1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Aquasana Countertop Water Filter System, Model AQ-CWM2-B, is engineered to provide clean, filtered drinking water directly from your countertop. Utilizing advanced Claryum Technology, this system significantly reduces common contaminants while retaining beneficial minerals for healthier, great-tasting water.

Key features include:

- **Power Activated Filtration:** Delivers an 8-ounce glass of filtered water in approximately 8 seconds.
- **Claryum Technology:** Reduces up to 99% of 78 contaminants, including lead, PFAS, microplastics, mercury, pesticides, and pharmaceuticals.
- **Mineral Retention:** Filters out harmful substances while preserving naturally occurring minerals like calcium, magnesium, and potassium.
- **Eco-Friendly Design:** One filter replaces over 2,200 plastic water bottles, lasting up to 7.5 times longer than leading pitcher filters.
- **Easy Setup & Maintenance:** No plumbing installation required, with simple filter replacements.

2. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to set up your Aquasana Countertop Water Filter System:

2.1 Unpacking and Initial Cleaning

1. Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
2. Wash the water tank and lid with warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry.
3. Wipe down the main dispenser unit with a damp cloth.

2.2 Filter Installation

1. Twist the filter chamber cap to the left (counter-clockwise) to open it.
2. Remove the plastic wrapping from the new filter.
3. Insert the clean filter into the filter chamber, ensuring a snug fit.
4. Twist the filter chamber cap to the right (clockwise) to close and lock it into place.
5. Place the lid back onto the dispenser unit.

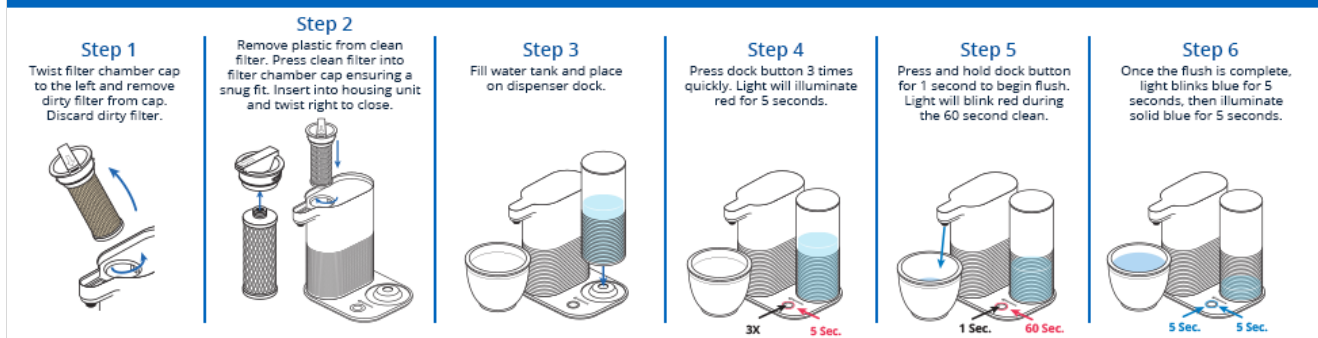


Image 2.2: Visual guide for filter replacement, applicable for initial installation.

2.3 Initial System Flush

Before first use, the system must be flushed to prepare the filter.

1. Fill the water tank with tap water and place it on the dispenser dock.
2. Place an empty container (at least 64 oz capacity) under the dispenser spout.
3. Plug the power cord into an electrical outlet.
4. Press the dispense button 3 times quickly. The light will illuminate red for 5 seconds.
5. Press and hold the dispense button for 1 second to begin the flush. The light will blink red during the 60-

second cleaning cycle.

6. Once the flush is complete, the light will blink blue for 5 seconds, then illuminate solid blue for 5 seconds. Discard the flushed water.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using your Aquasana Countertop Water Filter System is simple:

3.1 Filling the Water Tank

1. Remove the water tank from the dispenser dock.
2. Fill the tank with tap water up to the indicated fill line.
3. Place the filled water tank back onto the dispenser dock.

3.2 Dispensing Filtered Water

1. Place a glass or bottle under the dispenser spout.
2. Press and hold the dispense button. The system will begin dispensing filtered water.
3. Release the button when your container is full or when you have dispensed the desired amount of water.

4. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and longevity of your water filter system.

4.1 Filter Replacement

For best performance, replace filters every 300 gallons or 6 months, whichever comes first. The system's indicator light will alert you when it's time for a new filter.

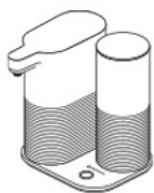
1. When the light indicator alternates between red and blue, it's time to order a replacement filter.
2. When the light indicator turns solid red, it's time to change the filter.
3. Follow the steps in Section 2.2 (Filter Installation) to replace the old filter with a new one.
4. After replacing the filter, perform a system flush as described in Section 2.3 (Initial System Flush).

4.2 Cleaning the Water Tank and Unit

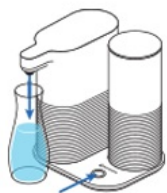
Clean the water tank regularly with warm, soapy water. The dispenser unit can be wiped clean with a damp cloth. Avoid using abrasive cleaners.

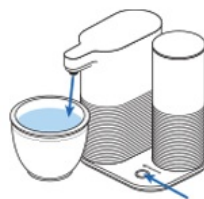

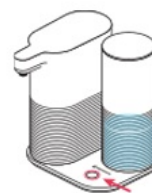


Image 4.1: Pro-Tips for Clean Water Machine maintenance, including light indicators.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Aquasana Countertop Water Filter System, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Water Drips After Dispensing:** Ensure you stop water flow before the glass is completely full to prevent dripping. Some residual dripping may occur due to the nature of the dispensing mechanism.
- **Unusual Noise During Operation:** The system uses a pump for power-activated filtration, which may produce a moderate operating sound. If the noise is excessive or unusual, ensure all components are correctly assembled and the unit is on a stable, flat surface.
- **Water Taste/Odor Issues:** If water quality seems compromised, check the filter replacement indicator. A solid red light means the filter needs immediate replacement. Ensure the filter was properly flushed after installation or replacement.
- **No Water Dispensing:** Check if the unit is properly plugged in. Ensure the water tank is correctly seated on the dock and filled with water. Verify the filter is correctly installed and the chamber cap is locked.

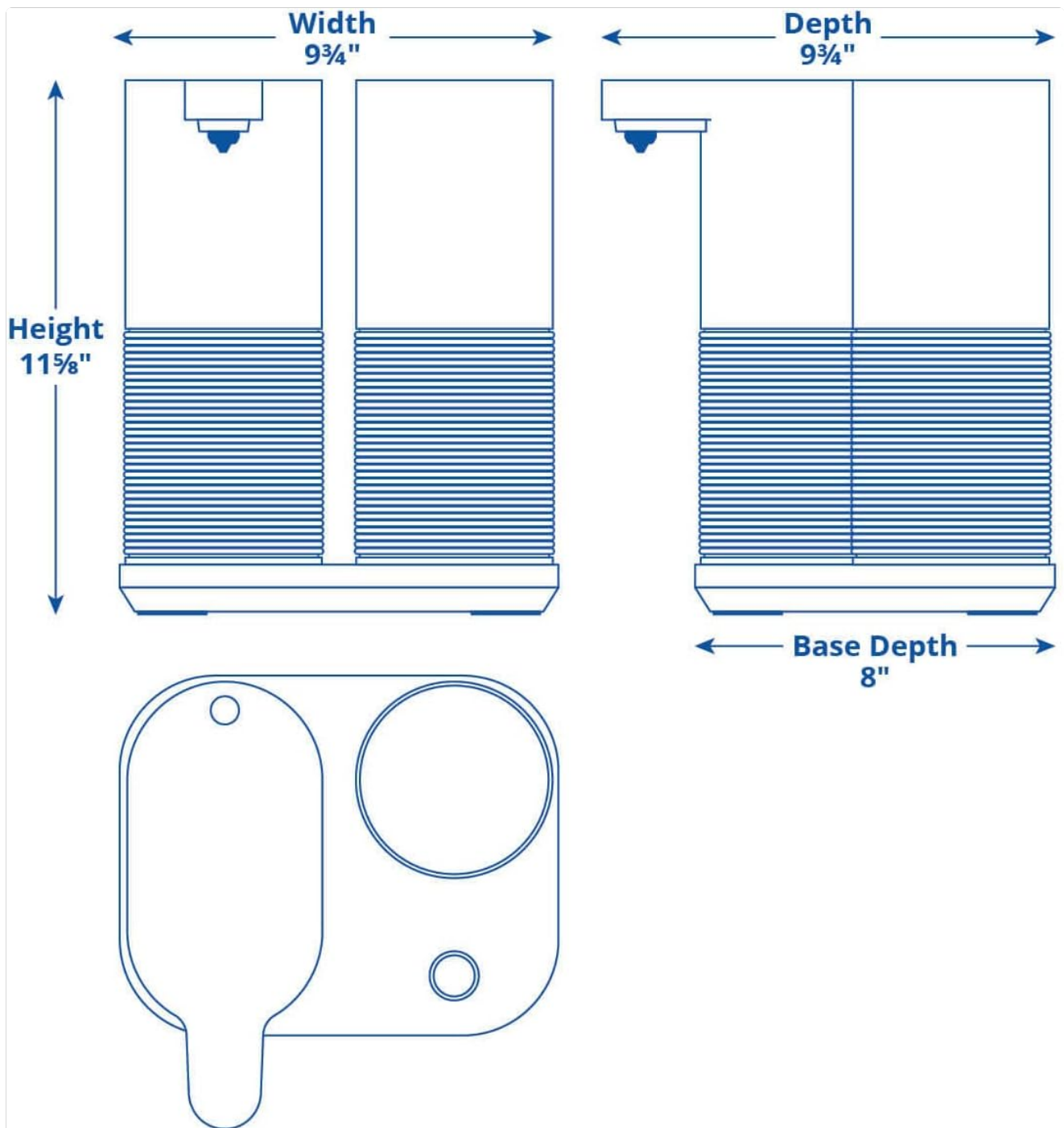


Image 6.1: Product dimensions for the Aquasana Countertop Water Filter System.
