1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

2. COMPONENTS INCLUDED

Your Backgammon set comes complete with the following items:

- 1 x Foldable Backgammon Board (Medium Black)
- 15 x White Playing Checkers
- 15 x Black Playing Checkers
- 2 x Dice Shakers
- 4 x Standard Dice (2 white, 2 black)
- 1 x Doubling Cube
- 1 x Strategy & Tip Guide
- Spare Playing Checkers and Dice

3. SETUP

To set up your Backgammon board for play:

1. Unclasp the briefcase and open the board flat. The playing surface will be revealed.
2. Each player selects a color of checkers (white or black).
3. Arrange the checkers on the board according to the standard Backgammon starting position. Typically, this involves placing:
 - 2 checkers on your 24-point
 - 5 checkers on your 13-point
 - 3 checkers on your 8-point
 - 5 checkers on your 6-point
4. Place the dice shakers, standard dice, and doubling cube within easy reach on the side of the board.

4. HOW TO PLAY (OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS)

Backgammon is a game of strategy and luck. The objective is to move all your checkers around the board and off before your opponent does. The included 'Get Your Backgammon On' guide provides comprehensive rules and detailed instructions for gameplay. Below is a brief overview:

- **Starting the Game:** Each player rolls one die to determine who goes first. The player with the higher roll starts. If the rolls are equal, both players roll again.
- **Moving Checkers:** On your turn, you roll two dice and move your checkers according to the numbers rolled. You can move one checker the sum of the two dice, or two different checkers using each die's value separately.
- **Hitting Opponent's Checkers:** If you land on a point occupied by a single opponent's checker (a 'blot'), you 'hit' it. The hit checker is placed on the 'bar' in the middle of the board.
- **Re-entering Checkers:** Checkers on the bar must re-enter the board before any other checkers can be moved. They re-enter on your opponent's home board points corresponding to the dice roll.
- **Bearing Off:** Once all your checkers are in your home board (the last six points), you can begin 'bearing off' – removing them from the board.
- **Winning:** The first player to bear off all their checkers wins the game.

5. GAME STRATEGY

The included 'Get Your Backgammon On' guide offers valuable tips and strategies for players of all skill levels. It covers fundamental concepts, opening moves, mid-game tactics, and end-game strategies to help you improve your play. Key strategic elements include:

- Controlling the board's central points.
- Creating 'primes' (a wall of consecutive points) to block your opponent.
- Hitting opponent's checkers to send them back to the bar.
- Efficiently bearing off your checkers.

Regular practice and studying the guide will significantly enhance your strategic thinking and gameplay.

6. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity of your Get The Games Out Backgammon Set, follow these care instructions:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior faux leather case with a soft, damp cloth. For the felt interior, use a lint roller or a soft brush to remove dust and debris. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Storage:** Always store the game pieces in their designated compartments within the folded case. Ensure the clasps are securely fastened to prevent pieces from falling out. Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.
- **Handling:** Handle the board and pieces with care to prevent scratches or damage to the felt and leatherette surfaces.
