The XPG INFAREX K10 is a high-performance gaming keyboard designed to enhance your gaming experience with its responsive keys, customizable RGB lighting, and essential gaming features.

Setup

Follow these steps to set up your XPG INFAREX K10 keyboard:

- 1. Unpack the Keyboard: Carefully remove the keyboard from its packaging.
- 2. **Connect to Computer:** Locate an available USB-A port on your computer. Insert the USB connector of the keyboard firmly into the USB port.
- 3. **Driver Installation:** The keyboard is plug-and-play. Your operating system (Windows 10 or later recommended) will automatically detect and install the necessary drivers. No additional software installation is typically required for basic functionality.
- 4. **Verify Connection:** Once connected, the keyboard's RGB lighting should illuminate, indicating a successful connection. You can now begin using the keyboard.

Operating Instructions

The XPG INFAREX K10 keyboard offers various functions to enhance your user experience. Below are instructions for common operations.

RGB Lighting Control

The keyboard features dynamic RGB lighting. Specific key combinations allow you to cycle through various lighting modes and effects. Refer to the keyboard's function key legends for specific lighting controls (e.g., FN + Scroll Lock, FN + Pause Break for mode changes, FN + Arrow keys for brightness/speed adjustments).

Anti-Ghosting Feature

The INFAREX K10 supports 26-key anti-ghosting, meaning up to 26 keys pressed simultaneously will be registered accurately. This is particularly beneficial for fast-paced gaming where multiple commands are often executed at once.

Windows Key Lock

To prevent accidental presses of the Windows key during gaming, you can lock it. This function is typically activated by pressing the **FN** key in combination with the **Windows key** (often located near the left Alt key). Press the combination again to unlock.

Media Control Keys

The function keys (F1-F12) on the INFAREX K10 double as media control keys when pressed in conjunction with the **FN** key. This allows for quick adjustments to audio and media playback.

- FN + F1: My Computer
- FN + F2: Search
- FN + F3: Calculator
- FN + F4: Media Player
- FN + F5: Previous Track
- FN + F6: Next Track
- FN + F7: Play/Pause
- FN + F8: Stop
- FN + F9: Mute
- FN + F10: Volume Down
- FN + F11: Volume Up
- FN + F12: Lock Screen

Maintenance

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your keyboard.

- Cleaning: Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe down the keyboard surface. For dust and debris between keys, use compressed air. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Liquid Spills:** In case of a liquid spill, immediately disconnect the keyboard from your computer. Invert the keyboard to drain any liquid and allow it to dry completely for at least 24-48 hours before reconnecting. Do not use a hairdryer as excessive heat can damage components.
- Storage: Store the keyboard in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your XPG INFAREX K10 keyboard, refer to the following common problems and

solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Keyboard not responding	Loose USB connection, faulty USB port, driver issue.	Ensure USB cable is securely plugged in. Try a different USB port. Restart your computer. Check Device Manager for driver status.
RGB lighting not working or stuck	Lighting mode error, software conflict.	Try cycling through lighting modes using FN key combinations. Disconnect and reconnect the keyboard. Ensure no conflicting lighting software is running.
Keys not registering or ghosting	Physical obstruction, excessive simultaneous key presses (beyond 26), hardware issue.	Clean under the affected keys. Ensure you are not exceeding the 26-key anti-ghosting limit. If problem persists, contact support.
Windows key is disabled	Windows key lock is active.	Press FN + Windows key to toggle the lock feature.
