INTRODUCTION

Casio MTP-V004L-1A

Casio MTP-V004L-1A Men's Watch Instruction Manual

MTP-V004L-1A Men's Stainless Steel Leather Band Black Dial Date Watch. Please read this manual

thoroughly to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your timepiece.




Image: Front view of the Casio MTP-V004L-1A watch, showcasing its black dial, silver-tone case, and black leather strap.

1. Setting the Time

- 1. **Pull out the crown:** Gently pull the crown (the knob on the side of the watch case) out to the first click position.
- 2. **Rotate the crown:** Turn the crown in either direction to move the hour and minute hands. Set the time to the current time. Ensure that the AM/PM is correctly set if your watch has a 24-hour indicator or if you are setting the date.
- 3. **Push in the crown:** Once the correct time is set, push the crown back into its normal position.

2. Setting the Date

- 1. **Pull out the crown:** Gently pull the crown out to the first click position.
- 2. Rotate the crown: Turn the crown to adjust the date. The date changes by rotating the crown.
- 3. **Push in the crown:** Once the correct date is set, push the crown back into its normal position.
- 4. *Note:* Avoid setting the date between 9:00 PM and 1:00 AM, as this may interfere with the automatic date change mechanism. If you need to set the date during this period, first set the time outside this range, adjust the date, and then reset the time.

OPERATING THE WATCH

Your Casio MTP-V004L-1A watch is designed for reliable timekeeping with a simple analog display.

- Time Display: The watch features a 3-hand analog display showing hours, minutes, and seconds.
- Date Function: The date window at the 3 o'clock position displays the current day of the month.
- Water Resistance: This watch is water resistant up to 30 meters (3 ATM). This means it is suitable for everyday use and can withstand splashes or brief immersion in water. It is **not** suitable for swimming, diving, or showering. Avoid operating the crown while the watch is wet.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning Your Watch

- Case and Crystal: Wipe the watch case and mineral crystal with a soft, dry cloth to remove dirt and fingerprints. For stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by a dry cloth.
- Leather Band: Avoid prolonged exposure of the leather band to water, direct sunlight, and harsh chemicals. If the band gets wet, wipe it dry immediately with a soft cloth and allow it to air dry naturally. Regular cleaning with a specialized leather cleaner can help maintain its condition.

Battery Replacement

The watch is powered by a single battery. When the watch stops or the second hand moves erratically (e.g., skipping seconds), it indicates that the battery needs to be replaced. Battery replacement should be performed by a qualified watch technician to ensure proper sealing and water resistance integrity.

Water Resistance Precautions

- Always ensure the crown is fully pushed in before exposing the watch to any moisture.
- Do not operate the crown or push buttons (if any) while the watch is submerged in water or wet.

 Avoid exposing the watch to extreme temperature changes, as this can affect the water resistance seals.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Watch Not Running

- Check the crown: Ensure the crown is fully pushed in. If it is pulled out, the watch will not operate.
- **Battery:** The battery may be depleted. Refer to the "Battery Replacement" section under Maintenance.

Date Not Changing Automatically

- **Time Setting:** The watch may be set to the wrong AM/PM cycle. Advance the time by 12 hours to correct this.
- Manual Adjustment: If the date is stuck, manually adjust it using the crown as described in the "Setting the Date" section.

Condensation Inside the Watch

If you notice condensation inside the watch crystal, it indicates a potential breach in the water resistance. This should be addressed immediately by a qualified technician to prevent damage to the movement.
