularly clean the trimmer to prevent paper dust and debris from affecting performance and to ensure smooth operation.

- Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe down the base plate, measurement grid, and cutting guide.
- Remove any small paper scraps or dust from the cutting channel and blade area.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or harsh chemicals, as they may damage the plastic or metal components of the trimmer.

#### **TROUBLESHOOTING**

#### **Uneven or Ragged Cuts**

· Cause: Dull blade.

Solution: Replace the blade following the "Blade Replacement" instructions in the Maintenance section.

• Cause: Paper not held securely.

**Solution:** Ensure the paper is laid flat and firmly held under the clear cutting guide bar before sliding the cutting head.

• Cause: Insufficient or inconsistent pressure on the cutting head.

Solution: Apply consistent, firm pressure when sliding the cutting head along the guide rail.

#### **Paper Jams**

• Cause: Attempting to cut too many sheets at once.

**Solution:** Adhere to the maximum cutting capacity (3-5 sheets of 80gsm paper). Reduce the number of sheets per cut.

• Cause: Misaligned paper.

Solution: Ensure paper is properly aligned with the guide and flat against the base before initiating the cut.

#### **Corner Rounder Not Working Effectively**

• Cause: Paper not fully inserted or misaligned.

Solution: Ensure the corner of the paper is fully seated into the slot before pressing down.

• Cause: Dull punch.

**Solution:** While the corner rounder punch is generally durable, excessive force or very thick materials can dull it. If issues persist, contact customer support.




Image: An annotated diagram showing the key dimensions (425mm length, 256mm width, 330mm cutting length) and components of the paper cutter.
