# BONTEC TV Stand Swivel Instruction Manual

Model: ST10-1 | Brand: BONTEC

## INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the BONTEC Swivel TV Stand. This manual provides essential information for the safe and proper assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new TV stand. Please read this manual thoroughly before beginning assembly and retain it for future reference.

## IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

**WARNING: Failure to read and follow all instructions may result in property damage, serious personal injury, or death.**

- Weight Capacity:** Do not exceed the maximum load capacity of 45 kg (99 lbs). This stand is designed for TVs between 26 and 55 inches.
- VESA Compatibility:** Ensure your TV's VESA pattern (mounting hole distance) is compatible: 100x100, 200x100, 200x200, 300x200, 300x300, 400x200, 400x300, 400x400 mm.
- Stable Surface:** Always place the TV stand on a stable, level, and sturdy surface.
- Children and Pets:** Keep children and pets away from the assembly area. Small parts can be a choking hazard.
- Glass Base:** The base is made of tempered safety glass. Handle with care to prevent breakage.
- Assembly:** Assemble the product exactly as instructed. Do not modify the structure or use parts not supplied by the manufacturer.
- Tools:** Use appropriate tools for assembly. Do not overtighten screws.
- Moving the Stand:** When moving the stand with a TV mounted, always lift it carefully and avoid dragging to prevent damage or tipping.

## PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before assembly, verify that all parts listed below are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, contact BONTEC customer support immediately.

## SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

---

Follow these steps carefully for proper assembly. It is recommended to have two people for certain steps, especially when mounting the TV.

### Step 1: Attach Anti-Slip Feet to Glass Base

Carefully place the tempered glass base (Part A) upside down on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches. Attach the six anti-slip rubber feet to the designated spots on the underside of the glass base. These feet provide stability and protect your furniture.

### **Step 2: Secure Support Column to Glass Base**

Align the bottom of the main support column (Part B) with the pre-drilled holes on the top side of the glass base. Use the provided screws and washers to securely fasten the support column to the glass base. Ensure it is tightly secured but do not overtighten.




*Image: The main components of the TV stand assembled, showing the sturdy glass base and the central support column.*

### **Step 3: Attach TV Mounting Plate to Support Column**

Slide the TV mounting plate (Part C) onto the top of the support column. Secure it using the designated screws. This plate allows for height adjustment later.

### Step 4: Attach TV Mounting Arms to TV

Identify the VESA mounting holes on the back of your television. Select the appropriate screws, washers, and spacers from the hardware kit that fit your TV's VESA pattern. Attach the two TV mounting arms (Part D) to the back of your TV. Ensure the arms are level and securely fastened.

### Step 5: Mount TV onto the Stand

With assistance, carefully lift the TV with the attached mounting arms and hook them onto the TV mounting plate on the stand. Ensure the arms are properly seated. Secure the TV to the mounting plate using the safety screws or clips provided in the hardware kit to prevent accidental dislodgement.

## OPERATING YOUR TV STAND

### Swivel Function

The BONTEC TV stand features a  $\pm 50$ -degree swivel function, allowing you to adjust the viewing angle for optimal comfort from various positions in your room. Gently rotate the TV to the desired angle. Avoid forcing the swivel beyond its limits.




*Image: A television mounted on the stand, demonstrating its ability to swivel 50 degrees left or right for flexible viewing angles.*

### Height Adjustment

This stand offers multiple height adjustment options to suit your viewing preferences and accommodate soundbars or other components. The mounting arms can be adjusted to 2 height levels (each by 50mm), and the TV plate can be adjusted to 2 height levels (each by 40mm). To adjust the height, carefully remove the TV from the stand (with assistance), reposition the mounting arms or plate to the desired height, and re-secure the TV.

### Cable Management

Utilize the integrated cable management system on the back of the support column to organize and conceal unsightly cables. This helps maintain a tidy and organized entertainment area.

### MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, damp cloth to clean the stand. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents that could damage the finish or glass.
- **Inspections:** Periodically check all screws and connections to ensure they remain tight and secure. Retighten if necessary.
- **Glass Care:** For the tempered glass base, use a glass cleaner and a microfiber cloth for streak-free cleaning.

### TROUBLESHOOTING

**Problem:** TV stand feels unstable.

**Solution:** Ensure all screws are tightened securely. Verify the stand is placed on a flat, level, and sturdy surface. Check that the anti-slip feet are properly attached to the glass base.

**Problem: TV is not level after mounting.**

**Solution:** Re-check the attachment of the TV mounting arms to the TV and the mounting plate. Adjust the height settings on the mounting arms to compensate for any slight tilt.

**Problem: Cannot swivel the TV.**

**Solution:** Ensure no cables are obstructing the swivel mechanism. Check that the TV is not pushed too far against a wall or other furniture, limiting its movement.
