

SAFETY INFORMATION

Always adhere to the following safety precautions to prevent electric shock, fire, or damage to the television:

- Do not expose the TV to rain or moisture.

- Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel.

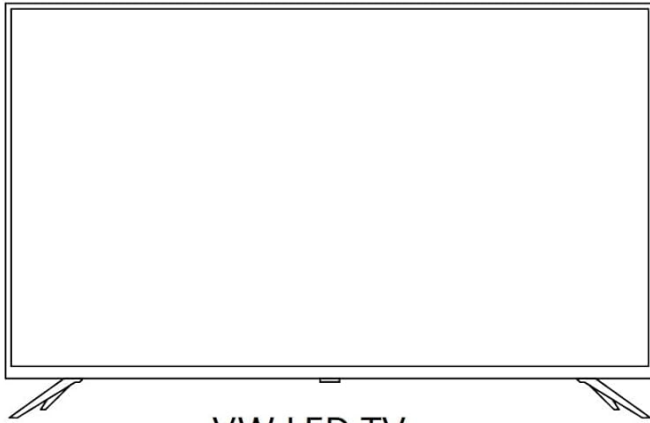

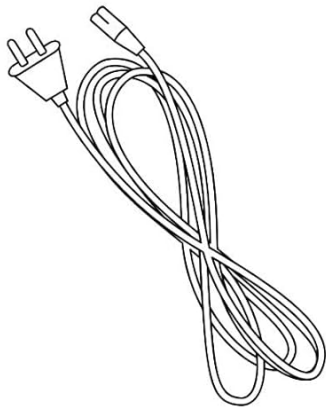

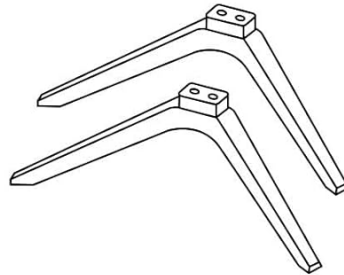

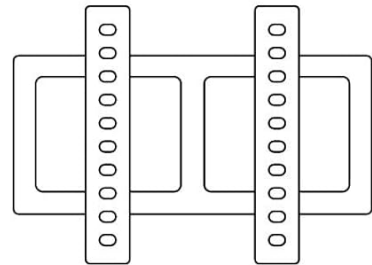

SETUP

Mounting Options

Your VW TV offers two mounting options: using the included table-top stand or wall mounting.

Table-Top Stand Installation

1. Carefully place the TV screen-down on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
2. Align the TV stands with the corresponding screw holes on the bottom of the TV.
3. Secure the stands using the provided screws. Ensure they are firmly attached.
4. Carefully lift the TV and place it on a stable, flat surface.

Wall Mount Installation

If you choose to wall mount your TV, use the included wall mount bracket. Professional installation is recommended for wall mounting to ensure safety and proper alignment.

1. Attach the wall mount bracket to the back of the TV using the designated screw holes.
2. Securely mount the other part of the bracket to a sturdy wall, ensuring it can support the TV's weight.
3. Carefully lift and attach the TV to the wall-mounted bracket.

Initial Power On

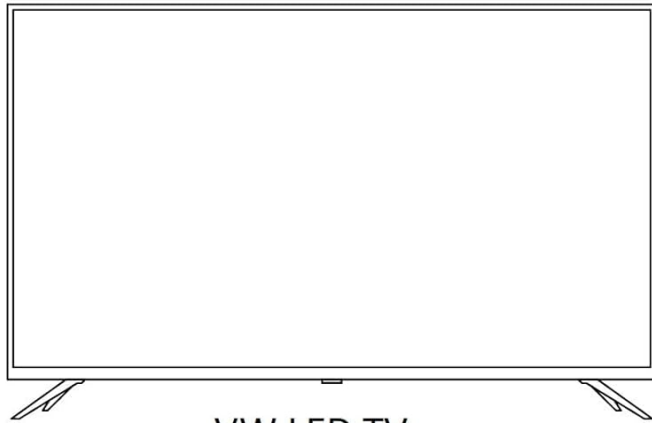
1. Connect the power cable to the TV's power input and then to a wall outlet.
2. Press the power button on the TV or the remote control to turn on the TV.
3. Follow the on-screen instructions for initial setup, including language selection and channel scanning.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Remote Control Functions

The included remote control allows you to operate all functions of your TV. Ensure batteries are correctly inserted.

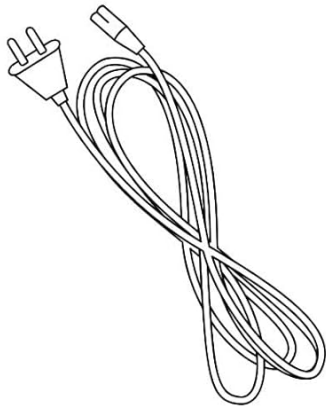

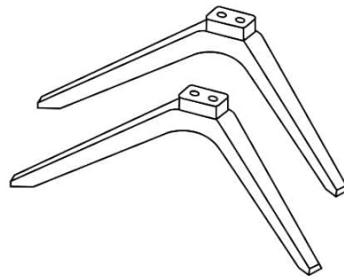

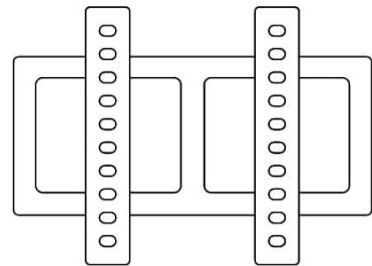

- **Power Button:** Turns the TV on or off.
- **Number Buttons:** Select channels directly.
- **Volume +/-:** Adjusts the volume level.
- **Channel +/-:** Changes channels sequentially.
- **Menu:** Accesses the main menu for settings.
- **Source/Input:** Selects the input source (HDMI, AV, USB, etc.).
- **Navigation Buttons (Up/Down/Left/Right):** Navigates through menus.
- **OK/Enter:** Confirms selections.
- **Exit/Back:** Returns to the previous screen or exits the menu.

On-TV Controls

The TV also features physical buttons on the side for basic control:

- **Power:** Turns the TV on/off.
- **Volume +/-:** Adjusts volume.
- **Channel +/-:** Changes channels.
- **Menu:** Opens the menu.
- **Source:** Selects input source.

CONNECTIVITY

Your VW TV is equipped with multiple ports for connecting various external devices.

- **HDMI Ports:** Connect high-definition devices such as set-top boxes, gaming consoles, Blu-ray players, or computers. The TV has multiple HDMI inputs.
- **USB Ports:** Connect USB storage devices to play media files (photos, music, videos). The TV has 2 USB ports.
- **AV Input (Audio/Video):** Connect older devices using RCA cables (yellow for video, red/white for audio).
- **3.5mm Audio Jack:** For connecting external audio devices or headphones.

To switch between connected devices, press the "Source" or "Input" button on your remote control and select the desired input.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning the TV

- Always unplug the TV before cleaning.
- Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the screen and cabinet.
- For stubborn marks, lightly dampen the cloth with water or a mild, non-abrasive screen cleaner. Never spray cleaner directly onto the screen.
- Avoid using abrasive cleaners, waxes, or solvents.

General Care

- Keep the TV away from direct sunlight and heat sources.
- Ensure proper ventilation to prevent overheating.
- Do not place heavy objects on top of the TV.

TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your VW TV. If the problem persists after trying these solutions, please contact customer support.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No Power	Power cord disconnected; no power from outlet.	Check power cord connection. Test outlet with another device.
No Picture, but Sound is Present	Incorrect input source selected; loose video cable.	Press "Source" button on remote to select correct input. Check video cable connections.
No Sound, but Picture is Present	Volume muted or too low; incorrect audio settings.	Unmute volume or increase level. Check audio output settings in TV menu.
Red Hue/Haziness on Screen (e.g., with set-top box)	Signal issue from source; TV display settings.	Check the connection from the set-top box. Try adjusting picture settings (color, tint) in the TV menu. Test with another source if possible.
HDMI Connectivity Issues (e.g., with PC/Laptop)	Faulty HDMI cable; incorrect input selected; TV or device port issue.	Try a different HDMI cable. Ensure the correct HDMI input is selected on the TV. Test the HDMI port with another device if available. Restart both TV and connected device.
Remote Control Not Working	Dead batteries; obstruction; remote sensor blocked.	Replace batteries. Remove any obstructions between remote and TV. Ensure remote sensor on TV is not blocked.

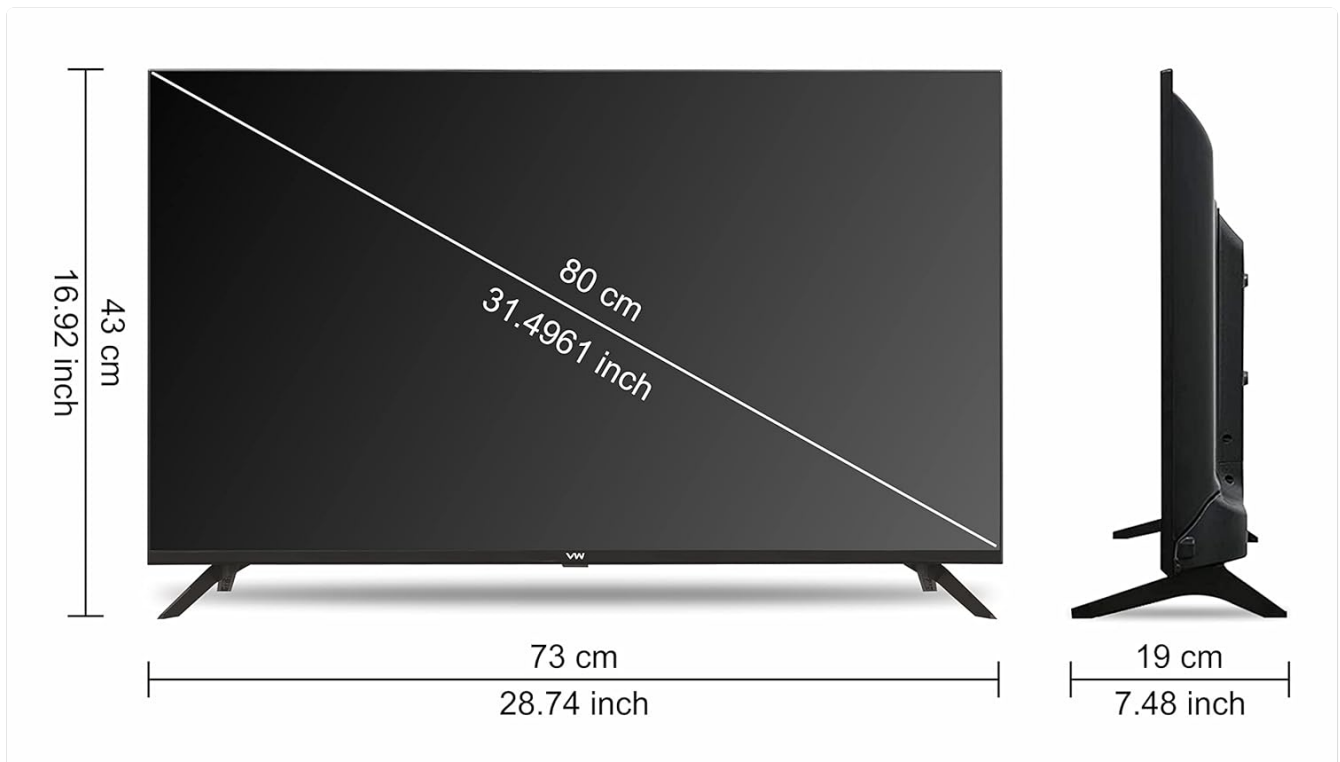


Image: Front and side view of the VW TV with detailed dimensions in centimeters and inches.
